AMORBITAL'S HISTORY


The group Amorbital was officialy established by a singer and guitar player Chrysogonus together with a drum player Lazare. Immediatelly after that, they are accompanied by a bassplayer Lipo. The group had been played in this configuration of three members till the december 1994, when they were joined by a second guitar player Krishpin. After his arrival the group created a new material, which was much more technical. Their first concert took place in Humenne, at Festering Blood part.II, where the group played together with the groups Phantasma, Dementor, Agony Conscience... It has been followed by the other concerts, till that time just in Slovakia. We can mention concerts with Krabathor, Lux Occulta, Depresion, Godless Truth, Depresy, Infaticide, Hypnotic Scenery. At the end of july 1996 the group recorded ist first demo. The name of it is "Crystal Rhapsody" and was recorded in the studio Exponent in Hlohovec. It contains 5 songs, which lenghts is 25 minutes. This demo was sent off mainly by zines and the distributors in Slovakia and Czech republic. Also the foreign distributions a and zines were contacted with this demo. The reactions on it were very positive. Immediately after the arrival from the studio they began to work with a new material. Amorbital had some more opportunities to performe at

some concerts. In april 1998 have again visited the studio Exponent, where recording not a demo but a new MC album "INVIDIA". It consists of 9 new songs, which are faster and harder as on previous demo Crystal Rhapsody. Total lenght of this material is 30 minutes. Whit this new material Amorbital will try to contact more and more magazines, distributions, labels, radio stations and certainly the fans. The group Amorbital was officialy established by a

VITAL REMAINS

Could you tell us how did you start and what was your first demo like?

VITAL REMAINS formed in late 1988 and put out the first demo "Reduced To Ashes" in 1989. The demo, was for sure a head of its time! It was very brutal death metal! Any one who wishes to hear it send me a blank 60 minute cassette and 2 IRC's III dub it for you! And we also might release it on CD with some other stuff!

How did you get to OSMOSE Prod.? It was a decision we made to sign with OSMOSE after our time with PEACEVILLE. Things just wern't happening with that label so we decided to find a new one. So one day I called OSMOSE and discussed many issues with Herve and concluded in a recording deal. And I must say OSMOSE has delivered everything they said they would. I have no complaints about this label. OSMOSE IS A VERY

TRUE LABEL!

I saw you Uherské Hradiště, when you played with VADER, MALEVOLENT CREATION and INFERNAL MAJESTY. When I heard your music, I was standing like a stone...WONDER-FUL!!! It was great action except the microphone which was still breaking off...What do you think about this tour?

Thank you for coming and supporting VITAL REMAINS. I remember that show very well. There vere many people in the show. But I don't remember the microphone. But the tour was great! It was our very first time touring in Europe, and what can I say, what better way to tour Europe for the first time than tour with VADER, M.CREATION and I.MAJESTY.

met so many people and visited 27
cities! I cant wait to do it again!

Dark image, candles in LIVE shows, is this an important thing for you?

Yes very much so! Weve always had a very dark image since the beginning. We always used candles and still do! Although we couldn't use them at all the shows we did in Europe because we didn't have time to keep buying them. But we've dune it all. Back in 92 we painted our faces with warpaint and we still wear leather and spikes. We don't wear war paint all the time. Sometimes I will paint my face. Or use blood from a


pig or breath fire. Its all a big part of what we are but we mustly represent our music!

That slim guitarman was only a "help" on tour? You're only three men, don't you think about the constant fourth guitarman?

Yeah! "Aaron" was the guitarist we had with us on the MALEVOLENT TOUR, He is a friend of ours, and he wanted a chance to help us out for the tour. But that time is over now-we are once again only three (3). We will record with only three, but live we will search for a fourth guitarist for the

I couldn't live, I must buy the CD "Forever Underground" and I was "down" again...How is the connection between the pentagram and the name "Forever Underground"? Are you satanic band? What are your lyrics about?

Well you see, when I first realised what my life was about and what it represents to me the symbol on the cover has always been there to represent my beliefs, therefore staying true by still having it appear on our works. In some instances yes. A lot of our beliefs and teachings come from Anton LaVeys books. So yes we are satanic! A lot of what we represent and try to express in the music is very satanic. And most of the lyrics deal with this subject.



Well yeah I think so, Its a very hard accomplishment to complete with some of the USA bands. Some of them are just so fucking fast and brutal-they rip your face right off your head. But we just write what we feel. And make it sound good on a CD.

6 songs, but the length is unusual. When will you release new album? (I can't wait) Will it be the continuing of "Forever Underground" or you will surprise with something different?

We are hoping to release our new album at the end of summer (98) It will be called "Dawn Of The Apocalypse" It will be very fast, very brutal you'll hear some elements of "Forever..." But its all new stuff. You'll just have to wait.

I've heard, you are making 2 cover versions. What are they like? Will they be determined only for compilations or they'll release also on your album?

We did "The Trooper" (IRON MAIDEN) for a tribute compilation for DWELL REC.- The same label that released A tribute to CELTIC FROST. The Maiden tribute is called "A Call To Irons". Its release date is may - 1998, It also has bands like ABSU, ANGEL-CORPSE and SOLITUD AETURNUS.

Joe, that's it! Do you want to complete me in any way?

Lets just say you might. Thanks so much for your support keep supporting metal! (Joe Lewis).

Hello Frost This is my firsth spaking to you, so don't dissapoint me, ha ha. FROST, that's your first MCD "Meggido", what can you tell me about it? And why did it, rise? "Meggido" is a collection of rather odd and special stuff that would not fit in on a regular album, but that we still wanted to release. Some people find esnecially the first track-which is not a SATYRICON-track, but a re-mix done by Apoptygma Berzerk-hard to swallow

What does the cover express? It's dark enough...
Yes, the cover has a very dark feeling to it...The motive is meant to create an atmosphere od Death and Armageddon/and it does.

I liked your meaning for experiments, which you use enough, what did you necessitate to these progresses? Would you like to separate from the classic black metal progresses. Necessary for our experimenting in music was first and foremost a highly creative brain and good musical understanding. Satyricons way of making music has always been



quite different from the "classic" (ordinary?) Black Metal band's ways. And it will continue like this-Satyr has never had any problems doing experiments no Black Metal band has done before.

Why did you put the song "Orgasmatron"?

We saw a potential in "Orgasmatron" that was not fully releaed MOTÖRHEAD. So it was decided to do an attempt making the song as raw and powerful, but still arrogant, as it should be! I my ears we succeeded, no doubt about it.

I love your logo very much, it's stylish and legible, who's the author?

The logo is made by me, Satyr and Union of lost souls.

Do you agree with me that your top is the album "Nemesis Divina", or you are only waiting for your TOP?

I do agree that "Nemesis Divina" is our best album so far. However, our top is not reached, we get better all the time, and I know for sure that our next album will kill anything else we have released.

What kind of songs will be on your next album? I'd to know, it will be continueing of wonderful "Nemesis..." or your creation will change?

Our next album will show SATYRICONs development since "Nemesis Divina", and it will of course be a completely different album. Some of our characteristic trais will necessarily be maintained, but our new album shall sound like nothing else done before. Ther are fast and floating parts, beutal, militant parts, slow and grim parts, doomy parts, bizarre tunes etc...Our new material is strong as Hell, and it seems like there will be very

> few melodies incorporated in the songs. We are bored so immensely by all those new "black metal" bands that just try to create beautiful harmonies and melancholic moods-we will do nothing of the sort! We play BLACK metal, and it will be DARK, not LIGHT music. AAAR-RRGGGHHH everything has got totally out of hand, and sometimes it pisses me off, even if I try concentrating only on the worthwile side of things ...

Will be on your next album some insertions of the voices, girls, choirs or keyboards?

It's not fully decided what there will be, as not all our material is ready yet, but one thing is for sure, which is that we will incorpote synth in a new way on the new album. There won't be so many melodies and simple choirs, which has been very usual in Black Metal the later years, but rather a more creative use of the synthesizer. Wait and hear the result... Maybe there will be some choirs of stuff, but we will not use this just for the sake of having choirs etc., we will only use it if it clearly contributes to the atmospheres we try to create-and nothing else is better, or equally as good.

Is that the chance to get your first 2 demos, tell me something about them?

Our demotapes is no longer available, and haven't been for a long time. However, "The Forest Is My Throne"+ The Night of The Triumhator can be obtained by buying the split CD/LP with ENSLAVED.

The first demo is hard to comment, as I didn't play on that one, and the line-up was completely changed after wards. Satyr did not even make the songmaterial on the first demo, so you might imagine it was a completely different band. I think there are a few excellent parts on that demo, but generally it bores me.

The second demo, "The Forest Is My Throne" is actually a very good demo in my opinion. It clearly shows lack of musicianship, at least from my side, but it is extremely Black and primitive, and both the guitarsound and the drumsound is brilliant. SATYRICONfans into die-hard Black Metal should absolutely not ignore it.

Frost, good luck, thanx for the inrview, your creation is immortal !!!



BAL-SAGOTH become to be group turning and breaking the styles. directions, limits-don't I'm right?

Yes. We have always aspired to transcend boundaries and redefine the genre. We do not recognize any limitations, and we will not allow fetters of any kind to be placed on our artistic

freedeom. It is our sacred quest to shock people, to astonish them, to make them totally rethink and recyaluate their previously held views on what extreme metal is, or can be. Our lunacy is allowed free rein to infect the world, astounding everyone with its incredible bombast and sublime insanity. We are like a great steelthewed colossus, effortlessly strinding over all boundaries and spitting in the face of convention and musical/lyrical conformity.

The feeling which comes to my mind after listening "Battle Magic" is look like some dramatic story from history it coulds be your I'm to cause this feeling, this historical atmosphere ...?

Indeed, the lyrical concept for "Battle Magic" is very concerned with actual historical concept as well as the fantasy fare. History is something I have always been very interested in, particularly military history, and with the new album I have introduced a lot of historical content into the stories. The music perfectly reflects the historical lyrical approach, as there is a perfect creative synergy between music and lyrics evident on "Battle Magic". The new songs deal with many historical times, such as heathen Anglo-Saxon England, Roman Britain, the time of the Spanish Armada, etc. It

was always my intention to introduce a series of historical story arcs into the lyrics, and with the third album, I have done just that.

I have by me only the promo-there fore I ask you for explaining the essence of your

As well as the aforementioned historical aspects, the lyrics of BAL-SAGOTH are also concerned with such things as fantasy, science-fiction, horror, and a whole

myriad

a subjects. The lyrics are essentially the keystone of the whole mammoth BAL-SAGOTH engine, and their essence is imagination, escapism, and adventure. The stories can be read as ripping fantasy yarns, or also as tales containing deeper, hidden meanings clear to the more erudite and astute reader. Imagination is the key ... and the lyrics often deal with themes such as the quest for power and

enlightenment, key concepts and pursuits for mankind since time immemorial. There is the desire to know what lies beyond the stars... and what lurks behind the shadows. The lyrics of BAL-SAGOTH are a portal to be stepped through by any reader with that vital spark of imagination... that vital capacity and gift to dream.

How is the component of your music? Or all you is taking care of it?

The music is written mostly by Mr. Jonathan, and also Mr. Christopher contributes riffs. I write all the lyrics. and through a cunning and ethereal process of artistic fusion and celebral manipulation, the aforementioned creative synergy is achieves flawlessly.

You are one of the little which is staying by CACOPHONOUS is due to the fact that you are satisfied with their work?

We have been approached by NUCLEAR BLAST, who would like to sign us for future albums, and also CACOPHONOUS obviously want to continue working with us. CACOPHONOUS have improved greatly as a label over the past two years or so, and they have promoted "Battle Magic" very well. If we decide to make a fourth album, we will certainly carefully choose the label that we think will work best for us. We shall

The Hyperborean Saga is also soon to be a graphic novel, which I am currently writing, and which the cover artist respossible for the third album artwork is illustrat-

And what's the meaning of your cover "Battle Magic"? It looks like some crystals...

The cover of the

"Battle Magic" promo is NOT the real cover of the album. The actual "Battle Magic" cover is a sanguineous scene of slaughter representing the battle of blackhelm vale, a confrontation chroniclled in the "Starfire..." album. I skerhed out some ideas & character designs detailing what I wanted the cover to lock like, and Simon Lee of judas cradle artworks did a wonderful job of bringing the concept to vibrant life. True epic fantasy art...Worthy only of the mighty BAL-SAGOTH!!! The promo displays a different, abstract graphic in order to maximize the impact of the true cover when the album was

abstract graphic in order to maximize the impact of the true cover when the album was officially released...And of course due to the time contraints involved with the advance release of promotional samplers.

REGURGITATION was formed in October, 1994 by vocalist/guitarist Ben Deskins, and guitarist Tony Tipton. Formed by their undying passion for the Death Metal scene, the duo set out to create an extremely brutal band, while maintaining musical excellence.


Unable to find suitable musicians, the two began to write material for a forthcoming demonstration tape which displayed their own style of brutal Death Metal. In November of 1995, the band added drummer Travis Huffman, and recorded the "Conceived Through Vomit" demo in January 1996, with Deskins handling guitar, vocal, and bass duties. "Conceived..." was released in March 1996 with mass acceptance into the underground, and gained the band much recognition as an outstanding force to be reckoned with.

After the recording of that demo, the band added bassist Tommy Chaffin, and was also later joined by Rob gaines on vocals. The band went on to play many shows that year and further get their name and music spread.

1997 proved to be quite an eventful year for REGUR-GITATION. In the earlier part of the year drummer

Travis Huffman and bassist Tommy Chaffin left the band due to musical and personal differenes. They were quickly replaced by Dan Baker on drums, and Brian Baxter on bass.

Soon after, REGURGITATION again played an array of shows, which included gigs in Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, and Ohio. All of the while the band continued to assault the underground with a relentless ad campaign, and gained much momentum. Many interviews and positive reviews followed in magazines such as BRUTALIZED, SOUND OF DEATH, IN DEED HELL, MORTAIL COIL, INNER SOURCE, SIMBIOTIC, UNDERGROUND METAL, BLACK MAGIC,



THE NEW BREED, and PUTRID DYSENTERY.

In November 1997, Rob Gaines was eliminated from the band due to personal differences. It was at this time that the band decided to remain a 4 - piece with guitarist Ben Deskins and bassist Brian Baxter handling all vocal duties. This proved to be a very positive decision and retained the dual vocal brutality they had wanted.

Drummer Dan Baker left the band in January 1998 for personal seasons and has since been replaced by Brad Arnold.

Now, at the present, REGURGITATION, plans to further torture the masses with their musically endowed brutal Death Metal and with the release of their new full length CD "Tales Of Necrophilia" in 1998 on ABLATED RECORDS. Along with the album release, they plan to continue their hard work in the underground, further expand their dedicated following, and go as far as they possibly can with their brutal music. We look forward to meeting many new people, and creating an even greater following amongst the underground.


In July 1994 Arkona recorded their first official studio demo "Bogowie Zapomnienia". That's was the first Pagan Metal Masterpiece in polish language.


In December 1994 they recorded their debut full lenght album "Imperium" for the Swiss label Morbid Madness Prod. In spring 1996 MMP's financial troubles brought to rupture of the contract and "Imperium" was released on Astral Wings Rec.

In spring 1997 Folter Rec. definitely gave ARKONA a multi- albums contract. Arkonas first release on Folter Rec. was "An eternal curse of the Pagan Godz". This album contains the first two Demo- sessions.

"Zeta Reticuli"- Arkonas 3, full length album has been recorded during a frozen Winter session of pure hatred at Tuba Studio Wrocław. Their own description of their style is: "Evil Pagan Black Metal by Mystical Cosmic Way". The lyrics act about the connection between Paganism and Alien sprint. A very unique way of philosophy.







EXMOSTED

Interview with Sigtyr of EXMORTEM.
I'm sorry but I came in contact with you for the first time, through Voices Of Wonder. Would you introduce yourselves to IN DEED HELL readers.

Sure, the band formed back in 1992, at that time they called Mordor, they released one demo in 1993 called "Souls Of Purity", then in the end of 1994 the band, as a trio, recorded the debut "Labyrinths Of Horror", but it was first released in July 1995. At this point I had joined as well and the

name had also changed to EXMORTEM. Thereafter we played some gigs around in Denmark, but due to different problems we didn't record anything new until in Jan. 1997, namely the promo called "Dejected...". We then signed a new contract with EUPHONIOUS and in June 1997 we recorded the new album that have first been released here in March 1998. We have recently got a new drummer, as the old one was a fool!, and we are right now preparing to get out and play some live shows, and we also got some new killer numbers ready! That's pretty much it...!

It seems you and INFERNAL TORMENT belong among the extreme bands in Denmark. Are there any more bands like you?

Well, I wouldn't say that there is any more bands like EXMORTEM, but there surely is some bands like ILLDISPOSED and INFERNAL TORMENT, but they are not really worth to mention! I don't like INFERNAL TORMENT at all, they too have slowed down and started to play a more mainstream kind of metal, their debut sucked as well!

So, you've been in a band for 6 years now. Are you going to prepare anything special to your 10th anniversary or you'll just be glad to see the end of the century? Are you going to celebrate?

That was a somewhat unexpected question. We haven't really thought about that before now. But sure, if we become "10 years old" then we will celebrate with a huge fucking concert with lots of nasty effects on the stage and shit like that, maybe lots of topless girls serving Beer!!! You are hereby all invited to come and

"Drink Like A Dane"!

In our country there's such a saying: "He drinks like Dane" which means that he drinks a lot. Is there any truth in it?

There surely is truth in that and it's a great saying I must say! Danes do drink a lot /and have done so throughout his-

Are you proud of being Danes or do you want to live somewhere else-where?



without necessarely meating other people all the time. But historically seen we're of course proud of the Viking age and the beliefs they had back then. The glorification of Death, the proudness and honour and so on...!!!

Your album cover is very stylish and mysterious. But I can't understand it-what does it mean?

The title schould pretty much explain the cover.





It's a man, or mankind for that matter, that is beeing sucked down into this dark, obscure world...and there is no way back for him, so he is "Dejected In Obscurity". I hope this is explanation enough...?!

If I look at some of your pictures you look different every time. Which one is the true one?

Well, I'm not sure what you mean really. But back in 1995 there was taken some really shitty pictures that was just made in a fucking hurry, some of us where even wearing working clothes, I tried to cover it by wearing a SUFFOCATION shirt, but I still had these ugly white jeans on, it was a dissaster, and we even stood in this garden with green shitty grass and stuff...I don't hope you got those pictures!? Anyway, they

where never meant to be used, but the label just pressed a hell lot of them, but they must be fucking stupid if they still send them out. They have nothing to do with what we are anyway.

I think it's not difficult to recognize a Dannish band. It's the style. It doesn't matter what but I find there always something Dannish. How do you do that?

I don't really know how we do that...It might have something to with promotion or something? About this so called Danish style, well I don't know it there really is a Danish style, I only hope that we are not part of it then, cause I do, in general, not like the Danish scene that much.

> You're into classical death metal lyrics. Do you think there's still anything to write about?

Oh yes indeed there is. You can allways give it a litle twist and do it in a more personal way. That's what we have been trying to do anyway. I think the lyrics we have used so far fits

and our lyrics will allways deal with the dark and obscure in one way or another. But we are working to make the new lyrics more personal and diverse.

Did the tour with KONKHRA, ILLDISPOSED and DISMEMBER help you? What are the guys from these bands like?

Well, I don't know why the label tells people that we have been on tour with DISMEMBER and KONKHRA, cause we only played two shows with them, and we played really bad aswell, so that didn't help us that much. But the tour with ILLDISPOSED was ok and we got a lot of experience from taht. But as they drink a lot /or did ... / it often ended up in some really serious drinking sessions and I'm not excatly sure

> how it sounded when we played...We won't drink that much before future gigs, cause we don't find it to be fair, to the people who have actually paid to see your show!

Do you cooperate with any Czech music magazines?

No. I think that this is the first Czech 'zine we are in contact with, so that's really great, but I think that Kolle will do an interview with another Czech 'zine in a few days, but I don't remember what it was called. But we are in contact with the Slovak Immortal Souls Prod.

EUPHONIOUS I came in contact with them not long time ago. So I don't know them much. I just know they released a great album SATUR-NUS. Why did you choose them and how

was your caloboration?

As they had released the first album and was interested in releasing the second one aswell, we just thought it would be a good idea to



stay with that label. Olso because they now are a part of Voices Of Wonder, which should probably mean that they have a better distribution now. I don't know who will release the coming album, but others did show interest around this one, so we will see ...

How many copies of "Dejected ... " do you release? And your debut album?

We haven't heard anything about "Dejected ... " so far, and it's olso much too early to say anything yet. The album has hardly been reviewed anywhere, so no one knows that much about it, yes. "Labyrinths..." has sold about 2500 copies I think, so that's not too much, we should do much better this time for sure!

I don't know your first album (I just keep playing your great "Dejected" at home all the time!). How How would you compare these two album?

I think that, compared to "Dejected ... ", "Labyrinths ... " is more basic and a little monotous. The new one is more varied, better and harder riffs, and a more crazy structure. I think it's more violent and aggressive than the debut. We also have a much better sound this time, much more powerful, there is also a great obscure cover this time. Check it out!!

Do you answer to every magazine?

Yes we do. We are a underground band and no 'zine is too small you know. If a 'zine shows interest in EXMORTEM, then the least we can do is to give them a fucking answer, right. But on the other hand I would say that for example right now, we're using a lot of time answering int's and letters and so, so maybe one day it will be too much...But we will at least always send the 'zine or person a note. I won't use my time on

someone who just try to make a joke out of it that's for sure!

What do you think of succes of your fellow countrymen KONKHRA?

Well, I don't like KONKHRA at all, so I have no interest in the band, neither their success, if such exist?!

I think they're a bit conceited, aren't they?

I couldn't really read your hand writing in this question, so I'm not exactly sure what your question is. But personally I don't like the bands music that much, I liked their demo and debut back then. But nowadays I think they are pretty much doing as so many others, in their own way of course, namely making groovy Death'n Roll or whatever it is called ...? But I have no problems with them as individuals and we get some beers from time to time, so that's just fine.

Is there anything you are afraid of-what?

Well, I guess I'm afraid of loosing those few people that are closest to me, you know my family and so...I'm not really afraid of my own death, I more like respect it, but I of course don't hope for it to come too soon you

Would you like to degrade pretty girls, would they have to obey you? And vice versa?

No, I don't see any reason why I should do that, she should desire for herself, just like I will deside for myself aswell. I don't want anyone to even try and control my life, so why should I try to control others? I'm not into SM either if that's what you mean ...?

Thanks for the interview. Best wishes and good luck with doing other killer albums such as Dejected it's beautiful death...

I couldn't wait for its releasing-is it normal from an editor?



This time I find your singing more aggressive while the guitar shevier. I'm confused to label you...There are death songs as black metal passages-everything well-mixed!

We sacked the vocalist Michael Andersson after three songs on the album. (Booby - Trap) was a really fucked up company and is to be avoided all bands in the future. There should be a warning sign on that said "Avoid At All Costs". Hopefully no other bands work with them after we're ready with them.

You were right, Daniel, even on the second album there are instrumental songs, that were typical for SACRILEGE. You wouldn't do it without them now, would you? Do you play them your concert?

The instrumental songs are perfect to throw in between the so that the listener can relax for a few minutes before terror sets in again. On "The Fifth Season" there are two songs. One in the middle and one at the end. We don't play live though. In that case we would have to change guitars tones and I guess the audience wouldn't like that their dried and begun to smell bad during the concerts. That is after wards.

What is "Sorg" about? It's an absolutely dark song. Sorg is the Swedish word for sorrow or grief. It's a dark song still there's some kind of joy in the distorted melody lines a good song for fucking your girl.

He he he...ach Daniel...The first song "Summon The Masses..."kicks ass and it nails the listener to the wall, Did youto put such fast song on the beginning of the album? Well,"Seduction Nocturne" would manage it...

Since the first album was opened by an intro we wanted to do different and use a fast son on "Fifth". It's always

Yes. We are currently writing new material. We hope to put out a full length CD at the end of this year.


Will you arrive to play around Europe?


The cover and the booklet are beautiful and the toppic is about Egypt, a typical atmosphere for South Countries, can you explain me why all this?

We had an excellent underground scene, here in Italy, but what we've lacking in is good labels willing to invest in metal bands.



I like your sincerity. On your releases are classical satanic symbols.

Symbolism is very imporatnt to me. Everything I use is connected with me. we use reality, not gimmicks!

Name one song, which would charakterize ACHERON.

"Fuck the Ways of Christ" from the "Anti-god, Antichrist" album. There aren't any lyrics in your booklets, why?



Silence Diary

Say something about your beginnings... your first thoughts about releasing a 'zine, first contacts, disappointment...


Firstly, I'd like to greet the readers of In deed hell. I'm glad there are still people who find some time to read a quality magazine. The beginnings of SILENCE diary date back to 1995, when we were going through old quality magazines and we got the idea of reviving the spirit of them. We missed a 'zine with quality interviews with interesting bands. First contacts were rather just trying, but the more surprised we were when people abroad started to reply. Disappointments came as well, but that's life.

Why are you doing all this?

From the beginning it was of course the immense fascination by music. It's rather normal today to find a demo or a CD in my mail box every day and I'm also not so eager to find something new. But some kind of obsession remains. Then there is the contact with people here, which is a thing that fascinates me. You admire a band and all of the sudden their singer is at the opposite end of the line or you are interviewing him at a concert. Isn't it fantastic?

The latest issue has been released in English. You virtually have to start from the beginning. Tell me something about the work... circulation, distribution...

We decided to release our latest issue in English as we wanted to try something new and we also felt kind of fettered by the Czech scene. You know, what I mean. We wanted to come up with something original and have open perspectives in front of us. That's what the distribution abroad gives us, also trades for other magazines etc.



I also think there was about time to join the countries where there are 'zines in English and to support our bands abroad. If it comes to circulation, it is those traditional 300 copies, a testing amount so to speak. As I have already mentioned, the distribution is quite varied, both exotic and European countries are included. It's way different.

The most precious interview of yours and what do you think when an answer is shorter than your question?

The most precious interview I have ever done was with Therion (SD#1). Not that it was something special, but it was my first contact with a band of this qualities face to face. And the interesting thing was that I had my answers written on a paper and sweaty Chris took a pen and started to put down his answers. I appreciate this kind of attitude and as you surely know, a majority of smaller bands would fuck you off. As for the second part of your question, if it happened to me today, I wouldn't publish the interview.

When you compare reactions of foreign bands and Czech and Slovak...

I don't want to say that any scene is inferior to another. There are people who treat you with respect everywhere and people who treat you with disregard everywhere. But the difference in the international presentation remains. I believe the new generation of bands won't have any problems with it though.

Do you suffer any kind of deviation?

Of course. If you know Cartoon Network, which I hold up watching for hours or the English Godreah 'zine, which always takes my breath, you know what kind of person I am. I am certainly also obsessed by var-

ious ribaldries and the Czech beer

Name one favourite band of yours from any state that crosses your mind...

If you mean bands which I really respect... I'll start at home: Forgotten Silence; Germany: Empyrium; Italy: Will'o'Wisp; England: Thine; Greece: Septic Flesh; Sweden: At the Gates; Slovakia: Depresy...

Generally those who are able to create something salient and beautiful.

Do you send I. R. C. to bands abroad?

I never do this. I also never ask such a thing of people, I think I'm still able to reply somebody's letter. If any band regrets the money spent on me, it's sad.

Do you do anything else besides SILENCE diary?

I used to be involved also in the promotion of Ritual. Now it is rather translations, which I do from time to time for various people, or things connected with graphics, such as leaflets and tape covers...

What is your bad experience with the Underground?

Of course the bad experience exists, but I have also good experience, which is way more important for me. It is no use turning back, if I swallowed the bait sometimes, it is another experience.

And on the contrary... which people would you like to emphasise?


These are people with friendly and professional attitude like for instance Chris from Therion, mentioned above. But it's also people from 'zines because as you know, running a 'zine is always a financial suicide and these people do a lot. Those who I respect for their work are Crin from Godreah, Joao from Dark Oath or Raffaella from Headfucker magazine. But I will also mention our national 'zines such as the cult Darkness Actual, fabulous Whiplash, original Morphia, or for example your fantastic In Deed Hell. No, we are not so entertaining.
As there were always problems with members, rehearsal places, record labels and everything else too with LIERS IN WAIT-Kristian / vocals, guitar, and Johan / guitar formed DIA-BOLIQUE. But the main reason for this band is that we all wanted to play in a slower, heavier style than what we have done before. I (Bino) played in Seance before, Kristian, Johan and Hans /drums were in LIERS IN WAIT. DIABOLIQUE is our

full time band, we don't have any side projects.


Gothengurg, there is probaly strong music scene, what is here also exceptional?

Yes sure, me personaly doesn't like KORN but the other guys do so...




Do you have any IDOL (I mean someone, who is loved through his feeleng to music, expression in music, his artwork, his opinion)?

Through the eyes, and it doesn't mean anything (sorry)







INTERVIEW

You are an unknown band for me. I feel sorry I have got to know you only now. Tell me something about your beginnings and the way you got in touch with Dark Night's Sky prod

Vidar: So, Ethereal Pandemonium was formed in summer '96 by bass player/singer Nathuruss and me. I believe that talking about our history in details would be boring for the readers, so let me only add that our line up has been changed pretty often. Ethereal was first four-players band, then three, then five and finally during the recordings of our debut album A WINTER SOLSTICE EVE, our line up contained six members (Nathuruss -bass, vocals; Vidar - guitar; De Sade Soliloquay - vocals; Rhaa - keyboards; Demogorgon drums; and Countess Ekorn - female vox. Well, that has been changed just few days ago and now we are seven. A new guitarrist joined our band. His name is Herr Doktor. The answer for the second part of your question, we know the Dark Night's Sky boss -Darkoldus for a long time, especially our drummer. So in the time when he was starting his D.N.S. Productions, we agreed on a cooperation. By the way, we are absolutely satisfied with D.N.S.

Does D.N.S.prod serve as a springboard to a better label?

Vidar: Yes, we would like to release our second album in a bigger company. Our plan is to release it on a CD, which ain't possible by D.N.S. yet. But it is too soon to talk about these things, so the time shall tell.

Your tape visits my cassette player quite frequently, but I'd like to dust my CD player as well...

Vidar: That's what I was talking about in the answer to second question. D.N.S. deals with the unknown bands and it is logical that instead of releasing one band on CD, the company chooses to release two bands on cassettes. We would be high up in the clouds, if we demanded CD. I think that the band must first develop to have a CD.

We are absolutely glad to have WINTER SOLSTICE EVE released, with such great inlay card and well done distribution. So WINTER SOLSTICE EVE CD probably will not visit your CD devise. At least not too soon. Your female singer sings nice, original, but it seems to me as if she had caught a cold. Is it because of her illness during the recording, lack of training or do you just like it this way?



Vidar: Let me congratulate you for you are the first one to notice this fact. So here comes the explaining: we were recording W.S.E. in winter and Countess Ekorn got sick before the recording. Now, we could not change the term, so she volunteered to sing as best as she could. We were afraid of how it's gonna be, but it's just fine. Although it was hard, she did it. As we talk about this, let me say that as we were recording the album, all three our singers got sick. Even though in case of Nathuruss and De Sade Soliloguay it is no big

deal, because of their style of singing, but for this little problem Nathuruss sings on the album classically black-like, something like Immortal style. But when his voice is good condition, he can make a pretty good high-pitched scream, as the visitors of our concerts could hear. Our singers can do a lot better than on the W.S.E. album. I hope by the next recording we shall not have this misfortune.

Are you able to perform also live in the same way you

perform on "A winter solstice eve"?

Vidar: As I just said, in case of singing, we can do a lot better. In case of guitars, I had little problems playing those guitar themes live, because in some cases, there are four guitar themes in one riff, but as Herr Doktor joined in, it should not be a problem anymore. Well, maybe some sequences we play differently, but it is because of the improvisation. Everything except the

thunder and the rain sound in When the Dusk Comes... comes from us.

Do you use also any supplements such as a nymph's dance, candles, fire, artificial wind, show... to catch the eye during the live shows?

Vidar: That mostly depends on situation and the size of the stage. To make a good background to our music, we use candles, skulls, some crosses (inverted) and if possible, also steam. For more we have a lack of finances, but we would like to

refresh the concerts with some faery-dancers, or some bigger bacgkround stuff. We will see. Our look contains from war-paint, blood and black dresses.

"A winter..." is separated into several stories, do they create a whole - such as a serial for example, or do they have no relation to each other?

Vidar: It is no conceptional work, even though the song THE FIELDS OF TOMBS is the continuing of THE DEPTHS OF STYX, in lyrics. DEPTHS deals with the suicidal thoughts and lack of hope, while FIELDS deals with finding a power to fight the

problems. The title song deals is pagan-like, it is the challenge of fighting the christianity. PROPHECY is the biblical apocalypse turned upside down. The losers are winners here and the god's children cry above the ashes of their saviour. 1998 ANNO DOMINI deals with the story about 666 + 666 + 666 = 1998, but actually I did not created it. so I cannot say a lot about it.



WHEN THE DUSK COMES... deals with dreams and nightmares. The song OVERTURE is only an intro to 1998 ANNO DOMINI and has no lyrics and the AWAITING... is only the opening theme for WINTER SOLSTICE EVE, so I guess that's all.

It's pity I have only a promo tape so I don't know how the original looks. Please describe it...

Vidar: So, except the songs from the promo material, there are also two more songs, OVERTURE and 1998 ANNO DOMINI. The Cassette has a pro-look with the inlay card with lots of informations. There are also lyrics and the quotations of great authors like Dante, Vajansky, Cowley, Stoker and more. There is our photo and the thanklist. Inlay card has six both-side printed pages. Who wants it, he can order it on the adress of D.N.S., or at distributors like Shindy, Metal Age, Erebos and others.

The sound could have been a bit better...

Vidar: I agree, but that sound is 90% of what we wanted to achieve. I would change a little the guitar sound, but I think that the sound is alright. We have met with different arguments about the sound and the positive and negative were 1:1. But I wouldn't like the sound that thousands other bands has, that's why we did not go to some famous studio. It's alright.

In the end I'd like to ask, is E. Pand. just a fun or you have any serious goals - which?

Vidar: We all take our band as a very serious thing, that's why we play what we do and not some grind-crust-noise whatever, that lyrics deal with some anal organs or some other delicate stuff. We keep our goals for ourselves, otherwise they would not come true, but

I cas say, that we would like to have concerts in Slovakia and also in foreign countries and we would like to have big number of fans (an underground number of course).

(R.I.P.).



History of this band is not so long, because its creation dates back to July 1996, but roots reaching up until year 1993, when a band "SOOR" came into existence. One of this problem appears when the band is preparing to go the studio. That's why, the term of the recording was brought forward to April 1997. Within 28 hours in Půda Studio in Jeseník a demo - tape named "INHUMAN VISIONS" begins to exist as the latest but surely not last act of "Limits of Nescient"


