TERRORIZER are the best, fastest, and heaviest band to come out of the California since SLAYER, DARK ANGEL, INSANITY ... etc. TERRORIZER consists of Oscar on guitar and vocals, Jesse on guitar, Pete on drums, and Garvey on bass. Oscar and Jesse both have been playing for 4½ years, while Pete and Garvey for 4 years.

They released a killer first demo entitled "Nightmares" and two non-studio mixer rehearsals (4-25-87 & 8-22-87). All of the songs deadly speed, proving TERRORIZER to be the next death-noise-fast band !!! Here's an interview with Jesse Pintado.

SATANIC DEATH - How did TERRORIZER started killing?

JESSE PINTADO - We started in early '86. We got together and looking for a drummer.
Until finally met Pete one type fast suitable drummers in L.A..
We have never killed anyone! That shit is murder, and prision sucks.

S.D. - What response has the demo gotten?

J.P. - So far it's been fucking cool, everybody likes it. Even a bunch of hard core/ punk people who usually don't listen that type of music. GRIND CORE-FOREVER!

S.D. - Who are influences and favorite bands ?

J.P. - I've been influenced by Dischage, Larm, Inferno, Electros Hippies, Death Strike, Heresy & Hirax, Repulsion, but as a whole band, no one really.

S.D. - Who came up with the name "TERRORIZER" ?

J.P. - I did, we thought of calling our selves decomposed, but it didn't stick, then we liked the name terror, but I found out there was a band by that name, so I thought of TERRORIZER, at the time we didn't really liked it. But were used to it now.


S.D. - What would you call yourselves?

J.P. - I would say grindcore filth noise, not death metal, that term is very boring.

S.D. - Who write the songs ?

J.P. - Almost all with me & Oscar, it's like we work on one of his track then one of mine & sometimes both, I makes no difference. But the lyrics Oscar write mostly 90%.





S.D. - Are you guys gonna be the next L.A. SLAYER ?

J.P. - I wouldn't say the next Slayer, because our audience is very limited. Only very few people like this shit. (I personally don't like Slayers music + lyrics.) so I don't know it's up to the people if there willing to support us.

S.D. - What gigs have you played so far ? & where do you play to play in the future ?

J.P. - We have played like 8 times, like 3 times at Hoover Park (Hall) & some parties (only two). We are suposed to play in San Francisco w/ Sadus, Pestilence, Necrovore will just have to wait & see.

S.D. - How many death thrashers usually show up at your gigs ?

J.P. - I really wouldn't know, I guess about 200-400 people. What ever Hoover holds.

S.D. - How do you find the reaction of the fun ?

J.P. - Well just sleeping beside me girl friend is fucking great, but other than that, going to shows, drinking & just hanging out!

S.D. - When are you gonna release the 1st LP and your future plans ?

J.P. - It's hard to say were had offers from Wild Rag records, but we didn't take the offer. I've been told that a new label just for thrash is coming out & that they would pay us to record our album, but I know we will appear on "Raging Death" I w/ Necrovore, Sepultura, Morbid Angel, Oblivion, I've been told. Buy that!

S.D. - Any last comments ?

J.P. - Yeah! Our demos \$ 3.50 U.S. or \$ 4.50 Europe. (Elsewhere) I write Filth Fanzine check that out!

Here's an interview with a truly greatest death metal band from Florida. It took place with the help of Trey Azagthoth, MORBID ANGEL's guitarist. If you haven't heard their demo/reh/live tapes, then you're missing out, but soon, the first LP will be released, so be sure to buy it !!!

SATANIC DEATH - How and when MORBID ANGEL formed ?

TREY AZAGTHOTH - I formed the band in mid '84 with Richard and a drummer and bassist who not worth mentioning. After recording "Abominations of Desolation" I fired the drummer and bassist and scrapped the project because it lacked in heaviness. I then relocated the band to north calolina and joined with David and Wayne. The new line up is Trey Azagthoth - lead guitar, Richard Brunell - Lead guitar, David Vincent - bass and vocal and Wayne Hartsell - Drums.

S.D. - Who throught up the name MORBID ANGEL ?

T.A. - I came up with the name.

S.D. - What are your favorite bands ?

A.T. - I mostly listen to Sepultura, Pentagram (Chile), Death, Napalm Death, Wehrmacht and old Possessed.

S.D. - What are your influences ?

T.A. - I am influenced by fast and brutal music, Evil, Animal-like sex, fast cars, Pit Bulls, horror movies, occult !!



S.D. - Who write the music and lyrics ?

T.A. - I write all the music and the whole band arranges it. I wrote all of the lyrics prior to the new line-up. David is writting all the lyrics to the newer material.

S.D. - How many times have you gigged before ?

not played any shows yet but we are planning a tour soon here in the U.S.

S.D. - How many ragers usually show up at your gigs ?

T.A. - We have great turn outs. One show in Florida had over 500 ragers plus a lot of others also.

S.D. - When you'll release your LP ?

T.A. - We have a lot of great material to put on a album but we haven't found the right record lebel yet. Hopefully soon !!

S.D. - How can you imagine the results of your album? Do you think it will sell good ?

T.A. - I think our album will sell great. Everyday we get bigger and more popular, through out the world. Our style is very original and stands on it's own.


S.D. - Any last words ?

NAUSEA (ex - MAJESTY) comes our way with their brand of totaly heavy death metal band.

I just finished listening to them and now my mind is all full of death and destruction and is completely demented and warped!! Here's an interview with Oskar and cosmo.

SATANIC DEATH - How was NAUSEA formed by who?

OSKAR - NAUSEA was formed in march of '87 by me and Cosmo! Eric was dieing to be a band so we

Cosmo - Year, But Eric turned out to be cool. Then we got Richard.

S.D. - Did you get a good responce from the 1st & 2nd demos ?

Oskar - We only got one demo. I don't know were you got the second one. We are not done with the second one yet, we got a respond to the first one. We only sold two of them.

Cosmo - What's a response . We don't have a second demo. But we have reh..

S.D. - What are NAUSEA's main influences ?

Oscar - The main influence would have to be. (Napalm Death) and (Extreme Noise Terror).

Cosmo - Same as Oscar.

S.D. - What other bands do you listen to ?

Oscar - I listen to Napalm Death, E. N. T., old Dischage, Master, Repulsion, U. K. - Heresy, Death etc . . .

Cosmo - Same as Oscar with Hirax, Ripcord, Terrorizer and many more.

S.D. - How Would you describe your music ?

Oscar - Well, we call it (Tramp core). Some song are fast but short and some of them are at slower pace, but if you heard E.N.T. and Napalm Death, that the kind of stick we play.

Cosmo - I would call it music Calif.tramp core!
S.D. - How many times have you been on stage?

Oscar - I been on stage with them only two times!

Cosmo - Me and Eric been up their 3 times.

S.D. - What do you think about the death metal scene in Los Angels ?

Oscar - It's sucks, the only good bands are Terrorizer and Demeitor.

Cosmo - Same here, most of the other bands suck balls.

S.D. - Where are do you like record lebel ? & Your future plans ?

Oscar - What record labels were just trying to get a good demo out. About future plans we'll just keep on doing demos and playing live.

Cosmo - We'll be lucky if we get a good demo out.

S.D. - Do you have any last words for our S.D. readers ?

Oscar - Buy our new demo when it's doing and S.D. #2 it kill's, rips, destroy !!

Cosmo - Buy the new demo (out soon). Martyrdom is one of the silliest bands in L.A. (more then doom) G.G. is an important wimp.

NAPALM DEATH is a totally "braingrinding-noise-core" outfit from birmingham (UK). They are surely the brutalest band on earth! Their 1st LP is called "Scum". The A-side contains older tracks (with the old line-up), side-B has only new tracks, whitch are played with the new line-up! Nik & Jus left N.D.! The new stuff of N.D. is better than the demo stuff! They play a mixture of HELLHAMMER (in the doomier parts) & LARM (in the ultra speed parts but they play faster than LARM!! - ed.)
Here is now the interview with the N.D. - drummer MICK!!

SATANIC DEATH - Please give the current line - up of N.D.! MICK - Bill (17/guitar); Mick (me) (19/drums & screams); Jim (23/bass); Lee (20/vocals).

S.D. - Is it true that N.D. will make a split LP with ATAVISTIC ?
 Mick - No way ! Personally saying from all the band, they are terrible. They play so messy and the drummer cheats to

play fast. As people they are great with excellent ideas + lyrics, but as musicians they are terrible. We will stick to doing our own LP's (details see other question). We would love to do a split - EP or LP with S.O.B. (JAP GODS)!

S.D. - Why has Jus left N.D. ?

Mick - Well, Jus left N.D. on his own accord due to he was fed up thrash hardcore and had no more ideas towards the band + was slowly loosing interest, so he told us it was best he left, so he did + it took us a long time finding a replacement.

S.D. - Any tour plans in the near future (Europe or Japan) ?

Mick - Well, we have just come back from europe. We did a 6 date tour with RIPCORD (another killer UK-band). We played switzerland, west + south germany, belgium, holland. The tour was fuckin excellent. We will be back this october - december '87 if all goes to plan. As for Japan, we would love to play, cos Jap HC is my fave music! S.O.B. are total gods - they rules! We would love to play with them + Selltic Frost, Swankys, Brain Death, Gauze, Outo, Anti-Septic, Coward, Gism, Lip Cream, Last Bomb, Systematic Death, Roze, Roze & loads more - They all rule, but S.O.B. are the GODS!!

S.D. - You have some so-called "hobby" bands, like Earslaughter, Braingrinder, Brain Torture! Why do you play in theses

bands ?

Mick - Well, simply because I love noise + gringcore + maniac Jap vocals. I sing in all of these project bands, it gives me something to do in my spare time. I love it. I'm about to do my first noise-core, demo with 2 members of Ripcord (g/dr) and the bass player of Messiah (Tschosi) in 1 week called HEADERUPTION so watch out! I also play drums for E.N.T.!!!

S.D. - I've heard that Bill Steer (ed. of Phoenix Militia - mag.) is the new


guitarist, right ?

Mick - Yes, he certainly is. He has saved N.D from splitting (Cheers, Bill). He joined 2 weeks before we recorded the B-side of our first LP. I taught him all the new songs and he learnt them very quicky - he rules! Jus left N.D. december '86. I found a replacement, who played 4½ months then left us in shit, so i phoned up Bill + asked, if he would help; he did and

S.D. - How many drum - sticks have you killed ?

Mick - Too many and it costs a lot of money to keep myself in sticks! I break a stick say once a gig or practice at least.

S.D. - Anything important to add ?

Mick - Thanx to all people for giving + support N.D. since Dec.'86. You have kept us going cheers! Thanx S.O.B./Siege/Repulsion for your influences you all rule. Anybody who wants to contact us, please do (please be sure to enclose an I.R.C. for sale or swaps with the N.D. Lp, please write! Anybody who can release our LP in Japan: please, please, please write!!! Keep thrashing + grinding!!!

Mick is really a mad & great guy! He & N.D. really support from Japan! All Jap thrashers are hereby summoned to write Mick for LP - distributing, tours etc.! Also for tape - trading (He's got a great list!) You can also buy their first LP "Scum", whitch is a total Braingrinding manic desaster! It contains 28 tracks and is dedicated to all thrashers who think that Larm, Sea Monkeys ... Are too commercial!!!! It costs 7 pounds (including p&p); You can also get N.D. They started late'85, with the line up being Scott Reynolds - Guitar, Bill Daner - Guitars, Rich Flint Bass, Rob Wedda - Vocals and Jeff White - Drums. They started with covers live Slayer, Exodus etc. June of '86 they did a rehearsal tape with 13 songs half covers, The rest their songs. People told us they liked their songs better so they stopped doing covers and worked just on their originals. September of '86 they went into the studio to record their "Toxic death" demo. They played a show in November '86 that went pretty cool, except for the small room they were in this past Feb. '87 they recorded the second demo "Ravaged By Disease". It was done in the cellar of guitar player for a more raw sound. They played again in March with two other bands, sounds from Hell and Cremation. The show was great since then they parted with their guitar players. They weren't into what they were doing anymore. guitar players - Dave king and Shawn Miller. The give us a more heavier sound !! They are still going to play 4 or 5 old songs, but want to work on new one so they can go into the studio again. They want to get a good sound demo to send to Record labels. They are trying to get ready for that thing are starting to get better for us, with more shows coming soon !! They are new death/core metal band and also people ca get both their demos on one tape for US\$3. (overseas add US\$1)



HELLWITCH is one of Florida's fastest/heaviest band. HELLWITCH's first released was the "Nosferatu" demo that 1 song demo. The second demo "Transgressive Sentience" whitch was heavy/thrash stuffs with many time changes and great solo parts. The third demo "Mordirivial Disemanation" was even more devastating, faster and heavier ! The featured flesh ripping songs: "Degeneration", "Purveyor of fear", "Pyrophoric seizure" and a new version of "Nosferatu". Anyway, I got an interview with Pat Ranieri. Read on !!

SATANIC DEATH - How did you get started killing? PAT RANIERI - OK, Me and this Fat Slob came up with the name in october'84 and did a - one track demo as a sort of joke.

S.D. - What was the original line up?

P.R. - Myself on guitars and Fasta on drum (Text books) and vocals.

S.D. - Who are your influences and favorite bands ?

P.R. - We try not to allow anyone to influence our music. We feel originality is the most important factor in composition. I personally love Slayer, Insanity, Death, Possessed and Slaughter Lord.

S.D. - Do you like Hard core punk?

P.R. - Love it !! Dead Brains cells are GOD !!

S.D. - What kind of image do you have ?

P.R. - We are not satanists. We are just average guys who play death metal for fun. We like to be close to the audience, no rock star shit !!

S.D. - How did you get such a good sound on your demos ?

P.R. - On the '86 demo, we were not really happy with the sound. The guitars in partially. We belt they sounded too "clean". The demo however was recorded on 16 tracks in the same studio where Nasty Savage recorded their LP. A very professional set up. Our new demo was done on 6 tracks through a submix system using a 4 track recorder.

S.D. - Where did you record it ?

P.R. - The place was called Multi-track studios. (also known as morris sound.)

S.D. - What new meterial do you have ?

- P.R. Our new demo "Mordirivial Disemanation" contains, Degeneration, Pyrophoric seizure, Purveyor of fear and a newly arranged version of Nosferatu. Our fourth demo will contain the song Mordirivial Disemanation plus 2-3 new songs.
- S.D. Who are main write song and lyrics for your "Mordirivial Disemanation" demo ?
- P.R. I write most all lyrics and music except for "Degeneration" whitch ex member Andy wrote.

S.D. - Why do you put in "Nosferatu" for your new demo ?

P.R. - We originally planned to have. Mordirivial Disemanation ready for our new But we had already written new bass and drum parts, as well as, new lyrics for "Nosferatu". The only choice we had was to re-do it.

S.D. - Any comments about "Mordirivial Disemanation" demo?
P.R. - The new demo shits all over our '86 demo! That's what everyone seems to be saying. I think so too. My song waiting skills have matured somewhat witch has greatly improved our sound. The production is much power + heavier also.



S.D. - How has the reaction to HELLWITCH of Florida ?

P.R. - Gainesville is sick of us (40-50 people at shows.) Tempa likes us !! Miami crowds are the most responsive, however. We played before 300 when we performed with G.B.H. and Agnostic Front.

S.D. - Where do you plan to play in the future ?

P.R. - We have no bassist at present, so we really have no gigs lined up. But we played with Mortorhead in Miami Florida in October.

S.D. - Hows the Florida scence ?

P.R. - The scene in Tempa is the best in the way of audiences. The bands from there through aren't too tatented. Bands like Xecutioner and Ravage are fair. Morbid Angel is great. The Miami scene is good. Live diving and moshing!

S.D. - Any chance of HELLWITCH on vinyl ?

P.R. - Yes !! Our LP will be out in spring '88 on possibly New Renaissance Records or Black Dragon Records .

S.D. - Thank you! Any last comments?

P.R. - Thanks so much for the interview Satsuki. Satanic Death is very professionally done zine. Keep up the good work! To all your readers, go to show, buy 'zine Support your scene !!!



The San Francisco Bay Area has given rise to several of the world's best thrash metal bands whose names need not be mentioned. The scene right now is host to many new a upcoming bands, one of which is VIOLENCE!!

VIOLENCE was originally formed in Janualy of 1985, but the present line - up was not complete until early 1987. Soon after the band's formation several personal changes transpired; During the period that followed, the band was recorded live at the renowned "Ruthie's Inn" in Berkeley, California. A song from this recording appears on the album, "Eastern Front; live at Ruthie's Inn". Soon after this recording, singer Jerry Birr was replaced by Sean Killian, who proceeded to rewrite VIOLENCE's previous lyrics. It was Phil Demmel, Perry Strickland, and Troy Fua (original members) along with Sean Killian and Deen Dell, who were on the 1986 demo recording, with music written by Phil and Lyrics by Sean. During the beginning of 1987. Troy was replaced by Rob Flynn on guitar, and thus the VIOLENCE line - up was complete.

SATANIC DEATH - When did you get started killing? PHIL DEMMEL - VIOLENCE back in May 1985.

S.D. - What's your main influences ?

P.D. - Slayer, Exodus, Metallica ...

S.D. - Let us know the present line - up of VIOLENCE.

P.D. - Sean Killian (Vo), Phil Demmel (G), Rob Flynn (G), Deen Dell (B), Perry Strickland (Dr).

S.D. - Could you describe from your side your music ?

P.D. - Our music tends to be an outler for our emotions, When we feel violent, we sit down and write out a Violent song, We feel have our own distinctive sound.

S.D. - How many times have you been on stage?

P.D. - We've played 33 shows.

S.D. - Where do you think VIOLENCE will be 3 years after ?

P.D. - We've had records offers so hopefully recording our third album and touring.

S.D. - Do any of you listen to death metal?

P.D. - All of us listen to Death, Massacre, Morbid Angel ... etc.

S.D. - How many guys usually appear at your shows?

P.D. - About 200~700.

S.D. - Your future plans.



P.D. - Hopefully recording maybe near future and a tour after.

S.D. - Any last words.

P.D. - Thank you for your interest and spread the VIOLENCE !!!

The band will be following this up with a new demo tape "Birth by Radiation" in the near future. The new songs are to be heavier, faster and sicker! Some new titles are "Virus", "Torn apart by werewolves", "Infected creatures" and "Vomiting blood". Wait or die in hell! Anyway I got an interviews with King Fowley.

SATANIC DEATH - When was DECEASED formed ?

KING FOWLEY - We were formed in '85 out of love for thrash/death metal! We wanted to be the best death metal band ever!

S.D. - Why did you choose the name DECEASED ?

K.F. - Well, we through of a ton of names but DECEASED was the one for us! It means Death so we had the perfect name for our music. And a lot of people love it!!

S.D. - Will the band please introduce your selves.

K.F. - O.K. Rob Sterzel on bass and Yuk, Mark Adams on guitar and PCP Hasbacks, Doug Souther on guitar and Alcohol, and me King Fawley on drums/vocal and Gory thoughts!!

S.D. - Who are your influences ?

K.F. - Voivod, Sodom, Napalm Death, Cryptic slaughter, Excel, Bad Brains, Tankard, Sabbath, Bloodfeast, old Kiss, MDC, Speed core bands, noise and horror movies!!!

S.D. - Do a lot of people confuse your themes with Satanism or Death metal ?

K.F. - Well, we label ourselves Death metal but we aren't practising satanist's! We do have a few songs about hell, satan etc... But it's just a topic! We mostly write about weird ideas!!!

S.D. - What inspires you to write ?

K.F. - Gore movies, my wierd mind, death, hatred, anger, fear !!!

S.D. - About how many copies your demo did you sell?

K.F. - 750 a few more or less !! We are very happy !!!

S.D. - Any plans for an LP or demo soon ?

K.F. - We want to do an LP but now a new demo "Birth by Radiation" will be out soon !! it is fast, heavy and sicker than ever! Look for it !!!

S.D. - Any last words our readers ?

K.F. - Yes, thank you Satsuki for your support! You got a pretty cool scene in Japan (Casbah, United, Dementia) I wish we could come and tour there! One day though. Please support DECEASED!! Everybody write to me today.







When I listened demo "Ripper crust" for the first time. I considered HELLBASTARD are very much like Certic Frost songs, but they are faster than it. New Certic Frost sounds are boring to me. (It's fuckin' shit!! Come back to old times!!!!) HELLBASTARD is a real killer heaviest/thrash band from U.K. This is an interview with guiar and vocals Scruff was most of the interview, oh well ....

SATANIC DEATH - What promped you to start a death/thrash band ?

SCRUFF - Firstly our band is a thrash band, totally unconnected with Death Phil, Scotty and myself have always been interested in music but it first began punk.

Then it progressed to thrash metal when we decided to form our own band in 1985. The reason for this was to play the music we wanted plus to relate our own beliefs and throughts to other music form.

We also play for the pleasure of other people and hopefully we will open the narrow minds of some people.

S.D. - What are your favorite bands and why ?

Scruff - My favorite bands (lyric wise) are Amebix, Bad Brains, Chaos UK, Disorder Apostles, e.t.c. Where as the bands I enjoy listening to for music are Certic Frost, Sabbat, Master, Voor, Hellhammer, Sacrifice, Papsmer, Decapitator, Whiplash, Massacre, Death ...e.t.c. and also it gave people the inclination that were not just a boring punk band.

S.D. - Who came up with the name HELLBASTARD ?

Scruff - Originally it was a sons of bad Breath song SOBB are aband from Hockney,

(London) who are very good friends all 1 decided on the name. Firstly it was a
piss take of bands who sing about Satan, Death etc.

S.D. - What kind of image do you have ?

Scruff - We don't really have an image we just dress the way we feel not how our music dictates, but if you want discriptions well, lots of haily moles + a lump on nose. Long dyed crimped matted hair, dirty black ripped years, patched with leather and encrusted with dirt from years ago. Ripped + tied leather jucket with a cut - off underneath.

Phil - Red & black long hair, ripped pants, lots of nose rings, green combat jacket with

a tuffty badge.

Scotty - 7 foot tall, woolly hat, ripped jeans, black jacket, short uncontrollable hair a braun independent can do nothing for it.

S.D. - Who are main write songs & lyrics for your songs ?

Scruff - Scruff writes all the lyrics & music for all songs except for the lyrics of nazis killed whitch were written by Phil.

S.D. - Whitch do you like Death metal or Hard core ?

Scruff - Both. I like Hard core for both the music and the lyrics and Death metal for the music but fuck the lyrics.

S.D. - Have you done many gigs in England?

Scruff - Yes, We've played at Newcastle, Birmingham, Scotland and many others through out England. We've also been affered gigs at Italy but we couldn't afford to go. We may be playing at Germany soon.

S.D. - How do you find the reactions of the fun ?

Scruff - We are not a fun band but we don't mope around with serious faces all of the time. We believe there is a time for fun and seriousness. Gigs are fun but everyone knows the serious side of them. Most people regard us as a serious band as are messages relayed to them one?

S.D - What do you think England Death metal & Hard core scene ?

Scruff - The English Detah metal, Hard core scene involves a lot of Punks who have progressed with the music.

S.D. - Any last comments.

Scruff - Thanks for the interview, thanks to everyone who have taken an interest in us bought our demos. Unity and strength - HELBASTARD '88.

1st AGRESSIVE MOSH FESTIVAL, Geneva, Switzerland, may the 30th 1987 with : CYANIDE - MASSACRA - MUTILATOR - OUTBURST - AGRESSOR - ARTERY - MINOTAUR and MESSIAH.

This gig was one of the most important European thrash festival ever! Lots of "unknow" bands played there for (only) 220-240 people! 4h30 (PM) CYANIDE opened the festival, they're from Lausanne (Switzerland) and played a good mix of speed and thrash parts. Very influenced by SLAYER and EXODUS: it's a great live-band (lot of fun esp.). The second band of this festival was MASSACRA from Paris (France), this guys are pure assholes because they wanted to fight the organisers 'coz the soundcheck was too quick (15 minutes), their live-prestation was fuck and their music was totally boring (nobody thrashed during their show : great !). MASSACRA is one of the badest band (live) I've ever seen! Incredible! Then came the new French-sensation: MUTILAOR. They are very cool guys and played with the AGRESSOR's guitarist (Alex) as bassist (he hadn't rehearsing with them before the gig!). Their gig was fuckin' fast and very killer except the bad guitar sound, their music is in the pure NYC MAYHEM/FCDN TORMENTOR/ CRYPTIC SLAUGHTER vein! Lots of slamming and thrashing, they played 2 covers: "Black magic" and "Endless pain" but faster than the ogiginal versions! This guys rule and their music too !! After MUTILATOR played OUTBURST from Marseille (France), instead of CRYPTIC DEATH (because C.D. can't come to Geneva) they were great too! This band consists of ex-HELLFIRE members but you can't compare HELLFIRE and OUTBURST. Their music is very loud with speed parts, a bit influenced by KREATOR (old version!) and they do a great KREATOR cover too: "Flag of hate" singing by their road-crew! Then came the festival's sensation : AGRESSOR.



Comming from Antibes (France) this guys are very professionals. Their music is a mix of the bests KREATOR and CARRION's parts! Their set was incredible and for every thrashers who liked AGRESSOR's music, they played a total improvisation of the S.O.D.'s cover: "March of the S.O.D. - Sargent D. and the S.O.D.", everybody became MAD!! After the superb AGRESSOR's set came ARTERY (the funniest !). This band is from Geneva and paly speed music like ANTHRAX (they were the same look !) with a point of hardcore influences (mostly CRUMBSUCKERS and STUPIDS). They were very good and their cover-song was "Inspector gadjet" (great isn't it?). The only bad part of their set was the intro (with a classical guitar : like MEGADETH) which are fuck ! But the rest was incredible! It was 10 PM when MINOTAUR came on stage (this is a german band). The crowd was a bit tired and the reaction to their music wasn't very good. Their music is very fast (all song faster than the demo tapes) but their prestation was boring a bit (esp. the bassist). Jorg (drummer) is a cool guys and do some moshing in the public during a song! (Yeah you've read right: it's the drummer!). MESSIAH, the last band festival comes on stage at 11h15 PM but the crowd was great : lots of shaking (mostly) and thrashed in the front of the stage! They opened with "Hymn to Abra Melin" and since the firsts riffs everybody become mad! They played some new tracks like "Nero"; "Enjoy your self"; "John Paul the last"; "Extreme cold

weather"; "Ole perversus" (a song composed for every shankers and moshdancer! A must) and some old tunes in a new version: "Resurection" (ex-Satan's resurection). The most intense songs were "Messiah", "Thrashing madness" and the ultimate composition: "The dentist" to closed the set. It was 60 minutes of incredible thrash and fun without violence! Broggi and Tschossi were very happy of this gig and the only problem was the public ! (as I sayed before : only 220 people !) This gig was fantastic and very attractive due to the cool price: 10.-frs. about 5 US \$) it's a bit incredible for 8 bands! The light-show was excellent and the sound quite good. It was no security (no police ..) and everybody was OK : no fight ! Really great !







On Saturday 9/19/1987 DEATH ANGEL played their show on their first European tour in "Het Paard Van Troje" in the Hague, a small club for the alternative circuit. Their supporting band were Dutch thrash band Shockwave, it was the first time I ever heard of this band I hope also the last cose they sucked major dick. Than after a 20 minute break the mighty DEATH ANGEL entered the stage starting off with Ultra-Violence intro Mistress of Pain. Following were 75 minutes of Total thrash, combined with a intense live show I've seldomly seen before. audience through awesome versions off all the L.P. tracks and 3 new songs "Third War", "Guilty of Innocence" and their best track ever "Dehumanisation" + an old track "Devil's Metal". They came back twice for a well deserved encore. A totally raging show, after which they all entered the bar to drink and mix with the people and this interview was taken.

SATANIC DEATH - Hi, what did you think of the show and the audience ?

MARK - Great, the sound was good and the crowd was crazy.

ROB - Yeah, totally fucking wild.

GUS - Raging.

S.D. - How are the sells of the album ?

Rob - Well we only know the sells in the states and they're pretty good, about 50

Mark - Yeah, about that number.

Gus - I heard the latest sells were about 70 thousand, worldwide I think about 150 thousand at this time.

S.D. - Are you satisfied with the way the album turned out ?

Mark - Well yes and no, we recorded the album ourselves before we had the contract with Enigma, in only two days and months later we mixed it for 2,5 days, so I think it turned out pretty good.

Gus - It turned out OK, we were planning to release it ourselves, when the Enigma deal came around. The next one will be heavier though.

S.D. - Was the Enigma deal the only one ?

Mark - No, but it was the best.

Rob - We had some offers from European Companies.

Gus - From Noise and Roadrunner and one other, but they weren't good enough. The Enigma deal was good though.

S.D. - Anything on the new album ?

Mark - We don't know a recording date yet nor a producer, but it will decimate the first one.

Rob - It will have ten tracks, 7 new ones and 3 old onreleased ones.

Gus - Some new tracks are "Third War", "Shores of Sin", "Bores (with U2 undertones !?), Guilty of Innocense" and "Dehumanisation".

S.D. - How long will the European tour be ?

Mark - A little over 2 weeks.

Rob - With a show almost every night.

S.D. - Since this interview is for a Japanese mag, and Satsuki tell me very few U.S. speed and thrash bands tour Japan, will DEATH ANGEL tour Japan soon ?

Rob - We'd love to, but it all depends on Enigma if we tour there or not.

Mark - They paid for this tour, one day they came up to us and they said "How would you like to tour Europe, the sells are good enough over there" and we said " sure, great when do we leave".

Gus - We get a lot of great letters from Japan, so touring there would be great, but it all depends on how the album sells over there.

S.D. - Well that about covers it, anything to add?


Mark - Greeting to all European and Japanese Thrashers, you guys are great.

Japanese death metal band MESSIAH DEATH formed by Jun Kokubo (Vo) and Daisuke Morimoto (G) in early 1986. Then, in March 1986. the rest member Masahiro Nakagawa (dr), Takaaki Okuma (Ba), and Hideki Yamamoto (G) joined the band the line-up was completed. At the time, they called themselfs "CHRIMINAL CHRIST" and also named each other stupid names. (Now they don't.) In May 1986, Hideki was kicked out because of the musical differences. In August 1986, they released the first demo intitled "Cryptic Doom". But in March 1987, Jun and Masahiro were sick tired to play in the band, so Jun decided to break up the band. The main reason why he decided to do so was that on the guitarist/song-writer Daisuke was never fit for the band to play real death metal. They (Jun & Masahiro) really wanted to play more fast and heavy! Anyway the band was broken up. But now they were reborn. Jun decided to reform the band and also decided to play the guitar as well as the vocals. Now they called name "MESSIAH DEATH" and the line up is : Jun Kokubo (Guitar/Vocals), Masahiro Nakagawa (Drums) and the session members Koji Kuno (Lead vocals/ from CRUCIFIXION). They are still searching for the bassist and the guitarist. They were released Promo. rehearsal demo in August 1987! All songs are total death metal !!! And they look like SEPULTURA. 


Do you know Agressor ? They aren't from US, W-Germany, Brazil which are pure bands. Well, Agressor is French speed/thrash metal band !! Born of ashes KATACLISM, formed june '85, including a rhythm guitar, a slowly drummer, MOMO (bass, vocal), ALEX (lead guitar/vocals), this band never gave any concert, it was often changing bass player & lead singer, Duuring this time ALEX improved composition (rhythm part, solos & vocal) they are the current AGRESSOR'S repertory, but KATACLISM broken up june'86 because of bad relationship between the band's musicians. Soon after that ALEX joined METRAL a heavy metal band looking for a lead guitar player but ALEX is not officially part of the group because he dosen't like the style. Unfortunatly the drummer & the guitarist left the band for personal reasons, a week after he arrived but meanwhile METRAL would give 2 concerts openning for PANCOEUR. It's about that time that ALEX decides to form another speed/thrash metal band end of august '86 with ALEX (guitars/vocals), DESTROY (drums), MOMO (bass) AGRESSOR was born... They was released "The Merciless Onslaught" demo. The songs are "Bloodfeast", "Lucifer's spell" and "666". It's goes without saying they're playing ultra heavy/thrash (like KREATOR !). SATANIC DEATH - How did DEATH ATTACK started killing?

SLATANIC DESTROYER - Well, DEATH ATTACK started killing since March '86 when I've meet SLATANIC THRASHER.

S.DEATH - Your influences and some of your favors.

S.DESTROYER - I think when you hear our music, you think we're influenced by BLOODDEATH INTENSE MUTILATION & others grindin' shit, but really we're influenced by SLAYER, NYC MAYHEM and others !!! I love SLAYER (My god !), REPULSION, WEHRMACHT, STRAIGHT AHEAD, FCDN TORMENTOR, MASSACRE, MORBID ANGEL, INSANITY, CRYPTIC SLAUGHTER, ARCHNEMY, MASTER, UNSEEN TERROR etc...

S.DEATH - Are you satisfied with the results of your demo"Blood virgin" ?

S.DESTROYER - When We've realised this demo, we throught all people hate us because we didn't knew how to play, but we've been very surprised when some people in Germany, Japan, USA etc tell us that they love us! Incredible but true!!!

S.DEATH - How would you describe your music ?

S.DESTROYER - I think we can describe it as MEGAULTRAGARBAGESHIT METAL with "Blood virgin" but now we can call our music "MEGAULTRAFUCKIN'THRASH METAL" !!

S.DEATH - What is the thrashcore scene in France?

S.DESTROYER - It sucks !! France sucks !! The thrash scene in France !! It's one of worst in the world! Except with us,LOUDBLAST (heavy/speed), AGRESSOR (the French Kreator/Carrion),MUTILATOR (the French Wehrmacht), GODZANGER (hardcore/thrash),OUTBURST (formely Hellfire!),That's all!!





S. DEATH - How do you find the reactions of the fun ?

S. DESTROYER - Funnyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyyy !! Hahahahahahahahahahahahaha !!!!

S.DEATH - How many times have you gigged befor ?

S. DESTROYER - Well we've gigged many times. We'll play soon with AGRESSOR, CYCLONE, MUTILATOR !!!

S. DEATH - Any last words guys !!

S. DESTROYER - Megathanx for this interview, you rules !! Buy SATANIC DEATH or die in hell !!! Listen our megahigh technical music too, it's very important if you want to become crazy like us !!!



J.H. - Our influences range greatly everyone from Trouble, to Metallica, to Minor Threat to Sacrilege, to Batalion of Saints, Led Zeppelin. Some of our current favorites are: Faith no more, Red hot chili peppers, Forbiden Evil, Ludichrist, Watchtower, U2, and about 8 million others, we love music!

S.D. - What do think about the recent popularity of death speed metal, how many years

do you think will last ?

J.H. - The recent popularity of death/speed metal is cool in the sense that it brings more people together, and in the negative sense. There are so many fucking lame bands with nothing to say and are only in it to feed off of their favorite bands music and are causing the people who are truly loyal to the scene to be brought down with their lame asses!

S.D. - How many times have you gigged before ?

J.H. - We've played many shows !! We were once quoted as saying we've played 100,b it's not that many . We've played in a bowling alley, a laundromat + other weird sports.

S.D. - How many ragers usually show up at your gigs ?

J.H. - Well not too many people showed up to our earlier gigs, but lately we've been getting bigger draws like 200~400, which is good for S.F.

S.F. - Comments about your demos ?

J.H. - Buy the demo if you are into positivity hardcore metal, or if you just have an open mind.

S.D. - What do you think Bay Area thrash/death metal scene ?

J.H. - The scene in S.F. has produced some of the best alternative music bands in history, and we are very proud to be from S.F..

S.D. - Your future plans ? tell me!

J.H. - Our future plans include some dates outside of Calif. next summer. Hopefully, well have some vinyl out by then.

S.D. - Any last comments to our readers!



SATANIC DEATH - Who are, and how old are the members?

JEFF CHAREST - Doug Whitney (drums) 19/ Mark Embrogno (bass) 18/ Joe Mariani (guitar)

19 / and I play guitar & vocalist. I'm 20.

S.D. - Has anyone played in a band other than VIOLENCE ? J.C. - Yeah, but nothing half as important as VIOLENCE!!

S.D. - Who came up with the name VIOLENCE? Is there any special meaning between the name and your style of music?

J.C. - Doug conceived the name in '84 or '85. Since this line-up has been together, VIOLENCE has taken on the meaning of fighting for existence because of all the shit we've dealt with lately in life. VIOLENCE is also a realistic band with a street attitude!

S.D. - Do you think there will be any problem between the VIOLENCE from OHIO, and the CALIFORNIA band of the same name? Will you change your name in the future, or is it just gonna come down to who puts out their LP first?

J.C. - We'll have to wait and see! But if we have our way, we'll keep the name!!

S.D. - What bands do you listen to and/or influence your playing ?

J.C. - We basicly listen to anything that thrives on speed, power, hate, and aggression!

Is there anything you'd like to say before I end?



- H.O. It includes four or five trax. Two of them are included in our last demo, and the others are new ones.


S.D. - Are you planning to send your new demo to any foreign countries ?
