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In my oppinion ILLDISPOSED's debut demo "The winter of our discontempt" is far the most brutal danish demo ever! And that demo has secured them a deal with french Infest Rec. Since I like the demo so much. I had to know to know more about ILLDISPOSED, so I wrote down a couple of questions, and send them to ILLDISPOSED's manager, Esben, who handed them on to the I.D. guys ... I must admit, that I find most of their answers as totally ridiculous, so I don't think, that you should take their answers to serious ...

- ILLDISPOSED's biografi!? The I.D. history starts in '91, where Michael June Enevoldsen and Hans Wagner (both from the Arhus band SLASHER) picks up Bo Sommer from the gutter, where we'll have to say, that he was compeled by an urge to a couple of beers too many. First line-up: Michael - drums, Hans - guitar, Bo - bass-vocal. A couple of hundred cases of beer later (aprox. 3 months) another guitarist joined. The big talent called Lasse was hired because of his long hair, alcohol problem, and that he had his own gear. After that, we had to get a real bassist (Ronnie), 'coz Bo couldn't handle both the booze-bass and the vocals. At that time we were almost ready to record winter...".

- Recently you relased your debut demo "The winter...", are you satisfied with it?

To begin with we were pretty satisfied with it. But it not clear, that we already have changed alot, in the short while there's been since the release. The sound on the demo is very "nice", and doesn't live up to the brutal sound we have live.

- Please tell me about the songs on "The winter...", is

it a concept demo?

Our lyrics is not conected in any way, that wasn't even the idea that they should have been printed on the cover in the first row.

- The intro is pretty weird, is it a lion (or another animal) which belch forth the strange sounds/growls?

We've "borrowed" a little from core sort of a test-CD Fr's

we've borrowed a little from some sort of a test-CD. It's of course completely legal to do such a thing. It's some sort of pissed lion, trying to get loose from its chains.

- Did you use any vocaleffects on "The winter..."?
There's no sort of vocal
effects on the demo at all,
exept from a couple of
overdubs and the first growl
in the song "The winter...".
Only for the fun we tried to
put a couple of effects on
some places, but then it's was
like that the "energi"
disappeared. So the voice on
the demo is exactly like Bo's
normal alcohol voice. And that
way should everyone do it!

- Your music sounds pretty inspired of "american" death metal, is it? What inspires

you?

Do you think so? We fucking sound just as the swedish bands, as we sound as the american! Vi just listen to everything brutal with balls! P.t. we listen alot to english death bands, NAPALM DEATH? BOLT THROWER...

- Have you got any new songs ready? Titles?

After "The winter..." demo, we have made two new song, they haven't been titled yet. The new songs sound a bit different than the old ones. The first one is the most brutal we've ever done, while the other one is much more nice. But don't fucking worry, it ain't nice at all.

- How often do you rehearse?
I.D. rehearse 15 hours per week. But then it must be said, that much of the time is being spend with sitting and yelling at each other, and of course we also enjoy a couple of beers in the reh.room.

- What do you think of the danish scene?

what scene? Der aren't more good danish bands, than I have fingers on my right hand! (How many fingers do you have on your right hand then? ed.)

- Where did you record "The winter..."? What did you think about being in the studio? How

much did it cost you?
We recorded "The winter..." in
a 16 track studio, which is
pretty cool. The studio is
about 10 metres from our
rehearsel room, and therfore
it seemed natural to record
our first demo there. We used
4 days in the studio, and all
together it costed 5000 Dkr
(about 850 dollars. ed.)

- How has the response on "The winter..." been?

So far the response have only been small, but we have got altter from Poland, where we seem to be the absolute best death metal band. But we're not very known, and therefore we aren't exactly drowning in album offers.

- What do you do besides of playing music?

Lasse - unimployed. Bo - unimployed.

Michael - unimployed.

Ronnie - digging holes at one of the municipality's exellent projects.

Hans - Plumber/"Plummer".


- What are your future-plans? A new demo, which we this time will try to make perfect. It's definately going to be the most brutal ever released in Denmark. No nice intros.

- Have you got any last words?

Fuck off!

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VICIOUS is the name of a great danish 'zine. No. 2 is pretty good, actually it's one of the better 'zines to come out of denmark ever! Well, Jens (the editor) is a cool dude, so I thought, that a little support wouldn't do him any worse. So Jens will now disclose a couple of things about his 'zine...

- Hi ya Jens, how are you today?

Fine, thanx. How about you?

- Recently you released the second issue of VICIOUS MAG., are you satisfied with it?

Up to a certain limit I am quite content with VICIDUS MAG #2. Of course there's always some small details you'd have done differently afterwards, but then it's a bit con late to think about that. The material is ok, I think, and we've gotten some nice comments on it, so everything considered I think it's ok...

- Is there anything specific, the you would like to change?

Firstly it's still xeroxed, and that's definitely a thing we'll change in the future issues, but more about that later. The front-cover isn't "exciting" and cathey enough and some of the pictures could've been placed more centrally on the pages, but that's and to explain unless you're holding the 'zine in front of you while reading this... where from this, there's also heaps of small (?!?) details, but there is really no point in complaining about that now.—all I can say is that issue #3 will be better!

- Tell me, when you got the idea to start VICIOUS MAG., and when the first issue was released!?

I have to admit that originally it wasn't even me who got the idea, it was a friend of mine. We were sitting at my place and we were really bored, so suddenly he asked: "Hey, how about we make a 'zine?!", and I immidiately picked up on the idea. However, it turned out that his and my ideas about how the 'zine should be were quite different + I was more serious about than he was, so I decided to "go solo". I kept the name 'cause I got it. I unleashed issue #l in early '91 by myself and after I got Victor Bentzen in

on the 'zine, and he's now the co-editor. I think it all started some time in mid '90.

- Are you satisfied with VICIOUS 1?

HELL NO!!! Seriously speaking, I was at the time of release, but nowadays...nope! It is obvious (I hope) that I was fuckin' (uh!) unexperienced at the time, and doesn't really have anything to do with how VICIOUS MAG looks nowadays, which is also why I've lecided not to sell it (issue #1) anymore. But; thank to those who did buy it!!

- How was the response on VICIOUS 1?

Everything concidered I guess it was pretty good. From what I know, most people liked the actual written material, but though that there simply wasn't enough of it in he 'zine. Also it was severely overpriced - as an example I can tell you that in DK ssue #2 costs the same as issue #1 even though there's about 2-3 times more stuff in ssue #2. The price for foreign contries had to be raised due to the postage rates outside DK... Anyway, so many things have happened since issue #1 so I'd rather not ompare it to issue #2.

- What do you think is the best thing about doing a 'zine, and what is the worst?

Phew, a tough one! I like most things about making VICIOUS - recieving letters, making new friends, getting stuff for review, getting response from people who have bought the 'zine (constructive criticism is a must!!!), and...GETTING INTERVIEWED!!! Bad things? Well...typing the stuff for the 'zine is fucking boring, that's for sure! I can't figure out a lot of bad things, so...

- What do you think of post-rates? Will VICIOUS 3 also be xeroxed?

Eh, the idea itself is as good as any, but charging 36 DKK (= about 6 US\$) for sending one 'zine overseas by surface-mail is fucking hilarious!!! Fuck that shit!!!!! Of course the people at the post office (etc.) have to be paid too, but as I said, the prices as they are at the moment suck! The worst threat to the underground?!?!

Hopefully not! We have our minds set on getting it professionally printed because we think that means quite a bit to a 'zine, and we'll do just about anything to get it done! If there's anybody out there who needs to have their car washed or lawn mowed

please contact us! Ha ha!

- Which 'zines are your fave 'zines?

That must be Isten 'Zine (Finland - godly stuff!!) and Sacroformity Mag (Denmark - ditto!). Other cool 'zines are: Trechoma, InZinerator, Laceration (RIP), Progress, Close-Up and many, many others. 'Zines are a very vital part of the underground in my opinion, and I wish there were a way to get rid of those rip-offs who're giving 'zines a bad name. I enjoy reading 'zines a lot, and most 'zines are cool as long as the stuff inside (interviews, reviews, etc.) is good.

- Are you a totally Death-freak, or du you also listen to other genres?

Well, 90% of the stuff I listen to is GrinDeaThrash, so I cannot claim to be a "pure" death-head or anything. I love stuff like EDGE OF SANITY, DARK TRANQUILLITY, TERRORIZER, RIPPING CORPSE, BENEDICTION, MASSACRE, AUTOPSY, the first CANNIBAL CORPSE, ALCHEMIST, DEMOLITION HAMMER, MORBID ANGEE, DEICIDE, new CARCASS, INVOCATOR, ATHEIST, CONFESSOR, new DEATH, etc., etc., but sometimes a dose of FAITH NO MORE, NIRVANA, TROUBLE or whatever ain't bad either. I can't stand "computorized music" and stuff like that...

- What do you think of pure Black metal alá the new DARK THRONE?

The new DARK THRONE is pure shit and they don't deserve to carry that name anylonger.

The new DARK THRONE is pure shit and they don't deserve to carry that name anylonger I'm not an expert in black metal, but I must admit that until now I haven't heard a black metal that I like, sorry. Of course I can respect it, but I sincerely hope that other black metal bands have a better attitude than Gylve/Hank/Fenriz of DARK THRONE because he seems to think that black metal is bad sound/production, bad playing & of course hating death metal (even though he played it himself - "we play what we love" he said while he still was playing death metal and now he says that all death metallers are dickheads)...fuck that kinda stuff. But please do not think that I am running a personal war against black metal, I just recent Gylve/Hank/Fenriz' attitude, ok?

- Which albums has mostly visited your turnable the last 2 yrs.?

2 years is a friggin' long period of time, but let's try with: stuff from AUTOPSY, RIPPING CORPSE, DEATH, CARCASS, BENEDICTION, DARK THRONE (only "Soulside Journey"!), METALLICA, FAITH NO MORE ("The Real Thing"), INVOCATOR, NAPALM DEATH ("Harmony Corruption"), EDGE OF SANITY, MASSACRE ("From Beyond" - the new one isn't that cool), ATHEIST, PARADISE LOST (mostly the first lp), NIRVANA ("Nevermind"), ENTOMBED, TROUBLE (The Skull"), etc., etc... I think that should give you a fair picture of what I've listened to past few years.

- What do you think of the danish scene? Are there any bands, that you would like to recommand?

The Danish scene is quite cool at the moment and it's still growing. New 'zines & bands are springing up all the time, more and more people are getting into death/thrash

metal and almost all of them seems to be reliable, so that's cool! Most of my faves both concerning bands and 'zines are from the Esbjerg-area, the best are: EIDETIC, MACERATION, SACRIFICIAL, CAUSTIC, EHIRO THERIUM, and of course the mighty INVOCATOR. His to all these bands! Oh yeah, and ICONOCLASM have just recorded their debut-demo, "Obscurity", and I'm looking forward to that one. Cool bands from other parts of Dinamarca are: AGONIZE (hi!), INIQUITY (I haven't heard their demo yet though, but I've got some old rehersal which sounds quite good), FORCE MAJEURE & there's tons of other bands. The only Danish 'zines I've seen so far are from Esbjerg; Trechoma, Laceration (RIP - sneft, hulk!), and SACROFORMITY, but I'm awaiting the first issues of Bowel Movement 'Zine, Nagual Mag (who? What? Where?), and Emanzipation soon...also hi to these guys!

- What do you think is the most importent about a 'zine?

That's probably to be 100% honest, sincere & dedicated about it. If you're not really interested in it, but just work on it once in a while because somebody else thinks it's a good idea I don't think you'll get a cool result. I haven't got a whole lot to comment on here, next question, please...

- For how long have you been listening to "extreme" music?

Thanx! ... I guess I've listened to extreme music for about 4 1/2 years now. The first thrash lp I bought was METALLICA's "...And Justice For All" - I bought it around X-mas '88. But the one who got me into really extreme musick was Victor (Yep, we've been friends for a long time). He'd just bought some SEPULTURA + KREATOR stuff and he practically forced me to listen to it, at first I hated both him + the music, but after I'd heard it a few times I began to like it and it's just been going ever since. Thanx to Victor!

- Descripe yourself in 7 words!!

Very tall, wierd, "funny", dead, extreme...editor!!!

- What do you think about bands/individuals with a starattitude?

Well, of course I do not like these persons who think they're better than the rest of us, but I think that some people ten to judge too harshly... But then again there are some people who seem to be alright but turn out to be pricks. Yesterday MASTER played here in Esbjerg, and the pulled the support-band off the stage after 4 1/2 (yep, in the middle of a track!) 'cause they wanted to play NOW! That's what I call a bad attitude! A guy I know talked to Speckmann earlier in the evening and said Speckmann was a really cool guy, and the he (Speckmann) pulls a stunt like this! Wierd...

- Who's gonna be featured in VICIOUS 3?

I can't tell you exactly as nothing has been planned yet, but we're working on CARCASS, ATHEIST, MESHUGGAH interviews at the moment. Also there should be special feature on the best Esbjerg bands with interviews with some of the best bands from around here + of course some others who aren't decided yet. We have yet to decide which demo-bands we want to feature 'cause we want to have the best bands in it. I think there will be less reviews and more interviews in issue #3, but that depends on how many bands/labels/whatever will send their stuff (everything that gets in will be reviewed!). Let's wait n' see, ok?

- What do you do besides of doing VICIOUS MAG.?

I'm still in school + I work two times a week. Other than that I don't do a whole lot - I'm not in any band or anything (but my biggets dream is to be the drummer or lead growler in band!) if it's that kind of stuff you're thinking about. Oh yeah, I also like to hang out at Power Records + I eat and sleep a lot! Parties are cool too of course!

- Ok, it's time for for some free advertisement; the famous last words are all yours...

Thank a million for the interview, Bjarke, it was cool! This is the first time ever I do an interview, so I hope my answers were ok?! Good luck with Nagual Mag, buddy! NAPALM DEATH

Grind!! The kings of grind gotta be NAPALM DEATH! With their latest opus "Utopia banished" they're (allmost) back in the old vein. Personally I prefer "Harmony Corruption", but I also like "Utopia banished"! When they played in Denmark, I got in touch with Shane and Barney...

- To begin with I would like to know why your old drummer (Mick Harris) has left you!? He simply wasn't into the music anymore. I'm not really going into great details about it and why. He just basically wasn't into it. The Earaches talk ragous about why he left

the band. I didn't really give him a hard time, when he left the band.

- Tell me something about your new drummer!

He's a friend of Jessies from L.A. He hasn't really been in any bands before, he was just jamming around and when Mick left I asked Jessie if he knew any, and he (Jessie) said "My friend, he's really NAPALM, he's cableble of doing it. 'coz he hasn't been in any band before, shall we try him out?" So he brang him over, and he fitted in rather well. Pretty good. Very enthuastic! Mere much open to our ideas than Mick was.

- As far as I know Mick was the only original member left,

wasn't he?

He played on the "Scum", but you have to understand that back NAPALM DEATH was way longer than "Scum" and Mick join when the bands didn't formed in '81. I get really answering these of tired questions, well I mean, it's Well, 1'11 just... carefull, I'll just say that the band played since '81, they changed their style in '86, that's when Mickie joined. Mickie was a part of the first, no he wasn't really a part of the first recording material by NAPALM. But he was from the "Scum" area. There's alot of things about that area, that people don't know about. I could have played guitar on the second side of Scum". But I didn't wanna join the band back then. There are lots of things that people don't know about, but know, you have to look NAPALM DEATH as a... really a band... It's more like an institution really. It's more like the collective sort of things, you know. It's a... The people that comes in pretty band appreciate what the meaning is all about, so ... I shouldn't really... Well, I mean, I can't say it's a problem, 'coz know lots of other bands, whose line-up constantly change, even more drastic than ours. They don't know, what seems to be the questions be the questions themselve, but ehh... Mick wasn't an original member of the band.

- Talking about Mick Harris, what do you think think of his new band/project - SCORN?

It's alright, it has got nothing to do with NAPALM DEATH, so... In my oppinon it's pretty good!

- What about some of your other previous members bands, such as CARCASS and CATHEDRAL? They're ok.

- What do you think about playing with L7 and BAD RELIGION here tonight?

I think it's pretty cool, actually! I'm more into playing with different types of bands. In fact, I'm much more into playing with bands that are different from us, than bands that sound like us!

- Is it only here in Denmark, that you play with L7 and BAD

RELIGION?

I'm not sure. I don't think... I think, maybe in Sweden, but I'm not sure...

- Please give me some facts about your new album "Utopia Banished"!!

It's the NAPALM DEATH. It

represents us in '92.

- It's the '92 NAPALM DRATH?
Basically, yeah. It's very much in tune with rest of the albums, you know. This album represents what we are about at the moment. It's very much straight from the heart, I could say about this album. We haven't recorded this album with any intentions to please anybody, and we really don't care if no one likes it, if they do. it's cool!!

- Do you earn enough money with NAPALM DEATH, so that can actually make a living out of

it?

I make a living out of it. I earn enough money to make me happy. Maybe not all the people, that's one of the reasons why Mickie left; 'coz he didn't make enough to make him happy.

- What do you think that nowadays inspires you the

most?

What inspires me hasn't changed at all. I'm still influenced by what I was into in 85-86. What inspires me to go on is the fact, that I've absolutely not reached the point, where we can say we haven't compromized one thing, and actually achieved a lot! That's my explenation for being on the waltz. Remaining the same, allmost.

- Do you think, that NAPALM DEATH will exist in 5 years

from now?

Hopefully we do! Maybe we don't. I can't say if we'll be around in 5 years from now.

- What are your futureplans? Just touring. We gonna tour Europe, and then we go to America in August. And hopefully after that we may tour America again, with MEGADETH, hopefully.

- With MEGADETH?

Yeah, but we don't know yet.

- Do you like touring or what?
At times yes, and at times I hate it! We just take each day as it comes. The touring thing is good, but sometimes it can really get so averating, you know.


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In 1991 EDGE OF SANITY released their debut LP. It was entitled "Nothing but death remains", and despite the bad production on that LP, it gave E.O.S. a certain reputation. Then in 1992 E.O.S. unleashed their so far best release, another LP, this time it was entitled "Unorthodox", and where "Nothing ... " was lacking of missing originality, "Unorthodox" sure showed that E.O.S. had improved alot, and sort of created their own sort of death metal, filled melodic parts, and extremely brutal vocals!! This interview made with "god-growler" Dan Swand ... Read on!!

- When and why was EDGE OF SANITY formed?

We formed in 1989 (early november, the fifth I think), because we wanted to do some stuff together since we knew each other from two local punkrock acts, that also made their respective carreérs a bit after these band's collapsed in due to E.O.S. outspred rumours and dilevery, people can't stand, when their friends make it bigger than themselves, that's why those bands fucked ...

- Are you named after movie "Ede of sanity"? I'm Yes we're, but not responsible though...

A list of your releases, please!? 1989/"Euthanasia" -1990/ "Immortal rehearsels" - 1990/ - 1990/"The "Kur-nu-gi-a" dead" - 1991/"Nothing but death remains" (LP/CD/MC) 1991/"Dead but dreaming" 1992/"Unorthodox" (LP/CD/MC). - Your first LP "Nothing how much has it sold? Are you satisfied with that?

I think, that it has sold just as much as it should according to what's on it ... The playing isn't that bad, but the cover and the sound etc., is not the best around...Let me guess, 6.000 copies or so ... Nothing like 20.000 that I heard some time ago ...

- Are you satisfied with the way "Nothing..." turned out, musically and soundwise I mean? Who's "John med gummi-

handsken"?

Well... The drumsound sux. much because these originally trigger pulses not drumsound, but since it was the first time that MONTEZUMA really worked with intense death they didn't know that trigging and sampling don't work in E.O.S. with a drummer like Benny that keeps on doing his triols one the pedal (only one, remember) and his fanfare snare-shit in someplaces, that sounded fuck on there, even worse.. Like a bad drummachine so we stuck to the original "drumsound" and the guitars were pushed a mile to low, but their monitors there, allways tend to push the guitars up front in the mix and then they all of a sudden fucking dissapear ...

- Why did you use that cover on "Nothing .. ", and why did you entitle your 1st LP

"Nothing ... "?

That cover was better in the original version, dark and evil. but somehow it got the light on it before press, we never really understood what was going on, but we saw and accepted without thinking of the original aswell ... And the title comes from "The dead" and we found it importent to create a slogan and I think it rules....

After "Nothing ... " you released a promotape, why did you do that?

show labels and B.M.P. what we'd been doing since the depression left ...

How was the promotape recieved, did any other lables show interrest in you?

No... We only got B.M.P. and it was clearly shown, that we only had to stick to them, because we were signed for a longer time that we knew... 4 options...

- Do you think that the promotape was a better and more upto-date representation of E.O.S.?

Yes, at least we turned some 'eads with "When all is said"

and that's cool ...

- Though it seemed as you had gone apart from Black Mark Pro., your second LP is also out on B.M.P., what happend? We just hated them for what they did with our first album, but then all of a sudden B.M.P. seemed to have matured a bit, and we decided to give it all a second try...

- You also recorded your 2nd album at the MONTEZUMA Studio though the sound on "Nothing ... " was "critisable", why did you choose once again to go to MONTEZUMA Studio instead of trying another studio, SUNLIGHT for instance? We knw that MONTEZUMA and REX (B.M.P.'s boss. ed.) had more to deliver, and it had ... SUNLIGHT is fuck ... We'll never record there unless it was with bigger amps and real drums, but they aren't or he's (Tomas Skogsberg) not that used working with it, so I guess MONTEZUMA is better for us, but not the best!

I know you are also running a studio called GORYSOUND (!), tell me something about it; who have recorded there, what

it costs etc.!?!

I have ha d this studio since 1988/89 and I have recorded so incredibly much. I find it uninterresting to count 'em all up, but it costs 100Sek/hour for 8 channels (the most modern machine/mixer) and the sound just fucking kills!

- Besides of sining (?) in E.O.S., you are also involved with several other bands -MACERATION, PAN THY MONIUM etc., tell me about your relationsship with these bands! What does the other members in E.O.S' think of your "side-projects"?
MACERATION is not a project

MACERATION is not a project for me, I did some vocals* lyrics that's all... I wish them a 1000 times good luck and I hope to get that album one day, it shreds!!

- Ok, back to E.O.S., your second album "Unorthodox", are

you satisfied with it?

Gosh...
- Tell me about the songs on "Unorthodox"!!

Let me just pick a few, I cannot type this forever...
"Enigma" — Our most outstanding track 'tilldate... I just love its mood and harmonies!! "Nocturnal" — Evil and our way to show what Swedeath's all about!! "Dead but dreaming" — Slightly unoriginal, very evil, and totally fucking aggressive!! "When all is said" — A good song, a misty ballad and it just sends shivers down my spine!!

- In one of your songs ("Enigma") you sing "God gives you shelter and heaven shall..." with a "normal"

voice, why?

I am a priest in that part if you follow the lyrix and a priest shall have normal voice, since the very me is not a christian, but I respect them and have a Jesus painting on my wall and I find christians quite sympathic because they stand for their beliefs. The lines on "Unorthodox" is written by a character, not by myself. I write for someone else, that is real and won't make his voice heard because he doesn't exist anymore...

- How has the response on that

particular song been?
"Enigma"? Oh boy we have a

hit!

that something, that you'll do again (sing with that voice)? Yes. On a new track called "The spectral sorrows" I'll do some normal vocals all the way and it'll be a totally sad and depressive track... Also in "Jesus cries" I'll do some backing vocals with my normal voice... Not to much though, if you wanna hear my normal voice all the time, buy "0" (:the circle) or UNICORN's every demo ... - What do you think about "Unorthodox"? On which fields do you think that "Unorth ... beats your previous releases? On every field... Especially playingwise, the guys really gave 100% and I love them for that! And I think and know, that "Unorthodox" will be very important for all 5 of us, it will take us places (to prison for 2 atleast ... and me to Roskilde!) Will your next releases continue in the same vein as "Unorthodox", or will you go one step further and be even more experimenting? "Sorrows" as it's called, will be even further "Unortho.." but also brutal as hell! We'll just do what we've allways said, progress in every vein .. The brutal gets more brutal, the slow stuff gets even slower, the fast will not be faster though (God save the Benny!) and of course the harmonies, the solos (yes they here!) will be goddamned melodic that you'll think, we've borrowed them from a fucking symphony so ... But I gave, give, OLQ... Check out our URIAH HEAP ... (Attention! It's not me who's spelling wrong here!! ed.) - What does E.O.S. draw their influences from ? Everything that's melodic wise and the brutality form twisted horrow visions. - You have been on a small tour with DEADHEAD, how was

OBITUARY are among the biggest in the death-scene. They've just released their 3rd album ("The end complete"), and have completed their world-tour 92 "Campaign for musical destruction". When they visited Denmark, I got in touch with bass-player Frank, who willingly answered my questions...

- Then you're back on the road again? Do you like touring or what?

Yeah, yeah, we like you know! It's a way to really spred out the music, 'coz they don't play it on the radio. And anybody who hasn't heard (of) us is going to hear, that we are going to play there, and maybe they come and see us live.

- How does it feel having just released a 3rd album?

It's weird! I never thought that we would have had more than one album out. But (now) I have 2, because you know, I didn't play on the first one. But the band has 3 albums out now.. It's pretty weird! But that's cool!

- Are you satisfied with "The end complete"?

Yeah, big time! But one thing I don't like about it is that we didn't have much time to write new songs. We wanted to put a little weird stuff into it, but we just had to forget it, and write straight ahead death metal.

- Why did you once again go Morrisound?

Because it's close to where we live, and we get the best sound we can get in Morrisound.

- And it's "cheap" to? Yeah, we spend like 15-20.000\$ on "The end complete", so it isn't really that cheap! But it's real near our houses and Scott is one of our best friends.

- What does the cover to "The end..." symbolize?

Nothing really, expect from that the logo is changed.

- How has the response on "The en...." been?

Lots of people says it just like OBITUARY, no change and nothing, but that's we wanted. That's how we wanna sound -OBITUARY!

- It seems to me that you changed style a bit, and that you now play a bit slower?

Naah, not really. There's a lot of slow parts, you know, but we have allways had a lot of slow parts. The new album has just as many fast parts as the others.

- You have also changed your logo, why is that?

It's getting like a tradition; a new logo on each album, it's allways the same way, but it is different. The first album was like blades with blood on them, the second album was just "red". And the third one is with that creature thing.

- How do you feel about being one of the "big" ones in death metal?

I really don't realize it.. I don't think; that we're really that "big" compared to metal bands.. (Well you're not that big compared to some metal bands, but for being a death metal band, I think that you're pretty "big"! ed.)

- How much calculate with that "The end...." will sell?

I hope it sells like 80.000...

Do you think that if you'd signed to another label than Roadrunner, that you then would have been less poular? If we'd signed to a smaller label, I think that we would be more "underground"...

- Are you satisfied with what Roadrunner does for you? Yeah, yeah, they do lots of things for us. - How the is your deal with Roadrunner by the way?

Roadrunner by the way?
It's for 9 albums.... It's really great!

- Can you make a living out of

playing music? Hmm, yeah. Sort of. I can pay for my appartment, my bills, and all that shit. But if I want to buy a thing or go to a party, I gotta have a job

besides...
- Does any of you guys have a job besides OBITUARY?
Yeah, I have a job. I do a construction-work. Building

houses and so.. All the other guys in the band doesn't have job, exept from John.. They are happy with what they have. - Do you know how much "Slowly we rot" and "Cause of death" has sold?

I think that "Slowly..." sold about 70.000, and "Cause of..." sold a 100..

- What are the lyrics on "The end complete" about?

I don't know.. I have no idea.. John did write lyrics but he never showed any of them...

- What are your hobbies besides playing music?
Nothing really... Music is like the big thing in my life... I work and I play in the band... The band is my big hobbie.. I play a little guitar aswell..

- Who's your fave bands? SONIC YOUTH... and stuff like that..

- No death metal?
Not really, 'coz death metal has got to the point, where many things/bands sounds the same... Many bands sounds like IMMOLATION... That was a band, that came off with sounding like no-one else. I like death metal ENTOMBED, MORBID ANGEL and so, bands that sounds different... I like music that is totally of the wall and different - original!

- Ok, have you got any last words for now? It's cool being in Copenhagen again... And thanks to you!

Well, thanks to you to Frank for answering my questions! I'm glad that OBITUARY hasn't got a star-attitude, though they have become quite "big"! A special thank goes to OBITUARY's manager - Debbie Abono for helping with arranging the OBITUARY/NAPALM DEATH & DISMEMBER interviews!!

- Did any other label's than N.B.R. show interrest in you? Well, we had a little contact with PEACEVILLE, also EARACHE showed a little interrest, but they never made the mood about offering us a contract. And we had a little response from Roadracer, after we had signed to N.B.R.. we would never had

were quite pissed off with the CARNAGE deal, 'coz we hadn't gotten any money. So we were like "EARACHE is a fucking rip-off!"... But now we have our money, and everything is cool!

- How does NUCLEAR BLAST treat

you?

Well, they're pretty cool to us! But since they aren't that bigxxxxiabelxxxxxxxx a big big a label, and we aren't that big a band yet, there are certain things that we're not satisfied with! There's this problem with the t-shirts, but we're negotiating that with them right now!

- What do you think about your

label-mates?

BENEDICTION are some of the most cool guys, I have ever met! ATROCITY who are not on the label anymore, are really cool guys! DISHARMONIC guys! ORCHESTRA is cool guys aswell! I haven't the other bands ...

- Is it true, that AFFLICTED

has signed to N.B.R.? I hope not! I mean, N.B.R. are

not such a big label, and now they have so many bands.. My oppinion is that they should concentrate on the bands which allready are on the label! I have nothing against AFFLICTED - I just think that they have to many bands!

- Why did you let Dan Seagrave draw the cover to "Like an ever...."? Don't you think

he's a bit "used"?

Yes, he's used, but he's a good artist! He also did the cover on the CARNAGE LP, and we were so satisfied with that

we decided to use him again!

- A lot of people accuses you
to be an ENTOMBED clone, what
do you think about that?

I think that's bullshit! I mean, if they really make trhe effort to listen carefully to the music, they realize, that we are totally different! The only thing, which makes us similar to ENTOMBED is that we both are from Sweden, and we're good friends with them. But on the next LP we'll not use SUNLIGHT, 'coz we wanna get away from all that stuff. We wanna show everybody that completely different from ENTOMBED; we're much more aggresive than ENTOMBED, we have our own sound and so on.

- Which bands do you consider to be Sweden's best? ENTOMBED. MERCILESS.

DESULTORY, TIAMAT, GRAVE.... and AT THE GATES.

- What are DISMEMBER inspired of?

Life! And the music: life. My band are AUT: PSY, DETCIDE and CARCASS- I accept most kinds

- When will your next LP be sant?
When you have recorded an LP it takes a couple of monthd before it's out, so it's kinda hard to say... We are thinking about recording it in

September...
- Have you got any new songs

ready?

2 songs. One is called "The ninth circle" and the other is called "Reborned in blasphemy". And then we have lots of riffs ready, and stuff like that.

Do any of you guys work?

No, not at the moment...

- So you're on the dole?

If we take dope?

- No! I mean, is the goverment paying your "salery"? Get it? Oh! No, no, no! We are trying to make a living out of our music...

- What do you think about playing with BAD RELIGION and

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FOR THE DEATH METAL ENTHUSIAST



One of my personal favourite bands are RIPPING CORPSE! This band is just so undescripeable great!! Their debut album 'Dreaming with the dead" is a true classic! It belongs among such legendary ones as MORBID "Altars of madness" and DARK THRONE's "Soulside journey", so I simply had to have an interview with this godly band in my 'zine, so I contacted vocalist Scott Ruth, who anwered my questions ...

- The orgin of RIPPING CORPSE + a discography, please!? The band formed in early '87, the with original line-up Shaune guitar, being: Brendon - drums, Dave - bass and myself Scott on vocals. We rehearsed for about 3 months before we did our first demo, which is the "Death warmed over" demo. We send it out to a few labels. But nobody was interested in signing us back then. In '88 we anted to do a reh. tape for ourselves, which aventually ended up being "Splattered released as remains" Demo. It gave us a pretty good response. Lots of for gigging. Opening bigger bands: KREATOR, DEATH, D.R.I., SICK OF IT ALL... A really lot of gigging! The addition of a second guitarist in '89 who were Eric let us to go into '90. In january '90 we recorded the first demo with Eric and it was the first "industrial" demo, we didn't release it to the public, but anyway it ended up out there. And that demo was the "Glorious Depravity" demo and that's what got us signed to MAZE REC. In June '91 we released "Dreaming with our debut LP

the dead" on MAZE REC and on MUSIC FOR NATIONS in Europe. Since then MAZE has gotten under, ans we've lost our original bassplayer Dave. We have a new bassplayer who's name is Scott W. And that brings us up to somewhere near '92, where we're gonna do another demo for labels, and it'11 hopefully secure deal the US. another in Hopefully MUSIC FOR will pick it up in Europe. - Ok, you've had your debut LP out for some time, are you (still) satisfied with it? Well, it has been out for over With year now... promotion and no tours it has done fairly well, you know.. We wish it could have done better, but we're happy with it has done without promotion. There are lots of things that we could have done better, but when you've done something like that and you go back some months later and look at it, and realize that there are lots of things which you could've done better. We have matured alot since "Dreaming...", and think that the next LP will be alot better than the debut! - As far, as I know you have not been on tour outside the states yet, are you planning to do that? In case, when and where? Which band would you like the most to go on tour with? No, we haven't even toured the US yet, we have been on pieces of tours. Recently we've been offered an european tour, that needs to be worked out, so we don't have definately no answer to that, but it looks might be making europe at the end of the year. know, that you're having some "fights" with the members

- Recently there has been all these trouble in L.A., what do you think of it? Are the conditions in N.J. just as bad as they are in L.A.?

New Jersey is not as bad as L.A. We don't have all these youthgangs, though we do ahve our gangs. All these things in L.A. has been going on for many years now, it's just in the media right now. The media is really blowing it out of proportions! All these things will continue going on until happends, something comunicating to the police, the public and so on.

- For us (the europeans) it alomost every seems that in the U.S.A. citizen is carrying a gun, or atleast have one within short range. is it really like that? Does one have to earn a gun to survive in America? Do you

carry weapons? Again the media has blown it totally out of proportion. There too many guns in the U.S.A., but NO, you don't need a gun to survive in U.S.A.!!! None of us carriy guns, we

don't need to! I've

been told from that it's pretty severals, seldom that you americans get with vinyl (12"!). Have you got "Dreaming ... " on vinyl? Yeah, it's getting tougher and tougher to get vinyl in the U.S.A., because they've just totally faced it out. Most of the larger chains don't carry vinyl at all. But there are plenty of small specialstores that care about the people that want vinyl. Especially 7"es of hardcore, alternative music and death metal. So it can be found, you know, but it is being faced out.

Your LP cover, t-shirts, etc., is done by a guy called Rob Leecock I know that he also the artwork of HUMAN does REMAINS, DAMONACY a.o., is he a very used artist? What is it that you really love about his drawings?

Mr. Rob Leecock has been doing work with us for over 4 years now! He did the cover for our "Splattered demo second remains" as the first. And from that point of he's done flyers, t-shirts and the album cover. He's starting to get even more recognition now for the stuff which he has done for HUMAN REMAINS and REVE-NANT, so he's making a good name for himself! The reason we really dig him is because that he's an exellent scilled artist, with a pretty twisted and unique style!

- Ok, back to your music. Do you're feel that completely different from the band you were, when you band you were, when you released your first demo? On which field do you think that you've progressed the most?

We're not totally different, 'coz it's the same band, but we've matured alot since our first demo! On the first you the obvious could see influences of KREATOR and SLAYER. I'd say that on our second demo we started heading off into our own direction. But especially the more newer stuff is much more mature and diverse, just as heavy and intense as the older stuff, we've definately progressed to a point where we can control what we wanna do. - Your voice is pretty special, do you use any effects? No, I use no effects, because

basically I'm trying to convay a more angry and frustrated sound in my voice. I keep the effects out of my voice! - What are you inspired of? Favourite bands?

Well, earlier on we were especially inspired by SLAYER and KREATOR. But then begun to listen to underground stuff like MORBID ANGEL. Everyone has their own musical taste, so we have tons and tons of influences!!

- Try to descripe CORPSE's music!? RIPPING

We're just trying to be as

original, at the same heavy, sick, diverse, technical, brutal and intense as we can be. And hopefully it all comes out fairly original!

- Have you got any new songs ready? Titles?

We have a load of new material! 14 songs! About 45 minutes... Some titles include "Pyreoflies", "Growing anicent with the cold", "Keep the misery alive", "The hate eternal"... and many many more

yet to come!
- What will the next release
with RIPPING CORPSE be? When?
We'll record a demo for labels
soon! Depending on what that
does for us, wether we sign to
another label, that'll depend
on what our next release will
be! Hopefully you'll see

something around early '93! - Mention some of the bands that you've played live with!! We've gigged with many, many bands! The bigger names will KREATOR. SEPULTURA, OBITUARY, MORBID ANGEL, ENTOMBED, UNLEASHED, D.R.I., SICK OF IT ALL, BIOHAZARD... ANGEL. D.R.I., local and undergound bands that we've played with include REVENANT, INCANTATION, HUMAN REMAINS, NOKTURNEL, DECEASED, and tons and tons of bands! I'll say that our biggest gig was a KREATOR gig. where there was about 2000 people. Our favourite show that we've played gotta be with MORBID ANGEL, ENTOMBED and UNLEASHED! It was a really intense show!! - Are you thinking about doing a video?

Well, we don't have a label to give us monry to do a video, and we sure as hell can't afford one! Although we'd love to do one, we have alot of visual concepts for alot of our songs. Anyway, we would never be alloweded to be played on MTV if we did a video, 'xoz it would be very extreme, something like an "Evil dead" movie!!

- Do you have some stuff for sale right now?

Yeah, we do have merchandise!! We have two-sided t-shirts, that are 178 postage paid, we

have shorts that are 17\$ postage paid, we have hats that are 10\$ p.p., we have the "Dreaming..." Cd it costs 14\$ p.p. and the cassette with "Dreaming..." costs 10\$ p.p.!! — Why isn't your real logo on the LP?

That's one of the problems that we had with MAZE REC. They basically kept us in the dark about the graphics on the album. They used the logo that on the LP without our approval, and at the time we found out about it it would have costed alot of changing it, and that would have delayed the LP even more, and we didn't wanted that, time Next definately have our real logo on the LP!!

- Any closing words?

Thanks alot for the interview!! Hopefully we'll be seing you live overthere this winter, if things work out and we're alive and well! We have tons of new material, which we're happy with, and hopefully you'll be seing a LP with us too pretty soon! Take it easy and stay blunted!!

I hope that you enjoyed this interview, 'coz I sure enjoyed doing it!! If you haven't got "Dreaming..." then go and buy it right away, you won't regret, that's for sure!!

Since the first issue of PEARDROP zine hit the streets in 89,we printed 74 interviews, 78 articles, 242 albums/ep reviews, and 317 demo reviews (you're so clever, Laurent).

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Swedish LEUKEMIA are pretty different from most other swedish bands, and I found their "Innosence is Bliss" demo, as a quite original demo, so I send Kentha (drums) a bunch of questions, which he answered this way:

- A little background info on LEUKEMIA, please!! guys, we're LEUKEMIA! metal band (??? ed.) heavy formed back in '89 under a monicker. What different counts is our demo "Innosence is bliss", which was recorded in December and released in mid January (1991 ed.), think. What ever we may have done before isn't of my interrest, as this tape shows where and what we are: Just another ENTOMBED clone, ha ha! Your latest release "Innosence..." Demo, tell me something about it!! It's 23 minutes of killerquality death-thrash with more originality than what comes out of Morrysound in 365 days. The sound is totally perfect, as it's recorded in the famous Right now Sunlight Studio. there's about 40-60 tapes left of it (we printed 500), so when this briliant magazine is out (He he!), it'll be totally sold out & then hopefully our debut album will be availble. But more of that in another question...

How has the response on "Innosence..." been?
Totally killer exept for Forsberg of TRIBULATION, who didn't like it, I think. Peaceville didn't like it either, but it was actually them who wrote & asked for it.

The reviews have been very good and I think that's the way it should be, as we're damn good, ha ha!!

- Are you satisfied with "Innosence..."?
As apeshit! I'm damn satisfied with it. My oppinion is that it's the best demo I've ever heard, period! The vocals are extremely good, my accoustic guitarparts and drumming are good. The bass and guitar work by HOUSE OF USHER's Mattias is phenomenal! Thanks to you Kenko, du ar Olle's brorsa. Everybody, support HOUSE OF USHER!

- Is "Innosence..." the cause

why you've signed to Slaughter Records? Will they release your debut album?
We don't really know, nor do we care as long as I can listen to it myself. Slaughter has already sent a contract, but we'll at least look after something bigger. Yeah, "I.I.B." is the reason to our label interrests. Thanks god it wasn't our first demo, that caught any interrest!

- Have you completed the "forthcomming" album?
Fat chance! This thursday & sunday we'll do vocals & my accoustic guitar parts, then



there is all these backing vocals by famous vocalists + the mixing, that will take quite some time. So there's quite much left to do.

- Are you satisfied with "So never"? (That's the album's

title. ed.)

As fuck! And all of you who liked the demo will definately go total apeshit about this album!

- Tell the readers something

about "So never"!

There'll be 9 songs, I think. "Into the morgue", "You es of ey", "Wandering", "Different but same", Everything fall apart", "Uncarved miseria" all the demo tracks exept from "Alms"!! About 55 minutes of music, if I haven't already said that ...?

- Are the songs on "So never" in the same vein as the songs

on "Innosence..."? Quite alike, I think. Though half a tune more downtuned. We've also become more fast/ slow/brutal/melodic or whatever. There's even a track on it, that we would catogorize as Death metal! At least it's Death metal to us!

- Who'll be drawing the cover? Paw Nielsen. I like what he's doing, though most of his stuff reminds of each other. Just like Seagrave. Actually I'm not sure anymore if we'll

take Paw ...

- How many gigs have you done so far? About 3 or 4. Nothing to brag

about.

- What do you think of playing gigs? Who have you gigged with?

It's so damn fun to play gigs, and it makes you feel like a rock-star, ha ha!! If the crowd is fairly drunk that is! We've gigged with INTERMENT or BEYOND, DOGA, MESSALINA, & a few others. We've played twice in CSFR. We were really bad, but what the heck.

- If you had the opputunity to choose exactly who to play with, who would you then prefer?

GRAVE, MESUGGAH, & ATHEIST!

- Does LEUKEMIA have any merchandise for sale? Not really. Not right now anyway. We have the design for our new t-shirt, so they're on the way. I don't know, if the album is out when you read this, but try out with a letter & I'll let you know. There's quite alot asking about the t-shirts so have your money ready!

- How is it like living in Sweden, I mean there's so many Death/Thrash bands, that there must be a big competition in

between the bands?

It's cool! Some can't take our competition, but it's cool. We have our friends & they have theirs. Greetings goes out to GRAVE for all their killer support!! No greetings to Fredda of UNLEASHED, but hi to the rest of them.

- Your 4 swedish fave bands!? GRAVE, HOUSE OF USHER,

MACABRE & us!

- Do you think that all the bands, which gets signed these days deserve it?

Not at all. I wonder why bands like NECRONY gets signed as they suck major penis! But if you are a death metal band, you will get signed sooner or later, doesn't matter if you are good or not. Too much crap is getting signed & the good bands are missed most often. It's a shame! Though Anders of NECRONY is ok, but the musik suck!

What do you draw your musical and lyrical influences

from?

From myself and naturally from bands I listen to. As I write everything myself it's natural that the same topics ends up in the lyrics I do, but just different formulated same). But they still deal with the same kind of topics.

- Would you ever, no could you ever consider to write a gore lyric?

Don't think so. Not LEUKEMIA anyway. morgue" is the goriest I've ever done, but then it was not just as a done to serious

provocation to death metal. It took about 15 minutes to complete it & there are bands, who spend hours on such lyrics & does it dead-serious. Our lyrics will be on the album so read them yourself & make up your own mind. I love you Bjarke!! (You do what?? ed.)

- I know that you are also doing a 'zine called HYPNOSIA, give the readers some facts about it!!

Ok, it's pure quality. Printed with killerphotos & shrunk text. No. 3 is still availble in 40-50 copies for 3\$ or 20 Sek. 80 pages A5. Next issue is in A4 & with about 64 pages. It'll take a while before it's out, as my economy is really bad. Bands, do as you always do to me; Send dead rats! All mail answered!

- What is your general oppinion on 'zines?

They're too bad. There are not many good ones around. Maybe 10 or something. I wish all editors could put some mind into the lay-out & make it look good. And atleast try to print it or atleast screen the photos.

- Which 'zines are your faves?
I WONT DANCE, TRECHOMA,
THANATOGRAPHY, HYPNOSIA, ISTEN
and some more!

Jocke has been involved in a serious car accident, for how long was he at the hospital? Did the car accident have any consequence for LEUKEMIA?

Nah, we only had 1 year of official standstill while I just kept on writing new stuff:

- Da da da, it's time for some last sentences; any closing words Kentha?

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

A guy called Adwin runs the label is a cool guy, and it's the coolest things that he release, so I decided that I would support him by writing something about him. So far he has released UTUMO - The light of day 7", HUMAN REMAINS - Admirations most deep and foul 7", GOREFEST - Live misery 7", ROTTREVORE - Fornication in delirium 7", SJØLMORD - Weird as fuck and UTUMO - TBA mini-LP/CD. All the releases are professionally made, the lay-out and the sound-quality is in top. Adwin is really ambitious about his label, and I'm sure that CENOTAPH RECORDS will be big someday. The 7"es 6S, and the money is well given out! Also remember to ask him about his future releases! CENOTAPH RECORDS, Zdl. Achterweg 42, 4424 CT Wemeldinge, Holland.



After having heard ACONIZE's brilliant "Fall" demo, I decided, that I had to know more about this brilliant band! So I send vocalist Ole Holm some questions, which he glady answered.

- Some AGONIZE bandhistory....
Well, to make a long story short:
AGONIZE as it is, was formed in the
autumn of 1990, when Marco joined the
band. Since then we rehearsed for
about a year, yhen we recorded our
debut demo in october '91. We're now
working on new material, and playing
as many gigs as possible.

- Recently you've released your first demo, "Fall", are you satisfied with

it?

Yeah, we're extremely satisfied with the way "Fall" turned out, aswell as the good response we've gotten. However, our next release will be much better!

- What do you think about being in studio?

I think it's really great being in a studio, it's just like a great holiday, something you'll allways remember with joy. Being in a studio, is also a great learning experience for a band, it's a real challenge showing how good a band works.

- How much time did you spend in the studio during the recording of "Fall"? In all, we spend 3 days in the studio: 2½ days os recordings, and ½ day of mixing. Compaired to other bands that's really short, but then again we

didn't have anymore money!

- How has the response on "Fall" been, and how many copies have you sold?

We've gotten incredibly good response on "Fall", and that's really great! However we're not selling particularly many copies, which really sucjs, since we owe a lot of money away. All in all we've sold about 300 copies.

Have you send any demos to labels? Has any labels showed interrest in you?

I'm glad to say, that we've practicly only gotten killer-reviews so far! Everyone seems to like "Fall" very much, and that's really great. We wanted to collect some killer-reviews, before contacting any labels, and we've started doing that now. However

we've been contacted by 6 labels, so far, among them are: METAL BLADE, RAGE, TURBO, NUCLEAR BLAST and WILD RAGS.

- Do you think, that you're ready for a deal?

Well, that depends on what kind of a deal we get. At the moment we're not quite ready for a LP, since we don't have enough good tracks yet. An EP deal however would be great! - How many songs have you got?

So far we've only got the "Fall" tracks, and one new track. Recently we replaced our drummer, and have been busy with teaching him the songs, so there hasn't been much time for new material.

- Give the readers an insight of your lyrics!

Our lyrics are quite complicated lyrics. They are to descripe the psychological ways of man in different depressive situations. The lyrics on "Fall" all descripe ordinary individuals, living in their lives "Fall". I read a lot of psychology and philosophy, and writing these lyrics gives me great satisfaction.

- How would you descripe AGONIZE's

music?

I think I would descripe our music as Death Metal, but then that's just my oppinion. If people consider it Death Thrash or whatever, that's ok with us. We don't want to label ourselves. I think we've found our own style, and what you might call it doesn't really matter.

- What inspires you?
We're mainly inspired by our own thoughts and ideas, but also the music we listen to.

- Are you only into Death Metal?
No, not at all. We all listen to all kinds of music, mostly progressive and original music. Being open-minded is very important to a musican, who wants to develop.

- How many times have you played live? What do you think about playing live? Are you planning to

play outside Denmark? Since our demo release, we've played live 5 times. Playing live is the greatest thing. We hope to play tons of gigs in the future, and allready we've planned some. If any of them would be outside Denmark, we don't know yet.

- Recently you played a gig with MASTER, but it didn't turn out as planned, please tell, what happend!

well, the gig was fairly good. The problem was MASTER and especially their manager. I guess they've completely forgotten that once they weren't bigger than we are. They were a good example of typical star-fuckers. Their show was a real failure, and I guess they didn't like, that a couple of people came to see us.

- What do you think of the danish

scene?

The danish scene is growing fast, and that's really great! There are lots of bands, and some of them are really good. I think it's great, and I think that if you have the will, you can get far.

- Did you use any vocal-effects on "Fall"?

No, we didn't use any vocaleffects 'cause that really sucks! What wouldn't people say, if they heard you live, and your voice wasn't nearly as brutal as on the tape. No, we don't use any effects.

- I know, that you practise a lot, how do you get time for it? Don't

any of you guys work?

Well, we're 100% into the band, and so much practising is natural for us. We are all students, exept one, but myself and Christian are done this summer, and we'll proberly start practising even more!

- I've heard a lot of people complaining about your logo (no offense!! ed.), why is it the way it is, and have you ever

considered changing it?

Well, I'm sorry to hear that, we all think our logo is quite good, and fairly original. I suppose it's a little hard to read, but then again it's much easier than most Death Metal logos! You don't say, what people was complaining about, so we wouldn't know what to change! Besides that is just a logo. Take logos like SLAYER, DEICIDE, PESTILENCE etc. They are not really nice, but that's just the way they are. It's something you never think about.

- What will your next release be? Well, I guess we'll release a promo-tape for labels and 'zines in order to get a deal. We'll record it sometime within the next 6 months.

- How does AGONIZE's future look like?

AGONIZE's future look very bright indeed. We are all very enthausiastic and 100% into the band, and our hard work has really payed off. We intend to take it as far as it goes.

- Any closing words for this int.? Yeah, thanks to you Bjarke, for the interview! Good luck with your 'zine! To the readers: Buy our demo



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GRAVE om Swede are by my oppinon one of the better swedish bands with a deal. Well, GRAVE aren't exactly original, they are more or less "ordinary", but yet they have a little more to offer "ordinary" most other bands.. I'm really looking forward to hear GRAVE's second album, 'coz I think that it'll blow away their debut! But I guess that we'll just have to wait and see about that! This interview was done, when they played in Copenhagen ._ along with MASSACRE and DEMOLITION a long (to HAMMER. After long!!) wait I finally got in touch with Jörgen who answered my questions, while Ola sat and admired his new tatoo. A special thank goes to Rodney for making this Dunsmore interview possible!

- Ok, what do you think of touring? Do you like it?

I like to be around playing, but the worst thing is that we don't get home with any money. - So you don't earn anything? We're earning, but we have to pay it again, for the bus and stuff like that.

- By the way, how did you get the deal with Century Media? It's a pretty long story. Carsten from MORGOTH phoned us up, and then he wa like that Robert from Century Media was interrested. We phoned Robert up, and he said "come down to "come down to did some Germany". We recordings, he liked them, and so he signed us for 7 years.

Are Century Media a good label for you?

Yeah, they're good!

- What have you relased all together? one demo back in '87 under the name CORPSE (the name before

ed.), the demo was GRAVE called "Black dawn". And we did 3 GRAVE demos, the first one was called (then I can't hear the title. ed.), the second one was called (Sorry! I can't hear that either. ed.), and the third one was called "Anatomia corpsis humani". And a '7" The "Tremendous Pain": "Into the grave", and a split album with the english band called EVOLUTION (on Prophecy Rec./UK. ed.). - How is it to live in Sweden? It's cool! It's expensive, but

we like it!

- You live on a little island, don't you? We used to, but we've moved to

Stockholm.

- You're grown up now ...? Yeah, he he!

- Do you think that there's to between much competiton bands in Sweden?

Naaah... It's more like, I don't know... But the new bands are sort of trying to copy each other, I mean, like in between, let's say TIAMAT, UNLEASHED, DISMEMBER, and all the ones who was in the beginning, and everyone everyone totally supported each other, so we don't compete to each other, we're supporting each other!

- Who do you think are the best bands in Sweden?

Ehh, well ENTOMBED, the best TIAMAT, DISMEMBER, is LEUKEMIA - they're good, real good!

- It seems as you have changed style a bit since your last demo, "Anatomia..." to your album, "Into the...", do you think that you have become more "nice"?

No! Maybe we've matured alot, because that demo is a kind of... We had to prove that we could be brutal, and we tuned down to fucking, I don't know, to E, it was like ridiculous.

So your're not satisfied with that demo anymore?

really. The songs are good, but the sound It's ridiculous! fuckingutal

It's brutal, but it's not good at all!

- What do you feel that you

are inspired of?

Hmm, well all kinds of stuff, like movies, all kinds of stuff we listen to and so on. - For instance what? What do you listen to?

I listen to old stuff, like KISS and BLACK SABBATH, but I also listen to death metal!

- Why isn't there any lyric sheet along with "Into "? We didn't just feel to put them on.

- So your're not proud of your

lyrics ...?

We don't have anything against them, but we just didn't feel to put them on.
- Is there any way the fans

can obtain the lyrics?

I don't know. I don't know if Century Media will print them up, they're supposed to do that, but I don't know if they did it ...

- Is "In love" a love song? No, that's a necrophiliac song. (I thought so. ed.)

- How did you manage to get on MASSACRE and with DEMOLITION HAMMER?

Well, we did did an U.S. tour with them, and the booking agencythought, that we could go on this tour as well.

- What made you play death metal? Why do you play death

metal?

For the fun, mostly. I mean, it's the thinng that we like

to do, so we do it!

- The reason why I'm asking the next question is that GRAVE's old bassist had just left them, and Jörgen had taken over the bass. - Will you remain as a 3 piece band? I don't know, maybe ... We are gonna try to find somebody to play bass, but if we can't find any, which fits in the band, we'll stay as a 3 piece, and maybe get a kind of a stand in bassplayer on tours and stuff like that.

- When will the world see the next release with GRAVE? The next will be a LP. We're

gonna record in June.

- Will it also be recorded at Sunlight?

Yeah, and it's proberly going to be released like August or something near that.

- Have you got all the new songs ready?

We've got 5 new ones and 3 old nes. We think that the new ones are real good.

- Thanks for the interview! Well, thank you!!


- The word is yours now ... Well, the word is Ola's... (Ole goes:) We look forward to release our new album and finish this tour. Do some new songs, do another record, a new one. Hope you enjoyed the show tonight! (I sure did! ed.) We appreciate anyone who came here tonight, it was really good!

And so GRAVE ends this interview. To everyone who hasen't got GRAVE's debut, I've got one thing to say: Go and buy it! It's worth the money! I think that their next will be nothing less than a killer. GRAVE sure are among Sweden's best, and they're here to stay!



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In my oppinion DARK QUILITY have suceeded in creating something different the ordinary thrash. Just listen to their "A moonclad reflection". The way D.T. combines aggressiveness with melody, is just so great, and this band deserves all the support it can get, so I here bring you an interview with Niklas (guitar)...

- Let's start with a little band-bio!?

Hmm.. I'll keep it short; DARK TRANQUILITY was formed in late '89, we released a rehearseldemo in August '90, a studiodemo, "Trail of life decayed" in june '91, and our latest effort, the 7" EP "A moonclad reflection" was released in July '92, quite recently in other words. That was a very brief conclusion of our "career", but I'll tell in depht later.

- What's the line-up, and for how long has each member played his instrument?

We've kept the same line-up since the start, so here goes: Martin bass, Fridén vocals, Mikael - guitar, Jivarp - drums and me, Niklas - guitar. We have an average playing experience of about 3½ of something, so we're not any virotouses yet. I do think pretty competent musicans, especially drummer, and we're improving all the time. If anyone

wonders, we're 18-19 years old...
- You used to be a fun band

called SEPTIC BOILER ed.), why did you choose to be a fun

band in the first row? Well, when we formed the band we anticipated that we weren't going to be satisfied with our music in, say one year, after the formation, so we regarded it useless to start up a 100 dedicated and serious only to have been regretting it afterwords. We decided to try things out and just paly for fun in a year or so, and see how things devoloped. If we thought the attitude and chemestry between bandmembers was right and we started to feel confident in our abilities, then we would change the monicker of band, and redefine approacj towards the serious areas of music. soon knew that we believed enough in our music, but it took a long time to find the right name, and fit a loge into our lyrical concept. It really had to be a definate name-change. A lot of new bands change their name twice a month, and basically are getting nowhere 'cause they change members even often, and we wanted to avoid to fiddle around with such things. Anyway. "officially" we changed our name into DARK TRANQUILITY about 2 years ago, and we're still satisfied with the name, So if anyone thinks jokeband, who changed our name and music to cash in on the death metal trend, they're dead wrong! There was never a change of music with the name, just a huge development in all relevant areas between "Enfeebled earth" reh. demo and "T.O.L.D.", and as explained we planned change the first name all the time, we just wanted to check out, if we could play together

- Was it "T.O.L.D." which secured you the K.P. deal with Slaughter Records?

Yes, of course it was that demo that drew attention to band. Slaughter Records offered us a LP/MC/CD deal in '91, but December negoziated it down to a 7" since we wanted try out the label first and see if could work well together. We did recieve several offers on "Trail...", strength of but Slaughter Rec. had the best deal so far.

- How has the underground recieved your previous releases?

As I said, the demo got really good response, and the few EP reviews we've seen are even better. Slaughter Rec. will send the EP to 50 'zines which means great coverage for us, so let's wait a couple of months and I've read more reviews.

- You have also been featured on some comp. tapes, why is that? What is your general oppinion on comp. tapes?

Generally, comp. tapes are good, of course! They help spreding around the band's music, even if I think that a lot of comp. tapes don't sell more than 80-100 copies. can't say I've a fave comp. tape, usually there are some and some bad featured. Why we wanna appear on comp. tapes? Make a guess! - I know that you draw a lot, will it be you, who will draw the cover to your forthcomming EP - "A moonclad..."? Yep, that's exactly

Yep, that's exactly right! I've drawn the EP front - and backcover and I'm pleased with both; atmospheric and mystical drawings. As for the "Trail.." 7", the cover will be a photograph in full colour!

It seems to me, that an importent aspect in your music is your melodic parts, why are you having all these melodic parts? Do you think that the melodic parts seperates you

from most other swedish bands, who "just" play "ordinary" death metal?

No, I think our fast parts are dissimilar to the usual swedish style as well. I wouldn't say we have melodic parts of segments in our tracks. I like to think of the whole songs as melodic. We are of the oppinion, that clear and audible riffs are alot more aggressive than dark and muddy riffs. You're right when you say, that melody is vital part in D.T.'s music, and I can say that our most recent material is 100% more melodic than the tracks. It's a deevlopment I'm really satisfied with, and I'm also pleased to say that we haven't lost any aggression in the process. Some new tracks "Nightfall by include shore of time", My faeryland forgotten" - proberly our fastest ever, "Alone" - A moody doom ballad, and another one with no title yet. Right we're working on entirely accoustic possibly instrumental, but we may be able to fit some vocals

- Is any of D.T.'s members involved with other bands?

Yes, our drummer is a sessionmember of great deathsters CEREMONIAL OATH 7" (exellent out now Corpsegrinder Rec., LP/CD on Intellectual Convulsion Rec. in the autumn) since their drummer is doing his military service. Also, our guitarist and him have a cover band, together with some other local people and they rehearse once a week or so, playing good old MANOWAR tunes and the likes. Apart from, none in D.T. are involved in any other band. Last summer though, our drummer and guitarist (again) had a totally great grindproject called MORBID HELL running. They rehearsed one time before recording their demo, which has sold approx. 1 copy. Do miss it!

- What/where do you draw your influences from?

I don't know ... We listen to all kinds of different music within the band, so we have different influences. Personally I can mention BLIND GUARDIAN, IRON MAIDEN, SABBAT, HELLOWEEN & ROTTING CHRIST among my faves, but I can't sav we sound like a mix of these bands at all. I leave it to other to descripe catogorize our sound, we just paly and try to come up with something innovative interresting to listen to. "Melodic and varied Deathwith atmosphere, originality and aggression" may be a fittin description, but I'm not the one to say it. - How often does D.T. rehears? Usually 2-3 times a week. Now in the summer a bit less due to vacations and work. at rehearse our other guitarist's garage - not the best of places, but it's cheap and we live close to each other, so we don't have to travel all over the world to play.

- How do you think that D.T.'s

future looks like?

Who knows? I'm confident in our newest material, it's tons better than the demo and the EP. Of course we hope for an album deal, but if nothing happends, I presume a new D.T. demo or promotape will surface in early '93, hopefully with 4 or 5 songs. At the moment we're eager to promote the EP, and the forthcoming demo-EP-BUY THEM!!

- Do you know of any danish

bands?

KING DIAMOND, if that counts, INVOCATOR of course... They're ok, but nothing special, old TIMID (POLLUTION) - Ole of T.E.D. 'zine's band, which I can't/ remember how sounded, HOSTS OF CHAOS, whose live-recording was pretty good ... I know, that I've heard more danish bands, but I always forget names

don't tapetrade anymore, so there's a lot of new bands, which I haven't heard. I can say, that danish 'zines are of really high standard; VICIOUS, TRECHOMA, SACROFORMITY (is that right?) (Yep, you're right! ed:), etc.! - Well Niklas, will you close this interview? thanks for Well, this interview, Bjarke, and good luck with NAGUAL and your band the future! CONVULSE are hailing from Finland, and they are actually one the better finnish bands! I thought, that their debut LP ("World without god" ed.), was a pretty good debut, so I send Rami (gui/voc) a couple of questions...

Some band-bio!?

We formed in '88 under the name S.D.S. In '90 we changed the name to CONVULSE, while the music turned into death metal. A couple of demos, like "Resuscitation of evilness". One LP "World...", + a new promotape "04/92". Some line-up changes, Jani is not in the band anymore, he's replaced by Toni of PURTENANCE. I/Rami don't sing anymore, 'coz it's to difficult to sing and play solo-guitar at the same time. Our new vocalist is Timo of PURTENANCE.

How does it feel having released a LP?

Not so special...

How did you get the deal with THRASH Recs.? How is the deal? We send our "R.O.E." demo to Pat/THRASH Recs., and he offered a LP-deal for us and we accepted it. He promissed also CD-format & T-shirt, but he didn't fullfill his promises so it gave a bad taste for us. We do absolutely not do anything with THRASH Records anymore!!

Are you satisfied with "World without god"?

Not anymore, we did it all to fast and we had to use almost three years old tracks. Anyway it was our debut album, and it gave us a little bit of a "name". You know what I mean!? Your lyrics are pretty satanic are you a satanic band? Are your lyrics importent to you? They were evil and blasphemous, but not satanic from my oppinion. I despise the way which religious people spread their message! They think that the world is black and white.

I mean good and evil. Okey ...

now back to the matter of

point. Our lrics are importent to me, or infact to us, 'cos Timo and I make the lyrics together now. They are from power of clean nature. (What? ed.) Dark feelings - depressiions etc. There are surrealistic lyrics Tell me about the cover to "World...."!? Who has painted it? What does it mean? It's a gloomy gothic church. Mia Rassa, one woman from our hometown has painted it. Why did you choose to entitle your debut LP "World...."? Because the world where I live is without gof. I'm the only true master. How has the response on "World without..." Been? Positive! Some have critized the missing originality and I agree. Our new

agree. Our new style (Promotape "04/92") has divided oppinions in two. Some like it, and some just say "It's well played, but...". I understand this, 'cos our music is much to melodic and soft for most dedicated death & black metal fans. Make your own oppion after listening to our new stuff!

What have you been doing since "World...." was released?
Done a couple of shows. Mostly we have been writing new tracks. Things going great for us!

What does CONVULSE's members do, when they're not playing in CONVULSE?

Drink and sleep. (That's original. ed.)

What do you draw your influences from?

Lyrically or musically? Musically we are influenced by old heavy and new rock/funk music. Different moods inspires me lyrically, 'cos most of those moods are so strong, that writing lyrics doesn't make any problems.

Have you played live a lot? Who have you played with? Have

you ever played live outside Finland? We have played about 30 shows almost every finnish death metal band. We haven't played abroad yet. Do you get a lt of mail? Do you like recieving mail? much! About to letters per day. It's cool to answer mail, if you have got the time. But sometimes it makes me nervous, 'cos I'm a very busy man. Any new songs ready? "Years of the decay", "The green is grey", "Memories", "Lost equilbrium" and "The new beginning". How is the finnish scene? I think that there's quite a lot young death metal bands, but I don't know exact, 'cos I don't listen to death metal anymore. We listen to RED HOT CHILIPEPPERS, DOORS, THOUSAND YARD STARE, RIDE, PEARL JAM, THE CURE, etc. etc. What'll your next release be? A LP/CD! Out in the end of this year, or in the beginning of next year. The label is german SPV/STEAMHAMMER. A 7" EP will proberly come out at first, by RELAPSE RECS., but it's not sure yet. Futureplans? Make a LP - a good one! Amarrgghh - here it comes: Any last words? Thanks to you! (You are weled.) Order our white double sided T-shirt. The price is 12\$ (Europe) and 14\$ (Overseas). Bye and stay cool! Well, I hope that you learned something out of this interview! I don't know wether I prefer CONVULSE's old nor the material, but one thing is sure - they have definately become more original! They're now search-

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MACERATION from Dermark are one of the only danish (Death Metal) bands with a deal. They had signed to TURBO MUSIC, but then suddenly TURBO started to act wierd, and MACERATION then quit TURBO. A new label called PROGRESS RED LABEL instead of TURBO release MACERATION's debut LP, I thought, that all this was a bit messy, so I contacted Lars Bangsholt (Guitar), to know more about what exactly had happend.

- When was MACERATION formed, and who got the idea?

MACERATION was formed back in the beginning of 1990, and it was started by me and Jacob Hansen and a guy called Rune, but he's out now.

- How many demos have you done?

We have only done one live-tape, and that tape really sucks, we really hate that tape, and we don't

sell it anymore.

- You signed to TURBO MUSIC, who were going to release your first LP, but now you're not on TURBO anymore, and they're not going to release your debut, what has

happend?

Yes, we signed to TURBO MUSIC, and we recorded our debut LP "A seranade of agony", and we were really happy with TURBO, they promissed us a tour and promissed us to pay for the studio time, but they never fulfilled the promisses, and then we fucking cancelled the contract, so you can say, that we have been ripped off by TURBO MUSIC, so here from goes a big FUCK OFF to TURBO MUSIC!!

Who will then release your debut? A new startet label called PROGRESS RED LABEL have bought the rights for the album and they will soon release it, but only in copies, and only on CD.

- How did you get Jacob + Jakob (both INVOCATOR ed.) and Dan (EDGE OF SANITY ed.) to play on the LP?

Because when we recorded the album (Jakob) Schultz and Jacob were real members of MACERATION, not just stand-in members, the reason why we asked Dan to do the vocals were, that we couldn't find any singer in our area that we liked, but now both of Jacob are out Schultz and MACERATION. because thev have concentrate 100% on INVOCATOR, but I have found new members that (maybe) are even better than Schultz and Jacob.

- Do you think, that you've got a

steady line-up by now?

Yes, I think so. Our new line-up is (guitar), Lukas Meier Meier(Drums) (both play in SACRIFICIAL aswell ed.) and Jacob on bass, but we still need a singer.

- How was it to be in a studio? I doubt that TURBO payed for your studio time, did you pay for it yourselves?

Was it expensive?

It was a really great experience, we had a lot of fun. Yeah, TURBO should have payed for the studio-time, but they never did (Fuck 'em!), the studio time costed 2500 US dollars for five days, I think that's real cheap.

- Are you satisfied with production on

"A seranade of agony"?

Yeah, we're really satisfied with the recordings, but we are not satisfied with the mixing, we could have done that a lot better.

- Do you think, that "A seranade...." representation good a MACERATION?

Yes I think so, "A serenade...." isn't original but still I think it's a lot better, than all the new Death Metal bands, or am I wrong or what?

- What do you think of Jacob + Jakob

and Dan's "real" bands?

I love INVOCATOR, they are a real cool band, I allso like EDGE OF SANITY, Dan is a real unique person, he is god!

- Which song is your fave MACERATION

must be "Pain and pleasure That incarnate".

 Tell the readers about the songs on "A seranade...."!

Lyrically I don't know, because I'm not writing the lyrics, musically it's bands like MASSACRE, SANCTUARY, DARK ANGEL, DEATH, DEVASTATION (Chicago R.I.P.), SINDROME etc.

- For how long time have you played guitar? Who's your fave guitarist? I have played guitar for about two years now, my fave guitarist is Shawn

years now, my fave guitarist is Shawn Kelly from RIPPING CORPSE, I also like Mike Davis from NOCTURNUS.

- Will MACERATION go on tour soon to promote "A seranade..."?

I don't think so, because we haven't got the money for it, but we proberly will go on a Denmark tour.

- How many times have you played live? What do you think about playing live?

We have played live four times, it's really fun to play live, I love it. Lots of headbanging and stage-diving, it's really great!

- Your upper goal with MACERATION?

To make a new record. To make a decent name in the underground, and sell a lot of records.

- Futureplans?

To make a new and much better record and find a new singer.

Ok, it's time to end this int...

Any last words?

Thanks for this interview and good luck with your 'zine!! Look out for our debut CD "A seranade..."!!

Well, it seems as Lars' futureplans will come through - once again MACERATION have had a lineup change. They're still looking for a bassist, but they've found a singer - Jesper from ICONO-CLASM! "A seranade..." should be out by now - buy it! MACERATION can be contacted at this adress

EMANZIPATION is the name of a fine danish 'zine. The first issue was released in May '92, it contains 16 interviews, reviews and stuff like that, and then the famous (!) BEER-

SECTION where most of the interviewed bands tell about their beerhabbits, and some danish beers are also reviewed. No. 1 is sure a great 'zine, considering that it's "only" a debut. Most of the interviews in no. 1 was made live, and in the second issue the main part of the interviews are also made live: NAPALM DEATH, DISMEMBER, OBITUARY, CONFESSOR, NOCTURNUS etc. The editor, Michael, is a real open-minded person, and he is not only into death metal! Some of his fave bands include PARADISE LOST, NIRVANA, DEATH, FAITH NO MORE, CARCASS, METALLICA, CYNIC, AGONIZE, NAPALM DEATH and PEARL JAM. No. 1 contains 44 A5 pages, and no. 2 will proberly contain 36 A4 pages. No. 2 is also going to be more packed than no. 1, and I'm sure that it's gonna be a shredding one!! Esbjerg has been unofficially voted as Denmark's death/thrash capitol. I can't say if it's true or not, but there's a grain of truth in it. Lately other parts of Denmark has been breeding new bands, which is really good. As far as the

Esbjerg-area goes, a lot of things are happening here...

First off there hass been some quite serious line-up problems in the great thrash metal band CHIRO THERILM. After their debut demo (under the name CHIRO THERI-UM) "First Chapter", they lost their bassplayer Esban. A new bassplayer was recruited in Per Jakobsen, plus a second guitarist Torben Tanghej joined P.O., Simon and Carsten. But things didn't quite work out, so Torben Tanghøj left, and after that Carsten Nielsen (drums) left also. And as if that wasn't enough, their bassplayer Per left to join INVOCATOR. So far they have no replacements, but they P.O. (vocals) and Simon (guitar) will not give up. There is a rumour going on that Per M. Jensen of INVOCATOR will play session-drums on a demo soon to come.

Should be really cool! So keep an eye on CHIRO THERIUM!

A demo released last year was CAUSTIC's debut, which was highly acclaimed spite the quite poor, but brutal sound made on a 4-track cassette recorder. Their new demo "Timid Reality" was recently recorded on 16-tracks and this is truely Esbjerg can be proud of, even though it's very much PARADISE LOST inspired. Not that the aforementioned inspiration source is anything bad, but I just think CAUSTIC hasn't got enough of their own ideas yet. That will soon come, I'm sure. Remarkable are Søren Jansens superb vocals. Nobodv does it like him! "Timid Reality" should be out while you read this...

Speaking about demo's...LUTCHCRAFT is a three-giri one-guy-band (!) which has just released their strange debut demo "Uncertain Facts". How can I explain their music ?! I mean, it's actually quite cool: brutal, growling, female vocals and tight riffing, but the songs are just so...happy! WITCHCRAFT claim also that their music is "happy thrash". I couldn't agree more! New songs are being made right now

for a second demo.

ICONOCLASM must be one of the most suprising bands to release a debut demo. I really was shocked when I heard the final result. It's slow, brutal death. Very mean, and with deep, deep growling vocals. Their demo is called "Obscurity" and features three songs. A minus for this demo is, that the songs tend to be just a little bit monotonous in the long run. Anywey, get hold of this great death metal demo ! NOW! I think they're looking for a second guitarist at the moment. They were supposed to recruit Lars Bangsholt of MACERATION, but things didn't work out, as far as I know.

Speaking about MACERATION, which was supposed to do an album for the late now defunct (rip off) german label Turbo Records, is now signed on Progress Red Labels (who also have danish KONKHRA and DOUBT) for a CD. The bandas future is quite uncertain right now, but I think Lars Bangsholt is looking for nerw mem-

bers to re-form MACERATION.

EIDETIC, one of my fave bands from Esbjerg, released their 2nd demo "Mirror Passway" around April. This demo is really a rager in progressive stuff...not that EIDETIC are any better than so many progressive bands, but I still like EIDETIC a lot. "Mirror Pasaway" is not only my fave demo to come out of Esbjerg, but FIDETIC is also one of the most original bands from here! Lately they have parted ways with main songwriter and guitarist Dan, and a new guy have been recruited. Jonas(bass) and Terje(guitar) are now both writing songs, which should be more melodic and less technical. Should be really cool! Still, I can only recommend

"Mirror Passwav"

DEFAMATORY isn't a well-known band from Esbjerg, but they did release 2 demo's before the departure of their drummer Rene. Now they are trying out more thrash stuff than death metal, which the old stuff was. They are still looking for a drummer while they are doing new songs to complete a demo. I can't wait to hear their new stuff. I'm sure it kills. Very much NASTY SAVAGE-inspired, I'm sure. INVOCATOR have also had some serious line-up changes. Jakob Schultz is out of the band and our former bassplayer Perle Hansen is now playing guitar instead of Schultz. A new bassplayer has been recruited in Per Jakobsen. New songs are being made and a new album is planned to be recorded in Dec. '92. No exact dates vet, though. Some new songs are: "Lost At Birth", "Child In Chains", "Desert Sands" "Land Of Misery" and more.

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This may sound like there aren't many bands around...well, new ones pop up each month, but I really don't know any names yet.

Esbjerg also have some quite cool zines. There's TRECHOMA which is done by Mortan Nissen (who infact is the new singer in EIDETIC!). It's a really good zine and no.3 is on it's way. VICIOUS is another one done by Jens Christensen and Victor Bentzen. A xeroxed, yet very cool rag. I think their third issue is on it's way also with lotsa good stuff. I also heard that two girls should be doing a zine called ZOUNDS. But it's not out yet. SACROFORMITY is maybe the biggest of them all. Printed in colorfront/back and the fifth issue is out while you read this. As far as concerts goes, we have a lot! I can't mention them all, but through the past few years bands like INCUBUS, DISHARMONIC ORCHESTRA, SUFFICATION; OBITUARY, DEMOLITION HAMMER, MASSACRE, MORGOTH, EXHORDER, REVENANT, GOREFEST, DISMEMBER, DARKTHRONE, AFFLICTED, EDGE OF SANITY, ASPHYX, MASTER, BENEDICTION, BOLT THROWER etc etc. have played here! Always supported by local bands. And there are more to come! Most people were present at the MASSACRE, MORGOTH, IMMOLATION, INVOCATOR show. 500 (paying) people, and that's in a city with a population 100.000

Besides that, I'm doing a job as a producer. I have done demo's for bands like CAUSTIC, SACRIFICIAL, WITCHCRAFT, ICONOCLASM, EIDETIC, UNDERTAKER etc + I have mixed and produced AGONIZE's demo and DISASTER AREA's 7". I'm also the sound engineer at some of the aforementioned shows if possible.

Well, I think that was all for now. Please check out all the mentioned bands. They deserve it!

HELL-O guys!! I'm Dave Rotten from DROWNED PRODUCTIONS. Yes, I come from Spain, the ass of Europe!! I'm going to talk you about the unstoppable avalanche of Death/Grind bands that in a short time have emerged in this country. I'll take away of your mind the idea that in Spain there's only sun and absurd bullfights!!

NECROPHILIAC: They're surely the most and best known band from Spain. They're the very first in arising, and since early '89 they've released a bunch of demos like "Endless Death" (live 4/89), "Infernal Exorcism" (10/89), "Necrosion" (Reh. 3/90), "Process Of Empalement" (live 6/90) and "Visceral Fruit" (promo 4/91). I've released a promo tape including "Process Of Empalement" and "Infernal Exorcism" on a tape which is called "Excremental Pregnancy" and who got a quite good response. They've recorded two 7"'s for VIRULENCE REC. (FRA) and SERAPHIC DECAY REC. (USA) that won't be out finally. They've signed a contract with DROWNED PROD./HARD VINYL REC. for two years, and their debut LP entitled "Chaopula. Citadel Of Mirrors" has been recorded in March '92. HUMAN WASTE: This is perhaps the most original band from Spain, playing some kind of Death Metal with MORBID ANGRL/DEATH touches with a very own touch and very raw vocals. Their demo "The Miracle Of Death" (1/91) gave them a name, though they weren't satisfied with the sound. Their 2nd demo "Existential Nausea" (1/91) is their definite demo that will show their great potential. Both demos are out on DROWNED. INTOXICATION: The first band that emerged from the capital!! Their music is an extremely fast and brutal Death/Grind in the vein of CANNIBAL CORPSE. Their debut demo "Erutales Nauseas" (6/91) on DROWNED, and under the monicker of SUFFOCATION, but you may wonder they changed their name!! UNBOUNDED TERROR: Formerly known as PUTREFACT MONSTROSITY, they changed their name just before the release of their demo "Sarcastic Souls" (8/91) in DROWNED. This band has one of the most professional and brutal sound, thing that served to get a two year deal with DROWNED PROD./HARD VINYL REC. Their debut Lp was recorded in May. NEUNTOTER: Is a Grind act near to bands like TERRORIZER, CARCASS or NAPALM DEATH. Their first demo/reh. was awful shit. but in March'91 they recorded a new demo entitled "Consumed In Gore" on a 24-track studio, containing 15 grinding songs. ABSORBED: Hails from the North-east of Spain, and they've got a rehearsal tape with two tracks in the vein of DEATH/MASSACRE which is really brutal. Their debut demo "Unreal Overflows" has been recorded in the same studios as OBSCURE, HUMAN WASTE and OFFENSE. It's out on DROWNED PRODUCTIONS, and contains four killer songs with high technic. PSYCHOTIC NOISE: Pure Grindcore in the vein of early NAPALM DEATH/AGATHOCLES, they have a live tape (11/90) with a perfect sound. EL KASO URKIJO: They're surely the most "vile" Grindcore band from Spain, and one of the first. They've got a lot of demos, but their best release is an LP entitled "From Dark Dimension Of Destruction" with 21 songs in the pure vein of early CARCASS with some weird and doomy touches. Hi, this is Roy, editor of Norwegian FUNERAL MAG., and now I'm going to tell you about the Norwegian scene! The scene in Norway is growing, with many rising, but like every other country we've also got dozens of shitty bands. Ok, let's start!


THOU SHALT SUFFER used to go under the name XERASIA and the more known EMBRYO-MIC, but they have lately changed name and musical approach into the satanic/ Black metal vein. The music is dark, atmospheric and brilliant. The only drawback I find are the vocals, but they certainly are original. 7" out on DISTORTED HARMONY, an EMBRYONIC demo + and 12" soon! OED FUNERAL plays more death metal orientated with these gore lyrics. Their music is brutal Death metal with an original approach. They have a 7" out on THRASH REC. and a demo for sale. They are now working on their debut album. ATROX are in the Black/Doom metal vein, with this sad feeling over the whole stuff. The guitars have a minor role, but as this band is priced with one of the best drummers around, the music certainly isn't boring. A new demo is out, and one of the guys also does a 'zine called STICMA DIABOLICUM, with issue 3 out soon. MAYHEM are the Norwegian fathers in the scene, these guys are some of the few that have been in the scene for quite a long time. They play Black metal and have 2 demos + a mini-LP out. They also do a label called DEATHLIKE SILENCE, and has a shop in Oslo. DARK THRONE is proberly the most known Norwegian band in the scene with two brilliant albums out, plus another planned to be released after x-mas. They used to play some kind of technocal Death/Black metal, but they've now totally devoted themselves to Black metal. Check 'em out. CADAVER alos have an album out and another soon to be released. These guys seem to be heavily influenced by CARCASS, and the entire splatter-wave. This is Death metal with gore lyrics - beautifull. INDICATE INJURE is another Death metal band, and when I say Death metal, I mean Death metal, and nothing more really. This is music everyone have heard before, nothing revolutionary or very original. MEPHRITE plays Death metal, not very original, but I do think that they've got their own ideas. Quite normal Death metal with normal vocals and nothing new really. Demo out now. MORTOIS plays a kind of technical Death metal in the vein of the first DARK THRONE album, with some Black metal influences. Dark vocals, and their recent lyrics deal with norse lors (that's vikings and stuff like that). Rehearsel out. ICONOCIAST is my own band. We play a kind of Death metal in the vein of ROTTING CHRIST and VARATHRON, plus perhaps a few influences from SAMAEL. I can't really say if we are good or bad, but I do feel that we're abit original. IMPORTAL is another great band. I must admit that I haven't heard these guys, but alot of people have recommended them for me. They seem to play some kind of experimental Death metal. STICMA DIABOLICIM is a hell of an original band, maybe too original for some. Sick riffing, unsuspected structure and alot of surprises in the trademark of these guys. They have done a reh. demo (shitty sound) and they now have a new demo out. We also have alot of other cool bands in Norway, some of them are PHOBIA, ENSLAVED and many more, along with quite a few 'zines: SLAYER MAG. have 8 issues out. I think this is the best Norwegian 'zine. Metalion, the editor is so funny that you can only read one page every hour or so, he's really sick. Prof. printed, great lay-out, good interviews, etc. SEPULCHURAL NOISE have atleast 6 issues out, also a very good mag, with good questions, reviews and lay-out. KNOWLEDGE OF DARKNESS have got two issues out and the third one is nearly ready. I haven't seen any of his issues, but I printed some stuff for his third issue, and I found it quite normal, nothing special. STICMA DIABOLICUM have 2 issues out, the third ready for print and the fourth is half done. Quite entertaining 'zine, worth it's price. Ok, that's all. KONKHRA is one of the most known danish bands. They formed in Nov. '88, and throughout the four year they've existed, they've done alot of promotion for themselves and they have gigged alot with underground acts, but also some bigger ones, that are some of the reasons for their "celebrity".

KONKHRA have done two demos: "The Vicious Circle" (1990) and "Malgrowth" (1991). On their debut demo they played thrash in the vein of KREATOR. On the second demo they changed the music to death-thrash. Their second demo, "Malgrowth" has sold pretty well (more than 1000 copies!!), gained a good overall response, and it caught the attention from a couple of bigger labels. The new started PROGRESS RED LABELS signed KONKHRA for one CD release. That resulted in the release of their "Stranded" (July '92) CD. An absolute positive thing about KONKHRA is that they have two vocalists: Claus and Anders, who also play guitars. Claus has got a very thrash voice, while Anders is much more growly. They combine the two voices alot, and the result is good. The two other members in the band being Jon (drums) and Martin (bass) are handling their instruments very well, and they make out a good rythm section! KONKHRA - A danish death-thrash assault!!!

DAOLOTH is a rather new (and unknown) Death metal band from Denmark. Since I don't that that many know DAOLOTH, I decided to make this this interview with them... I contacted the drummer Jacob, who answered my questions this way:

- A little background info on DAOLOTH?!

We started about 2 years ago, about 6 months later we stopped due to various reasons. A couple of months fater I started up DAOLOTH, I stopped contacted my old guitarist, (called Rami) we got two members; Cory on guitar, and Phil on bass. Later Phil left and Rami took over the bass instead. Later on we got Nicholai on vocals and Michael on guitar. Then about 3 months ago we kicked out our guitar-ist, because he was a real cocksuckin' motherfuckin', asslickin' shithead!! And for some weird reason our vocalist went with him. We kicked out Cory because he was lazy and completely respectless, for instance during a concert he tried to steal my girlfriend, I mean if you have just a little bit of respect for your surroundings, you just don't do that! Well, a short while Michael got us a new guitarist named Flemming, and I got us a new bassist named Lennart. Both are really cool guys, I really think that things will work out now - all we need is an ultra brutal vocalist!!

- What the current line-up? line-up right Michael - Rythm Lead guitar, Flemming guitar, Lennart - bass, and on drums we've got_GOD - (He he)! - How is a DAOLOTH song being created? We start with a riff, and then we just experiment with all kinds of riffs, fast and heavy mostly heavy! And then we fit in bridges, lyrics etc.! Who/what are you inspired off? Do you only listen to death metal? Hmmmm... Mostly BENEDICTION. AUTOPSY, PYREXIA, MAIMED, OBITUARY, NOCTURNUS and maybe a bit MORPHEUS (US). I know that Michael likes METALLICA and Lennart likes punk. don't know, what Flemming likes.. I like QUEENSRYCHE. MINDS, SIMPLE JOHN MELLONCAMP and SPRINGSTEEN! (What JOHNNY REIMAR OG SMØLFERNE? -To you who doesn't know know it JOHNNY.... is a very famous danish Grind/Noise band!! ed.) - You have released a rehearsel-tape, are you satisfied with it? SUUUUXXX!! We had shittiest equiptment at that time, and I used single bass drum (Yieargh!). Although it was pretty charming, but very primitive! - How many songs have you got so far? What are your lyrics about - Gore? We have almost completely forgotten our old material, we've just finnished our first new song, it's entitled "Fading of emotions". I'm the one who's doing the lyrics, mostly they are loneliness, issolation and depression, I also adore the works of H.P. Lovecraft! - Who's your favorite drummer? think that the drumer of ATHEIST rules, also the drummer of german ATROCITY (Godz!) is very good, finally Scott Rockenfield of QUEENSRYCHE is really good aswell!

How many gigs have

played, and with who?

4 C

We've played about five gigs. 4 of them with a band practicing in the same place as us (they called BIFF BAXTER BAND. ed.), and one gig with a band named DARKENED DAYS and alot of other bands at that gig. There was fuckin' 3000 people present!

- I know, that you are planning to release a studio demo soon, when, and where will you record it?

We should have released our first demo about 12 month ago, but Cory refused to go fot it, eventhough it only would have costed us about 50 Dkr (Ca. 8 S. ed.) each! A band practices the same place as us (That the BIFF BAXTER BAND. ed.), only had to pay about 50 Dkr each. I tried to tell Cory about a zillion times, that if it turned out to be bad, we would just keep it for ourselves, and then atleast we would have a little studio experience, but he was thickheaded to understand that! The plans now is to make three more songs and then find a good cheap studio!

- Futureplans for DAOLOTH?

It's best to take things one step at a time, so no major plans, exept for the demo, of course!

- And now the compulsory "Last words"...?

"In nomine dei noistri satanis luciferi excelsii"! (Wasn't tha a bit trendy? ed.) Watch out if you meet a little smelly butthole named Cory fuckin' r first he seems nice, but after while that will change, fooled me! American PYREXIA rules! Kings brutality! Support underground! That's where the future of death metal lies! ILLDISPOSED are gods of danish death metal! And to Joakim Sterner of NECROPHOBIC - Why don't you send me that fuckin' t-shirt I sent money for? An interview for NAGUAL MAG. was also included!! And finally, Cthulhu is still calling - Jak Fthagn! Thanks for the interview and good luck to NAGUAL MAG. and IDIOSYNCRASY!

that the danish I suppose "underground" band, that have gained the biggest recognition overseas are the legendary INVOCATOR! To those of you who didn't know, I can tell that INVOCATOR was formed back in under the name BLACK CREED. In '87 they changed the name to INVOCATOR. In '88 they released their first demo, which was entitled "Genetic Confusion". Then in late '89 they recorded their most "Alterations", famous demo, which sold a lot of copies and spread their name throughout the world. Through the 7 years that "INVOCATOR" has existed, they've played tons of gigs with aswell small as "big" acts! Throughout the years INVOCATOR has had several line-up changes, and the only original member is Jacob Hansen (guitar + vocals). Since I did this interview with Jacob, Schultz (guitar) has left the band, and been replaced on guitar by "Perle" who used to play bass. Now INVOCATOR have got yet another (new) bassist called Per! Oh yeah, I almost forgot: In dec. '90 INVOCATOR signed to BLACK MARK PRO., who released their debut album "Excursion Demise" in oct. '91. Jacob H. answered my questions this way:

- First of all, are you satisfied with your debut LP, "Excursion Demise"?

Yes and no! We're satisfied with the cover that means that turned as we expected. Yeah, everything turned out as we wanted it, but the sound... That can be discussed! It's tame, thin and polished, which doesn't fit us at all. We had planned to put a bit of a

"death-feeling" over it, men our engineer destroyed that a bit. BOSS (Boss of BLACK MARK) had nothing to do with the sound. All in all he was in the studio about 5 hours in a whole week. If the sound has been ok, I would have been happy, 'coz we really did the best we could on that record! The sound gives a completely wrong impression of the band. It's just to bad. But otherwise I'm pretty satisfied with the rest. It looks as I've said, as I had imagined it would, and that's pretty positive... Or what?!

- INVOCATOR has always had alot of line-up troubles, do you think that your line-up is

steady now?

No, I'm never 100% sure about the line-up. You know, so many things can suddenly happen. Now and then the line-up is very unstable, and other times you're 100% sure that "this is the line-up"! You'll never know! I just hope that the band remains, and not ends like some sort of a ARTILLERY, who just disappeared from the surface! We'll only continue if we know that there still is a certain quality in what we're making!

- INVOCATOR has played alot of gigs, and recently you've been on an european-tour with DARK ANGEL, how was it and how did

you get on that tour?

It was a cool experience, that ment the most while you were on the road. And all the problems with food, money, driving, and so on! All the time there was one thousand problems, and we lived packed like sardines in a tin. But now when the whole thing far

away you remember all the cool things, such as the persons in DARK ANGEL and SACROSANCT + crew! Now it's cool to meet the same persons again! All the tiny things you were pissed about then doesn't mean anything now, and you can laugh about the things that during the tour were "serious"! That tour had alot of positive sides! Perhaps just as many negative experiences, but we just forget them!!

- It was BLACK MARK PRO. who released your debut album, is the contract for more than 1 album?

Yeah, it's on as many (max. 4) that BLACK MARK wants. If they want to release our next album we must do it on BMP, but if they're not interested, we're of the label.

- Have you got any new songs ready? Titles..? Are they in the same vein as your previous material?

We have 2 new songs ready and 1 one the way. The two have gotten the titles "Lost at birth" and "Tool of the perverted"! Actually they're very different from our "previous" songs. "Tool..." is a very mid-paced song, and there's not one single fats part in it. Anyway, everything is very complex, and so speak more conspicuous than our older songs! Both of the new songs have been made as intense as possibly, and they're pretty short. I have no idea about the last one, but I guess that it'll be in the same vein!

- Could you please disclose how an INVOCATOR is created? I've got some riffs which I record on a tape, and then I give it to Per (the drummer). Then he gets an idea of how we make a song out of it, so we go to the rehearsel room and tries it out. After a couple of days intense rehearsing we almost have a song. A text is being written, and we meet in the rehearselroom and record the song on a 4-tracker with vocals. We always think alot about the song, listens to it a dozens of times and thereafter we mak the changes that are importent, and then at last we add some solos. A song is always being changed alot of times until it's officially released. There's always some annoying things about a new song, which you first find after some time. But when it first is on vinyl, we don't change it anymore, but first then!

- Ok, could you please tell about some of your most importent influences!? Musicwise it's bands like DARK ANGEL and NASTY SAVAGE...

NASTY SAVAGE... "Old classic" etc.! I'm pretty Besides that inspired of the new american death-genre, such bands RIPPING CORPSE, SUFFOCATION, Their REMAINS etc.! HUMAN guitarists especially, also the way of structuring songs.

- Does it occasionally happend that you listen to something else than extreme music? I listen to a lot of different music. For instance TOM PETTY, ELO, QUEEN, REGGAE-music, POP (??? ed.). All of us listen to progressiv metal, exept from Per. LETHAL, FATES WALTZ. PSYCHOTIC WARNING. WATCHTOWER, SANCTUARY ... etc.! Does any of the INVOCATOR guys play in other bands that INVOCATOR? We used to. Schultz and I in MACERATION, Per in GERONIMO. I that Perle has been jamming some rock 'n roll with someone, but nothing serious. - What does the members of besides INVOCATOR do playing music? P.t. Schultz is at a journalistic-highschool. It's cool for him... (He's done ed.) Per have been digging 5 months now ditches for of some idiotic because arrangement. Perle municipal the same been in situation. Now he's on the dole. I've got plenty to do with my new recordshop POWER RECORDS! that Besides produce demos now and then for danish bands. - How do you consider the danish scene? Are there any specific bands that you want to recommend? The danish scene has become quite good. The old ones are almost gone now, and we've

gotten a new generation, who dares more! That's cool!! When we started there were 7-10 bands. Now there are tons of them and they all now how to promote themselves. Some good ones are KONKHRA, INIQUITY, SACRIFICIAL, ICONOCLASM (a new band from Esbjerg), PUGNACITY, ILLDISPOSED, CAUSTIC, CHIRO DISASTER THERIUM, AGONIZE, UNDERTAKER, EIDETIC, AREA. FURIOUS TRAUMA, MACERATION. DOUBT, RIDGID DOMAIN, etc.!! There are a lot of cool bands! - Do you know how many copies "Excursion..." has sold?

About 10.000 copies, I think.. That's pretty satisfying! It think that the tour with DARK ANGEL has helped the sales!

You have been nominated to a grammy for "Excursion Demise", tell me about it!!

Ha, yeah!! It was a very cool experience. Our old distributor SONET had nominated us! We only got the experience out of it, but it was actually pretty funny! We had hoped that we would be shown in tv, but we didn't, unfortunately! But I think that the Grammy thing gave us a bit PR.! Perhaps that was why we were offered the support-job for SEPULTURA when they played here. It gave a sort of prestige.

- Do you think that to many bands "pops" out these days? No, not at all!! I doesn't matter wether they're original or not. If only they can play, and not just think that they play death metal because they tune 2 tones down and has a growly vocal! The bands who pisses at the scene. we sure could do without them! Besides, the good bands overshadow the bad ones! Besides, I don't think that we can get enough good bands!! The more the better, that's the same for Denmark!!

- Do you mind sharing INVOCATOR's future-plans with

New songs, new LP, new shows, new, new, new!! We wanna try lots of new things (new to us atleast!) on our next album, but it proberly won't be that diffucult hearing that it is just won't INVOCATOR. We repeat ourselves on the next LP, so I'll try a new vocalmethod, a new vocal! We'll try to work with our leads, which will be turning towards a more melodic touch! The will will vary alot from song to song! Of course it's too early to actually speak about the new LP, but many things will be changed!

- Well Jacob, have you got any

closing words for this int.?
1000 times thanks to all our
loyal fans everywhere!! I hope
I'll see you live!! I also
hope that you're gonna like
our new album as much as our
debut! Thanks to you Bjarke
for this interview!! Do write
us! Join us on our "Excursion
Demise"....

SUFFER are from Sweden, but don't worry, they're not playing the "usual" swedish way!! Ok, their "M.O.G." wasn't exactly a masterpiece, but their new 7" just kicks ass!! It's just sooo great and well-played, aargghh!! Here comes an interview with the high skilled drummer - Perra:

A SUFFERing band-bio!? SUFFER started out as a trio back in in '88 with Jocke (voc/gui), Putte (bass) Conny (drums). The first demo "Cemetary Inhabitans" released early 1990. And also a new guitarist joined SUFFER, Ronny Eide (the editor MORBID MAG. ed.). In the middle of 1990, Conny left tha band and SUFFER was nothing for a while. Then they found me as their new drummer ... And in september the same year, I was a permanent member of the band. In the beginning of 1991 we released our new and 2nd demo, entitled "Manifestation of god"... A four tracker recorded at Sunlight Studios! That one turned out "killer" in the underground! The whole thing turned out in a deal with NEW WAVE RECS., France! And a 7" single is set to be released (it is out when you read this. ed.). In november last year, we went to the Sunlight Studios again... To record 2 trax for the 7" + 1 on a track for a spot soundtrack LP! We're satisfied with that one, it has got a good sound. But in January this year, Ronny left the band, as he found himself in personal difficulties. And 2 weeks later he was replaced by Uffe Samuelsson... Since he joined, we've "gigging" alot around here in Sweden! The only problems we have just now, is that NEW WAVE RECS. seems to have some troubles with the release of the 7". But we all hope that it'll be out and killing soon! We arealso rehearsing alot on some new tracks, we've 4 ready

just to be unleashed.

Give me some facts about the members in SUFFER; ages, hobbies etc.!?

Ok, let's start with the former member, Jocke Ohman: He is 23 years old, out of work, likes the autumm best... Listen to alot of different music styles, his faves: PET SHOP BOYS, DI LEVA, Q5, DEATH... etc.!! Then we have our bassplayer - Putte Andersson, he's as old as Jocke is. Working at a market called Domus. And adores bands like GUNS 'N ROSES and AEROSMITH. He is also the "short one" in SUFFER. And the new one, Uffe Samuelsson is... crazy! He works just now at a music organisation called "Tid ar musik"... But he'll soon loose his job, I don't know why?? He likes SADUS, NIRVANA, MISFITS, BOGHANDLE, PARADISE LOST, METALLICA... and so on! He is 21 years old! I (Perra) am

still in school, got one year left on that shit... I work with a 'zine called MOULD MAGAZINE. I'm also answering a lot of mail. A near friend (Vikko) and I has just started a comp. tape called "DEATHMILL LUNATICS". I'm alot into tape-trading... I think, that I'm the most underground dude in the band! That's it ...

Try to give a suitable description of what SUFFER sounds

like!?

SFFER sounds as it sounds, we try to be original... Maybe somewhere between thrash and death metal, that's hard to say. We can maybe call it "Brutal-hate-metal"... If want!?!

You are about to release a 7" on NEW WVW RECS., how did you get that deal? Has other interrest showed labels

you?

It was our old guitarist, Ronny, who fixed that deal. Yes, there has been alot of interrested labels ... But nothing is for sure! Are you satisfied with the 7

musicwise?

As I said earlier ... Yes we are, but our new stuff put this one to dust pretty fast ... That's for sure!

Tell me about the songs on the

The songs on the forthcomming 7" EP is "On sour ground" and "My grief". "On siur ground" is about as we say in Sweden when "Du är ute på halis", I think! It's hard to descripe the lyrics, as I don't know



them, you know? But all our lyrics has got a double meaning, you can think of them in many different ways ... If you understand what I mean!!?? Which release do you consider

to be your best? Why is that? We have not released so much yet, but our forthcomming 7" will sure be our best, so far.. As it's our latest recording, ok!?

Don't you think, that alot of people avoid a band called SUFFER? Why did you choose to call the band SUFFER anyway?

The name SUFFER was chosen by the whole band, after a name idea from the old drummer Conny! SUFFER is a perfect name for our music and lyrics, and if people avoid a band because of the name, then they avoid the whole fucking musiclife! Fuck 'em ...

Does the name really mean something to you, or is it

just a name?



Yes... SUFFER stands for the music that we compose! I think, that every living soul on earth are suffering sometimes every day in their lives... Don't you? (I guess you're right.. ed.)
Do you think, that it has any influence wether a band is from Sweden or China, in the matter of attracting a label? Actually I think, yes! I don't know why!? But Sweden maybe got better musicians, the China bands is not to many. By the way, I've never heard an underground band from there... Strange! But if the band is good, I don't care, where they're from!

what is your oppinon on people bands/labels, who rip off?
Rip off is a sad story. I've been ripped off a few times...
RED ALERT ZINE from Belgium!
PSYCHOSLAUGHTER RECS. in USA!
MAZE AMERICA INC. in USA! And of course I can't forget the 'zine EXTREMUNCTION from Spain. They ripped me off on 6 music tapes.... Fuck them!!
But I got alot of problems me myself with all the mail... So maybe some of you see me as a rip-off!? Don't worry all of you... ok?!

Do you think, it's importent for a band to promote themselves? What do you do to promote SUFFER?

As an underground band, it's

very importent. I have promoted SUFFER so far throung sending some bio's + tapes to 'zines/comp. tapes/Radiostations... etc! I think, that I must be pretty satisfied with it, as we've been featured in many 'zines, and so on! Will SUFFER play the same music in 10 years from now? We all have to see.. I don't give a shit, actually!! I hope that SUFFER is still alive in 10 years, we must play more organized guitar-solos, more weird drums, and of course...

Be original!!
Which subjects does your
lyrics deal with? What do you
think about bands who continue
to write gore/satanic lyrics?

Our lyrics are mostly about hate and such natural such natural subjects. And if like to write about gore and satanism, in their lyrics, it's up to them! SUFFER will never do it ... Have you played live alot? Who do you like to play with? Well, for about 15 gigs... I think! SUFFER has played in cities like: Norberg, Avesta, Stockholm, Orebro, Göteborg, Skara, Fagerasta... + some more! Even a gig in Norway (Bergen) was played in 1990! Some bands worth mentioning: MERCILESS, DISMEMBER, GENETIC TRIBULATION, GARBAGE. DESULTORY, ENSLAVEMENT, HOUSE OF USHER, ANTIDOTE, INVERTED, EXETEMPT, DEAD END, THRASHHOLES + tons of others to... We got alot of interresting gigs comming up at the end of this summer, as for example "Hultsfreds-festivalen" 7-8 August. Then maybe a 2 gig tour with the finnish LUBRICANT (Godz!) here in Sweden... Could be cool! We play with every band who wants to play with us... We're pretty cheap on the live-front, we just take some money for the trip + some food... That's all! And I can also tell you, that we're one of Sweden's most intense live-bands... aggressive That's our reputation! What would you say, if IRON MAIDEN asked you to support them on their world-tour? Well, I think that it would be okay. But it would be great if we had a LP or 2 out first! IRON MAIDEN were one of the first heavy metal bands ever, that I was listening Back in '83, I think! What is your view on the metal scene? Which genres do you think will survive? The metal scene is sure alive, but even if the thrash is allmost dead. I think, that death metal will stay around for a while. But who cares about genres actually? As long as the bands I like stay alive, I don't care if they play speedcore/death metal/ hate synth/ultra brutal dansmusik... They are just my fave band, and the only shit I care about is their music.. Right?! You are also doing a called MOULD, tell the readers about it!! Hell wes I have a 'zine called MOULD, but both my older issues has been sold out (150 copies each) worldwide! third issue is ready to be printed, I think it'll be out, when you're reading this.
