



LP, which also included bands as OBITUARY and ATHEIST, they made their own, self finansed LP "Illusions", which was released on tape under the name "Chemical Exposure" and now they are on RoadRacer Rec. and They have an LP out called "Swallowed In Black", but all this is in the interview I made with Steve Digiorgio, the bassist in this band.

- For how long has SADUS existed ?
"For about 6 years by know!"

- How did the "Illusions/Chemical Exposure"do and how gas the new LP been doing until now ?

"The "Illusions/Chemical Exposure" LP has done pretty good by our standards anyway, close to 8500 copies album and cassette. The new album of course is doing much better because of the help from the label."

- Is it true that RoadRacer will re-do
"Illusions..." ?

"It's very possible, but for now, we're still selling it."

- Are you satisfied with your contract with RoadRacer Rec. ?


"It's the best we could get at this time actually."

- Why did you change the SADUS logo from the original logo to the new one ?

"It's more interesting to change it around album to album. We had to have 2 different logos on the new LP because the German distributors didn't like the style of the SS's we came up with for the new design."

- What's your fave music/ what is on your record player at the moment ?

"Right now, I listen to a lot of: SOLI-TUDE AETURNUS (I hope that's right spelled...ED!), PSYCOTIC WALTZ, WATCHTOWER, DEATH, and SPYRO GYRA."





- What do you think of all these 'zines popping up today ?

"The Zines are the mere cause of the spreading of a bands information on and about the bands. I think they are very important."

- Have you played in other bands than SADUS ?

"Yes a session work, which each time I was a member os SADUS still. AUTOPSY, and another one of my friends bands, and now I'm getting ready to do the bass on DEATH's new album."

- What's your shittiest gig ?
"One I never made it to in '87. They were
SAD because all of US weren't there."

- What's the idea behind the title and the drawing on your new LP ?

"It's symbolic of the world as we know it is being swallowed into the blackness."


- A last word to the reader ?

TRANSGRESSOR "Twisting Brochus" Demo '90

This is a 3 piece band from Japan. Now you might think that this is yet another grind band from Japan, but infact TRANSGRESSOR plays death metal with a lot of breaks and slow parts. I do like this demo a lot and it has grown on me as something I can't explain. Infact I like their way to combine their death metal and I don't think that they need another guitarist. There is 5 tracks on this demo, one of them is instrumental. I've heard their music somewhere before cuz TRANSGRESSOR is for for sure influenced by MORBID ANGEL and a bit PARADISE LOST, and maybe they uses to many direct riffs from these bands, but still I like TRANSGRESSOR's way to play death metal. There is a pretty good sound on the demo, maybe a litle to compact. I especially like the guitar on the demo and the bass is also good, and mixing those two things together with the drums then you get some ultra death metal. I know they're going to release a split EP with MESSIAH DEATH in Feb. '91, but until then, I suggest you to check out this ultra death metal release, it costs 5\$ everywhere.

Too bad that this demo has got a bad production, the drums and vocals are too loud, the guitars and the bass fades into each other in a some kind a murmur in the background. Actually all 5 tracks sounds alike and that's one of the reasons why this demo gets boring in no time, One other reason is that their music is mostly build up by simple and boring riffs and I need a good and wellplayed solo or two on this demo aswell. One thing is positive about it, it is Christoffer of THERION who's doing the vocals and he is very good. My advice to these dudes is to dump all the simple and boring riffs and try to make something that's harder to do. I know they're up to a new demo soon. Write and ask'em how things are doing. I don't know the price of this demo but I think 5\$ is enough, but write and ask.

- Are you satisfied with the "Impending Doom" EP ?


"Yeah, I guess you can say we're satisfied."

- What will your next release be ?
"It'll definitly be an LP but we can't
tell what company yet."

- How did your "Conflict Within" demo do? "It did great! Generally all the zines got into it. But we stopped selling it when it reached 500 copies. Some people have kept sending money for it, but we just returned their money back."

- What do you think of racism ?
"I'm not a racist, so I guess I don't

like it."



- Is there a lot of street violence in your area, what do you think of it?
"My block usually isn't that bad, but in general it does get really violent here in Los Angeles. Even our friend who introduced us (SADISTIC INTENT) together, got killed walking home one night. He got shot in the back of the head which practically killed him instantly. I think that fuckin' type of bullshit sucks! There's even been times when we've had

guns pulled out on us. But so far we've been lucky and nothing tragic has happened to us."

- What's your fave movies ?

"I like different types of movies, some of my faves are: The Seventh Sign, The Exorcist, Die Hard, Raiders Of The Lost Arc, The Evil Dead, The Good The Bad And The Ugly, Dawn Of The Dead, and the list goes on.

- Who have you been touring with ?
"We've only toured once so far. And on
that tour we did a couple of shows with
MORBID ANGEL and we also headlined ourselves on the rest of the shows."

- Tell me about the shittiest gig you e-ver had ?

"One time we played and there was a gang who got mad at us because Enrique (vo-cals) told them, if they didn't know how to slam, stay out of the pit. Then they started talking shit and spitting at us on stage. Then we got of stage and they wanted to jump us. But somehow they ended up fighting some other people instead. We then quickly loaded up our stuff while that happened. After they finnished, they startet to throw beer bottles at us while "Impending Doom" EP yet, Well at least we were leaving."



- What's your fave beer ?

"As far as beer goes I don't have a particular fave, at least, right now,I don't the others do either, we'll drink anything as long as it's free. But some that we prefer would be Budweiser, Miller Draft, etc, etc.

- How often does SADISTIC INTENT practice weekly ?

"Lately we haven't been practicing but when we do it's like two times a week."

- A last word ?

"Thanx alot Morten, good luck with TRE-CHOMA Mag. And of course, thanx alot to all you who support SADISTIC INTENT, we really do appreciate it. And if you still haven't our "Impending Doom" EP, order it now from Wild Rags Rec it costs 10\$, See va!

They do some good death thrash, but they still need to work on some parts in their music, cuz some of them are rather simple and boring, still some of their death thrash is great and played with high energy. I know they are going to have an 12" EP out soon, followed up by a full LP sometime near summer.

I don't like their vocal cuz I don't think he fit into the music. Else I can say that they do some good breaks and they give almost all what they got in themselves in each track. Just by listening to the music from BLOODBATH, I can hear that the eastern countries is starting to

produce up dated death metal. I think you should order this demo for 6\$ US (everywhere), they also have t-shirts for 15\$ US(everywhere).

SACRIFICIAL "Sacrificial Combustion" Reh. 2 '91

This is the 2nd Reh. from these Danish death metal freaks. They are hoping to get in the studio to record their debut demo as soon as possible. This is one of the best Danish newcomers I've heard. They're not that original but their death metal is very brutal. This is a rehearsel tape and of course the sound is of course not good. Although I mean that these guys are one of the best newcomers from Denmark, then I also think they have to work on a lot of things before they enter the studio. I think they have to work on their solo's which isn't the best and then they they have to work on the vocals which I don't think sounds good. Their line-up is Claus Julius (bass/backing vocals), Lukas Meier (drums), Esben Christiansen (guitar) and Kræn Meier (guitar Willingboro, NJ 08046/ USA /vocals). Lukas sure knows how to play the double bass drums and that is a plus for this band. There are 4 songs on this reh. tape and it comes with a prof printed, glossy cover. This is a five piece band from NJ. They play a crossover inspiret technical thrash. The demo gets boring pretty fast cuz they play their drum rythm very monotom and the numbers sound like each other. But there is no thought about that these guys are great musicians they just does'nt combine their music right. Of course this demo isn't only bad, JUDGEMENT plays some good solos on it and the sound is clear. Their line-up is Andy Bordynowski (guitar), Rich Bordynowski (guitar), Steve Kraft (drums), Ernie Hilbert (bass) and Kyle Rivera (vocals). I don't like Kyles way of singing, it sounds like he's trying to sound brutal but can't do it, but then again, his style of singing fits into the music and would sound weird with another voice.

Retarded Minds

First they recorded "Tangled In Gore" and by SKELETAL EARTH, our album will be out Mind" and now they have a record deal with Foundation 2000, their name is GORE-FEST and if you haven't checked out this band then you better read this interview I did with Jan-Chris the bassist in the band.

- How and when was GOREFEST formed ? "The original idea for GOREFEST was formed by me and Frank, as we decided to form a death metal band, it took place in '88. It took us very long to get a lineup together, infact till the end of '89, when a second guitarist named Alex and a drummer named Mark completed the band. After only 10 weeks we decided to enter a studio and we recorded our 1st demo titled "Tangled In Gore"."

- Do you like living in the Dutch death metal scene ?

"I like living in Holland, for the fact that it's quite a free country and on the other hand maybe also cuz we got quite a good death metal/HC scene, lately with a lot of new bands but also some older like THANATOS and PESTILENCE of course."

- How did your "Tangled In Gore" demo do? "It sold about 550-600 copies, I think That's quite good for a debut demo. We had a lot of nice comments for it and it is still available."

- Why the name GOREFEST ?

"Cuz it's perfect to our music, it's heavy, it's filthy, it's gore so that's why we choosed it, and more important, it sounds well. Frank came up with it, so the credit goes to him."

- Have any labels been showing interest GOREFEST ?

"Quite a lot, but our first LP/CD will be released on Foundation 2000 recs., it's quite a new label from Holland, they did the SEMPITERNAL DEATHREIGN album, and in December they'll release the debut LP/CD

then they recorded "Horrors In A Retarded in the end of April, but before that there also will be a 7" with our "Horrors In A Retarded Mind" demo, probably on "Rotten Recs." a small U.S.A. label, cuz our 7" will be easy to get over there."

- What will the LP be titled, any numbers ready at the moment ?

"We don't have a good title for it yet, about song titles, there'll be 6 songs from the 2 demos...I think, plus some new tracks which are unreleased (and wont be played live aswell until the album is released) and 2 of them are already finnished and are called "Mental Misery" and "Infamous Excistance"."

- How has the underground reciewed both your demos ?

"Very well, we reciewe an almost enormous amount of mail from all over the world,

and everyone was very enthuastic about our demos, some told us we were the best underground death metal band from Europe, I don't think that's true, but I think that we have becomed quite a household name in the underground scene. I hope the people will like our album aswell."

- When you're playing live, do you often think of cookies or beer ?

"Normally I just try to keep up with the drummer + the 2 guitarists + try to keep my vocal as heavy as possible, so I don't think about cookies or beer."

- Tell about the funniest gig you ever

"I guess the funniest gig we ever had was one we played in Bietigheim in Germany, cuz we did the first song as a three piece band, the second guitarist, Alex, lost gigs we play, hopefylly also in Denmark his way in town as he went looking for a pub to get a beer, after wards we had a good laugh about it, but at the moment that we had to start up and we couldn't find him, we were quite angry with him."

- Do you know any Danish bands ? "Yeah, I know INVOCATOR, we played with them at that gig in Bietigheim, I think they are very technical + a very very tight live band."

- Do you think GOREFEST will exist in 5 years from now ?

"No, I think not, we aren't looking to the future, we only think of the near future but not more than 1 year at a time, we still will be playing music, maybe

still in GOREFEST, but I don't know by know."



- Tell me about SHA-DES OF GREY ?


"Well, SHADES OF GREY started in January '89 as a regular old thrash band, nothing new or anytthing. We just wanted to play basic speed metal, that's all. Things took a turn for the worst for the band when the original quitarist left. The band had no idea what they were getting into, they just decided to try and find someone who took the band seriously, instead of all the local musicians who had nothing to do but waste time. Well in April I became the bands manager and two months later Alan Pearson joined the band, I do the bass playing. We recorded the demo I send you, in September '89, so as you can see it's an rather old demo for us. We only play two numbers of it now, "Under The Skeptics Eye" and "Terminal Affliction". Every once in a while we do "Sounds Of War"!!"

- Why that name, and what does it mean?
"The old guitarist from the band picked that name, we had like 50 different names to choose from, and at the beginning

we wanted to be as original as possible, so they picked that name. There are to many bands with names like DEATHGRIND or BIG HAIRLYGRIND DEATH (What?....ED!) and we just wanted something a little different. The name isn't meant to be a mellow sounding name, it's meant to be a kind of dark ominous sounding, that's why we picked it. People say that SINDROME had the same kind of idea, use it as dark sounding."

- How has your "House Of Fools" Demo been doing so far ?

"So far we have gotten rid of a little over 500 copies, which isn't too bad. We were hoping to sell at least 600-700 copies, but I'm satisfied with 500. They are still selling and infact it has started to pick up again in the last month or so. This last week we sold about 10 copies, so I was real happy about that. I have got to go and get more demos made. I think were going to go for about 1000-1500 copies next time, but I'll worry about how to market that one later on."



- What will your next release be, and when ?

"Our next demo will be called "Under The Skeptics Eye" and will have 4 songs on it It should be out in roughly 2-3 weeks, it depends on when everything gets done. We have the cover artwork done and are just finished recording the songs, so we will see how long it will take."

- What will your future style be, as "

"One song to listen to on the demo for our current style would be "Under The Skeptics Eye" with a lot of different changes and such. Plus it will be faster and heavier than the last demo. Some of the songs on the new demo are old, like "So Who's Your God" that song is really old for us, so you'll be able to see why that is like the old demo (sort of) but it's still a good song for us to play,

"Pizza Face" was just a "Let's have fun sng", nothing special or anything. The songs on the demo are real old, and I must say that the only songs that fit us is "Under The...", but even that doesn't do us much justice,"

- Why did you record a song like "Pizza Face", I mean you're much more talented muscians ?

"Because we like the song, but now we're totally sick of it. We wrote this song before Peter was in the band, and Dave and I agreed that we wanted it on the demo cuz it was the first song we wrote together as a joke, and we did infact like it once!!! We won't do anything like it again, we putted it on the demo to show people that we can do another style, but we did it just to get the song out of our system!!! It seems to be one of the better songs live, when we play it, people just goes nuts."



- Fave bands/ fave music ?
"One of my fave bands today is INFERNAL
MAJESTY, they rule. I also listen to SACRIFICE, KREATOR, SADUS, SEPULTURA and
otehr bands here and there, but I listen
to INFERNAL MAJESTY."

- From where do you get your musically inspiration ?

"Along time ago I went to a show that had AT WAR and BLIND ILLUSION playing, and everybody went nuts when they went to see that show, and I knew that was what I wanted to do for a while. My brothers influenced me in plaing bass, so I have them to thank for getting me started, but it was those bands above that got me thinking about what I wanted to do.(jeff interrupts) I saw SLAYER play a long time ago, and then EXODUS, and I just wanted to play live in front of a lot of people, and when I saw how much fun they had, I said "What the hell, let's try it, and see what happens!"."

- Who have you played with ?

"We have done a lot of shows, but let me think!! OK, let's start this, we have played with bands as ANACRUSIS, REALM, ZOETROPE, NUM SKULL, MACABRE, THE CURSED, THANATOPSIS, DOOMSDAY, NEURO TOXIN, FUNE-RAL NATION and a few others here and there that I can't recall."

- What's your fave beer ?

"I have started to drink a lot of garbage, but I can't really remember what it was called. I think it's Michelob, but maybe Miller Genuine Draft, I'm not sure. I like Samuel Adams and Mickey's Big Mouth that stuff's good."

- A last word ?


LOBOTOMY "When Death Draws Near" Demo '90

- How has the tour with ENTOMBED and SIN-ISTER been going ?

P"The tour went good for all bands. In average 200-300 people every night. We played 10 gigs in Holland and 1 gig in Belgium. Almost every gig was good."


- Then tell me about the funniest gig on the tour ?

P"I think the funniest gig was on the afternoon show in Holland. It was a very small club with a small stage. First I entered the stage and made a feedback solo and acting kinda Jimmy Hendrix, then came Herwig and we played a MANOWAR show. Or, also on the Holland tour we played Santa Claus on one show and gave cookies and chocolate to the crowd."

- I also know you've been playing in Poland before you came here, how was it to

play there ?

M"It wasn't that good, first we had to play in Warzawa, but then there were some trouble with the organizers and we had to play in a town called (something I can't hear...ED!). There were enough people, but we get any money cuz the girl who should have given us the money, disappeared on the next day, but we didn't count on getting to much money. Luckely it was not expensive to sleep and eat on a good hotel so it didn't matter...I was another experience...We're not going to play there again."

- Did you like the local band that played here tonight?

M"Yeah, it's funny cuz there's a project me and Herwig (bass) wants to make with a guy, total death metal with a clear vocal and it reminded me of that, cuz it's kin of that music and the vocals are clean." Why did Haral leave DISHARMONIC ORCHES-

TRA, are you still seing him?

M"Harald is still a good friend of ours, I meet him almost every day and... But at the time when he left the band it was really strange. He wasn't that much into playing and he couldn't say much in our band, I understand why he left the band. It's also good for us, cuz we like to play only 3 people we won't play more

than 3 people. We didn't argue or have troubles with him, he just wanted to form his own band. Sometimes he's a bit strange but he's funny, we don't have troubles with him."

- I know you have been playing in USA earlier this year, how many gigs did you play and how was the response on you? M"We played 5 club gigs, the really best gig was the last one, it was a really big Raytown, MO 64133/ USA festival we played as the 2nd last band. The headliner was AUTOPSY and before us, there were some bands as IMMOLATION, RE-PULSION, CANNIBAL CORPSE. We really enjoied it, met a lot of people, but for us it was more a kind of holiday cuz there were much time between the gigs. We could have made more gigs, but we had made some mistakes with our tickets, so we had to

leave out about 10 gigs cuz we couldn't get this flying ticket cuz it's only in Europe you can get'em, in America it's impossible. It was a great time, much experience."

- And the response, how was it ? M"It was really cool but there are not that many people at gigs like here in Europe. When you tell them(the US bands) that you have about 300 people at every gig, they look big...It's not the same scene as in Europe...What do I know, America is big. They don't have much promotion, they have flyers which they spread through the post, but the don't have posters, even not at slayer gigs, only with very big bands they have posters."

- A last word ?

M"One word ? ha ha ha ha (Words...MN!)... oh it's always the same...Peace, love, funk, thanx.



MOONCALF "Kill The Fool" Demo '90

This is the debut release from MOONCALF, and what a debut. They play overvaried techno thrash with funk parts, in the vein of VOIVOD and yep they're great. I don't know for how long time they have been playing together but it must have been for a couple of years, cuz they're very tight and they know exactly what kind of music they wants to play....And what a weird style. I like the bass sound, it has this funk kinda sound also used by FAITH NO MORE. My first impression of this demo was that it was good, but then I heard it again, and I found out that it was a genious demo. MOONCALF is: Chris Fugitt (drums), Ron Fuller (guitar), Marshall Strong (bass) and Brian Sullivan (guitar/ vocals). I'm glad these guys got together cuz I think what they make is very extreme. I would call it, techno thrash with a difference. It's almost an LP cuz there's 9 songs and the sound is in top. It costs 8\$ US (everywhere) which normally is expensive, but in this case it's cheap. Yugo thrash attack!

Yugoslavia is one of the Eastern European countries with a long metal tradition. Of course when thrash started spreading over eastern Europe, Yugoslavia was no exception to that wave. In the late '80's Yugoslavia developed quite a lively thrash scene. At the moment the most promesing Yugoslav band is BLOODBATH, they play MERmerciless techno deaththtrash in the vein of SEPULTURA, SODOM, KREATOR, PESTILENCE and SLAYER. BLOODBATH were formed in Feb. '88, and their current line-up is: DAM-Damjan (vocals), Staca (guitar), Kerry (guitar), Vlada (bass) and Mengele (drums). So far, they have recorded two great demos (1st, a two track tape in '89, and then a 6 track tape in '90) They have delivered gigs in Yugoslavia and Poland. A 7" single should be out in Jan. '91 (That's by know...ED!), and their debut album, should be out in the summer the same year. The band is still negotiating with various labels. DEMONIAC. They play melodic, yet aggressive power metal. Back in August '86, when they were playing under the name SATANS WARRIORS, they played HC with some metal influences. After recording one demo, they changed their style into speed thrash in the vein of early ONSLAUGHT. Their 2nd and their 3rd demo ends this phase of their career. Finally on this 4th demo, in winther '88, DEMONIAC began producing catchy, yet aggressive power metal. Concerts and 5th demo followed. - Why did you change the original logo, to the new logo ?

"To fit the cover better and to make it easier to read."

- Is it the same Dan who has drawen the MORBID ANGEL cover, who has drawen yours? "Yes he's a killer artist (I agree in that...ED!)"

- Who is your fave drummer ? "The drummer of WATCHTOWER."

 Do you listen to other styles of music, than death metal ?

"I only listen to different styles of metal."

- A last comment to the damned readers ? "Check out our debut LP "The Key" on Earache Rec., and see your on tour."

A Mystical Warning

Well here I have an interview with Danish techno thrashers EIDETIC. Me and Peter sat and drank some beers while the interview was made, so if you think the interview gets abit weird then blame it on hte beer. Well atleast, here's the interview I did with Peter the drummer of EIDETIC.

- Please tell me some background about EIDETIC ?

"Jonas and I played together and then we knew Dan that just had started to play the guitar, and then we got us a very small rehearsel room with a terrible sound, and then we played down there for a while. We played some HC, noise and grind core. But then one day, we decided to get serious about what we did, and then we got a new rehearsel room with a better sound in, it's actually the same rehearsel romm as INVOCATOR. Then we began to make our own songs, a bit more technical than the grind core we played before."

- I know you've had a lot of band name changes, tell me some names you've had?
 "First we were called BONEHEADS and the we changed it to ODD BALD MEN, and we were called THE FAREWELL SINKING SHIP, actually we were called LOBOTOMY for a short while, and now, at last we're called EIDETIC."
- I know you didn't send your debut demo out to any labels, will you do that with the next one ?

"Yeah, cuz we know that we can stand for what we do on the next demo, we have developed a lot since the "Non Conspicuous Warning" demo. The new tracks are much much more technical than the old ones, we are more proud of the new tracks."

- And did people like "Non ..." ?
"No, not at all...Ha ha ha, well yeah,

actually people liked it much more than we had thought they would. Fanzines that we have send promopackets to, liked it. Especially other bands liked it alot. they said it was the greatest. Also a lot of death metal bands liked it, cuz they think it's different and they think it's original and it's not the typical crap... And also people who bought the tape liked it a lot. (Well, many people say they do not like it becuase of Mortens vocals.... ED!) Yeah, well that's because they're used to their normal death, raw voice, and Morten doesn't sing with the deepest, most raw vocal, he sings with a more normal voice, and I think that fits more into our music, I don't think it would be god if we had a death metal voice, but it is true that there is a lot of people thinks our demo is shitty because of Mortens voice."

- How did yo come up with a name like EIDETIC, and what does it mean ?

"Dan came up with the name, that was right after we had called us ODD BALD MEN, which was a name we liked, but then we thought EIDETIC sounded more mystical, but it's also a weird and original name. It comes from Greek language, and it means a phase in the early puberty where you can create visions from the future and the past with your imagination...It's kind of hard to explain."

- Why do you play techno thrash ?

"I don't know if you can call it techno thrash, we're trying to do it as technical as possible. There have to be some challenge in the music, it's no fun to play straight ahead thrash or death metal ...I mean it's great to listen to, but it is more fun to play technical."

- Haven't the rest of EIDETIC helped Dan with writing the lyrics ?

"Hm, Dan has written all the lyrics himself. Me and Jonas have tried to write lyrics but they didn't turn out good. But now Morten has written a lyric, which we are putting music on now. But Dan has written all the lyrics, it's a shame cuz we would all like to write our lyrics but it's not that easy...And I also think Dan writes some good lyrics."

- Who have you played live with, just to take a boring one ?

"HECTIC, INVOCATOR, DEADHEAD, GERONIMO, DISHARMONIC ORCHESTRA, DISMEMBER, and then we have played with several smaller

bands from Germany, Denmark etc etc. The greatest gig was with DISHARMONIC O. cuz it just turned out so good for us (Yeah, you started bleeding in the middle of the concert...ED!) Yeah I did, Per(IN-VOCATOR drummer) haven't washed the blood of his right cymbal yet, totally disgusting, I don't get it, but he thinks it looks great."

- Tell me about each member ? "Morten, he's 18 years old, singing in the band. He's being educated on Buisness school, and he uses most of his sparetime with skating and with his girlfriend Charlotte...Bitch, cock, sloth ha ha ha. He skates very much but he talks to much, no he's very funny. He's happy to tell about the time when he lived in Kenya, specially the store about Uffe Elleman. Jonas, I've known him for about 6-7 years he's 17 years old, we're in the same gymnasium class. He's tall and he's blond. He also skates a lot. He plays the bass, he's very happy to play the bass. He's totally crazy about reggae and Lenny Cravitch, Jelly Fish. He's funny, great dude Dan, he's 21 or is it 22, he's working at a place where he cleans fishing machines, he's just been chosen deputy there. He's just moved together with his girlfriend Mette, they live in a small apartment. He loves to play the guitar. He listens to a lot of classical music, Mahler and so. He paints, draws a lot, he's funny. And then there's me, I'm playing the drums, 16 years old, going in same class as Jonas. I'm using most of my time with ...Ryge BASSE (A Danish crap word...ED!) ha ha ha, I'm together with my friends, doing my homework, answerin letters and I am writing in another Danish zine, LACER-ATION mag...Yupie. And then I listen to a lot of death metal, but then again I like VOIVOD, WATCHTOWER and so on."

- I know you do a blues band together with Jonas, what's that ?

"It's me and Jonas, he plays the bass and he does the singing, I play the drums and we have one of our classmates, his name is Thomas, and he does the piano/ keyboard. And the we have a dude on guitar called Christian. We play Jimmy Hendrix cover tracks and Lenny Cravitch and everything...blues stuff, that's funny. You have to be oprnminded in what music concerns (Do you have a name for that band ? ...ED) Nix, no we don't, we are trying to find a name but the best suggestion so far is SUR MÆLK (which means Bad/ old milk) but we didn't feel like using it, ha he ho ho ha, No we have to find a name cuz you can't walk around without a name" What will EIDETIC do in 10 years from now ?

"Well, we will have our greatest hits and a double live album out...of course...And then a ton of bootlegs ha ha ha ha ha, no I don't know what we'll be doing, it would be a little boring still doing demo's. It would be great with a LP or two, I mean it's not bad to hope. Of course it isn't sure we'll be playing in EIDETIC anymore."


- How did you find Morten ?

"Me and Jonas knew him cuz we're skating and he had heard that we were searching for a vocalist, he asked if he could try, so we dragged him to our rehearsel place and then we got surprised cuz he's a quick learner, he's so easy to work with. And then we picked him."


- When do you think your 2nd demo will be out ?

- Do you think there's a change for a record deal when your new demo will be out?




Jonas is mangling his bass





They're pretty tight and they can combine their music, so that it sounds very varied. PROTECTED ILLUSION uses so many good breaks and they are very original. The first thing I noticed about this band, was their other one plays a totally different rythm or a drummer, he's a maniac, he plays the double bass solo. This is so dead that my tape recorder was drums so fast that it's unbelieveble. Then I heard the guitars, and they also shreds. The on- and it's also very original. I can't give them ly thinh I think iis a bit irritating to listen to is the vocals. Rytkönnen sounds like he's trying to copy Darren Travis (SADUS) and, well actually succeeds, but I think he sounds irritating. There's 8 tracks on this cassette LP, and one of them suddenly fades into a kind of ballad, I think it's great they use that effect on the recording, cuz it just shows that they can do other styles than just playing fast. - How is Relapse Rec. to work with, do decide for you what to do ?

"Matt from Relapse Rec. is a gerat guy to deal with. I feel were pretty fortunate to be dealing with him. He's been real flexible and patient with us, and is basically letting us call the shots with the record. Like I said before, we're really glad to be dealing with Relapse, Matt is a great guy."

- Do you think they can give you enough attention to the whole world?

"Well Relapse has some good distribution, and I know Relapse will definately be expanding in the near future, so I guess we will just have to wait and see what will happen."

- Do you think there's to many trend death metal bands, who just plays death metal because it's being more and more popular?

"I really can't see that yet, but around our tri-state area, death isn't all that popular. But on the other hand this might hold true around areas where death metal has a decent following. Fuck I've NAPALM DEATH was on MTV! Obviously it's starting to get out there."

- How is a ROTTREVORE gig ?

"We definately go for the tractor sound! I guess we also try to convey a lot of energy, the way I look, if people are going to spend their time seeing us play, then they deserve to have something worth watching and listening to. Whether we're worth it or not, I can't say, but we try" - Have you only signed for one 7" on Relapse Rec.?

After the release of their "The Manifes ttation" demo '88, which was their 2nd demo release and it got good reviews in magazines and fanzines throughout the whole world, they've played a lot of gigs, and they've opened for bands as DEATH ANGEL, SEPULTURA, DEATH, FORBID-DEN, CARCASS, MORBID ANGEL, DEVASTATION, etc etc etc. A lot of labels contacted them, but they didn't get an offer that fitted to PRIME EVIL. They then sold a lot of demos and played even more gigs and today their "The Manifestation" demo has sold over 2000 ex. Then in '90 they entered the studio once again to record a promo demo which only was meant to be send out to labels and maybe catch a good deal on. Unfortunaly they have, so far, gotten 8 rejections on it, but Relapse Rec. showed a bit of interest. PRIME EVIL didn't know what to do, so they entered the studio once again and re-mixed the promo tape. The promo tape got a much heavier sound and they are now planning to re-send to some of the labels that did reject them the first time. But the Relapse thing isn't over yet either. Relapse would like to release the promo demo for PRIME EVIL, but they are still talking details, and it is still unknown to everybody what they'll do. To everybody's knowledge the line-up is still the same: Gary Day (guitar), Andy Eichhorn (vocals), Mike Usifer (guitar), Todd Gukelberger (drums) and Mary Ciullo (bass). When DISMEMBER and DISHARMONIC ORCHESTRA visited Esbjerg, I did an interview with both bands, here is the interview with DISMEMBER.



- Please tell me the story of DISMEMBER?

"We started up in '88 and after two demos and 1 year after we started I left for CARNAGE, we got one deal with NECROSIS recs. And we made the LP and then Matti and David joined, David was in ENTOMBED for a short while, and the rejoined and we recorded the LP and then Michael left. So we had to change the name cuz he was the founder of the band. So we formed DISMEMBER again and recorded the "Reborn In Blaspemy" demo...And now we have a record deal with Nuclear Blast Rec."

- Conserning the deal with Nuclear Blast
Rec., is it good or is it bad ?
"Yeah, it's good and it's a three record
deal."

- And when will your debut be out ?
"We'll enter the studio and record it in
next month and it'll be out sometime during the summer."

- I know that MERCILESS should have played here tonight, why didn't they show up tonight?

"The money wasn't enpugh. We were supposed to rent a bus together with'em and

play in Copenhagen and in Esbjerg, but the Copenhagen gig didn't work out, so MERCILESS didn't want to play."



- I know the scene is big in Sweden, do you think it's hard to get wellknown the-

"It depends on what attitude you have on music at all, it's very personally in Sweden, you know, in the beginning we all helped each other but know it all is competition. Bands are very jalous, y'know, "We got a record deal and you don't got a record deal, then you're shit!". They try to play so fast and sing as dark as possible. Yeah all the trended death metal stuff, play as fast as possible and sing brutal, CARCASS is the main influence, almost everybody copies CARCASS and it sounds like shit."

- You say in Sweden that it's about playing fast, be the best, is there a kind of sick way to be like in Sweden ?

"Well many idiots makes a lot of false rumors, they talk shit about you. You can not do a thing without somebody complaining about it.



they don't like it they can fuck off, we do our thing cuz we like it, and if thy don't like it...then fuck off it's not our problem. It's like we were in the

scene from the beginning and we're not that old, but nowadays many people listen to MORBID ANGEL and stuff like that but they think, cuz we have a band and a record deal they call us rockstars and stuff like that. ENTOMBED and us, because we're friends and we both got a record deal, then everybody hates us...probably after this interview, they'll hate us even more...ha ha ha!"

- Did you like playing here tonight ? "Yeah, great place, the best crowd we ever had, but we're not that much a performance group cuz this was only the 5th gig we ever played with this line-up. It is always funny to play outside Sweden, cuz gigs in Sweden are very boring, it's the competition shit again. Some band members who doesn't like the band playing's attitude then they won't go to the gig...That's very childish and if you ask them what they think about the gig, then they'll say "Oh you did a bad show" it's always like that..."


- Last word ?

"Well, thanx for the interview and good luck with your zine. Hello to everybody in Denmark, thank for being so supportive. We would like to thank Frank from Alborg, if he read this, he's a real cool guy. He helped us, Richard and Matti (I think...ED!) we were very sick, we puked and we didn't play yesterday cuz we were it's really fucked, but we don't care, if so sick and he helped us, came up with tea and stuff like that, he was very kind without him we couldn't make it today. thanx alot!"

JESUS SAVE "Eye For Eye..." demo '90

This tape I got from a Danish management called Artless Management. The dude is promoting a band called JESUS SAVE. They play thrash. The sound on this tape is rather bad and it's hard to hear all the instruments. I think it sounds like the drummer isn't that good, it sounds like he's playing the same over and over again. All the 4 tracks on this demo sounds alike and actually they aren't that good, they need originality, more playing skill and then they need another vocalist cuz this dude on this tape is very irritating to listen to. I don't know when JESUS SAVE was formed, but one thin I do know, is that they don't like their style called death metal, they prefer life instead of death but I call their style for thrash.

I think they shuld stay a little longer in their rehearsel room and try to do some more original stuff, cuz I actually don't think this demo is worth listening to. One thing I like is that Artless Management isn't trying to make money on this release, and if you'll like to check it out then it costs 3\$ (everywhere). DEADHEAD "The Festering" Demo '90

DEADHEAD is a Dutch death thrash band, and their line-up is: Tom Van Dijk (bass/ vocals), Hans Spijker (Drums), Robbie Wonning (guitar) and Ronnie Van Der Wey (guitar). They play some aggressive death thrash, not the most original way but they have some very good ideas in their music. On this debut studio demo they have slowed a bit down, but they still have some of the old, very fast DEADHEAD parts in them. The best way I to describe their music, would be a mix between new SLAYER, old KREATOR, SADUS and POSSESSED, but still they have their own way playing. The sound on this demo is very good, and I especially like the guitar playing of Robbie and Ronnie, just listen to the solos. Hans Spijker delivers some very good and tight drumming, without sounding like a machine. The only thing I'm not so crazy about is Tom's vocals, cuz they're very Mille like (KREATOR), but anyway, they fit in the music, so it doesn't matter. If you haven't heard DEADHEAD yet, I think it would be about time, cuz their next release might be an LP. ROTTREVORE "The Epitome Of Panalgia" Demo '90

ROTTREVORE was formed back in '89 by Mark Mastro (guitar/ vocals) and Chris Weber (guitar/vocals) After some months of practice, Chris Free (bass) joined, and at last after immence trouble they found Nick Esquivel (drums). Then they released the demo "The Epitome Of Pantalgia" in '90. I really don't know what to say about this democuz it has got a miserable sound. So it demanded some patience to get an idea about what was going on. But except for the sound this is a good demo. These guys seems to be good at their instruments, but of course that is a bit hard to hear with the sound of this tape. Howeever their music are quite original, and Chris and Marks vocals are very brutal, a bit in the vein of GRAVE. The only positive thing I can say about the sound, is that the solos come out very clear comparing to the rest. If I had to compare them to anyone it should be AUTOPSY cuz their slow parts and some of their riffs has got some of the brutal roughness that AUTOPSY has to. But in general I would say that these guys plays a bit faster than AUTOPSY. I know they're signed to Relapse Rec. for a 7" called "c.o.t.a.w." and it should be out soon, until then you better check out this demo, it features 5 tracks and it costs 4\$ US (In the US) and 5\$ US (Elsewhere). DEFAMATORY Reh. '90

DFAMATORY is a Danish death metal outfit which was started back in '88, then as a doom metal band. But after some line-up changes, and a lot of difficulties they now play what I call very resonable death metal. Their current line-up is: Rene (drums), Kenneth (guitar), Ricco (guitar), Flemming (bass) and Kim (vocals). Okay that was some history and now to the rehearsel tape. It starts out with a long keyboard intro, not a bad one but it's to long. The first song is called "Entering The Future" which also is the highlight of this tape. It contains some heavy riifs and some quite good grind parts, right as a death metal song should do. The next song is also very nice, but it hasn't got the same raw power, grind parts and so, as the first one. They also play "Subconciuos Terror" (BENEDICTION), and it's quite wellplayed, but Kim hasn't got a powerfull enough voice, but anyway, who can sing like Barney ? As this is a reh. tape I have to say that the sound isn't good. PAN-THY-MONIUM "...Dawn" Demo '90

This is Benny of EDGE OF SANITY's band, I don't know more about the band itself, so I'll just go directly into the review of their demo ...Dawn". The sound is quite okay, but I don't think that it's perfect, to say it right away their guitar sound sucks. But anyway this must be one of the weirdest demos I ever heard, not in any negative way, but realyy I've never heard anything like it, They use keyboard in every single song of this demo without actually coming close to the sound of NOCTURNUS, but it doesn't sound like they intend to either. Their song titles are matching their music alright, just listen to titles like "Dauwhnn" or "Ekkhoeece" and I promise you that I wasn't drunk or anything when I wrote this. I don't know wether to call this death metal or what, but if it's death metal these guys certanly have their own way of playing it. This is very original stuff and I can't compare them to anything. This is afterall worth checking out, it costs 5\$ US (everywhere) and comes with a full coloured cover, 4 tracks and a something I don't know what to call. 

Reek Of Themselves

Actually the headline of this interview should have been "Reek Of Sickness" but then I realized that CARCASS is a band that actually does reek of themselves, cuz, a lot of bands are trying to copy them, but only CARCASS can play the real CARCASS way. Anyway, this interview was made by me and the dude of THRASH'EM ALL Magazine, and we proudly presents the interview with Bill of CARCASS.

- First of all, could you briefly present the history of the band up to the releases of the 2 albums ?

"Our first demo, "Flesh Ripping Sonic Torment", was recorded in September '87. It was never officially released, but we did copy it for several people we knew, and that was how it became circulated. Soon afterwards, we parted company with our vocalist and reciewed an offer of a 2-LP deal with Earache Records. We began recording our first album, "Reek Of put refaction" that December, and it was eventually released the following summer. A few months later we did a rough recording of 6 new tracks, which came to know a s the "Symphonies Of Sickness" demo. Again it began to circulate quite widely despite the fact that it was never official available. In July '89 we started to work on our 2nd LP, also titled "Symphonies...". This turned out to be the first CARCASS recording that we were actually satisfied with, and it was released Nowember that same year."

- And when do you think your next album will be out ?

"We intend to record the 3rd album some time in early mid-summer. So if that goes ahead according to plan, the record should be available around September or October probably."

- To get back to your "Symphonies Of Sickness" LP, why is the picture on the cover so hard to see ?

"The cover features a smashed head. It wasn't really intentonal. The copy of the photo was quite small, and once it had been enlarged on a photocopier it was pretty grainy and distorted. For

what ever reason, it was kept like that"
- That LP was a huge step forward, both
in terms of the music and the production. From the rather HC orientated music on the "Reek..." album, you stepped
to the brutal death metal. What brought
that change? Was it musical development
or something else, as a slight change of
interest, for example?

"I don't think that "Symphonies..." is any more death metal than "Reek...".

There are aspects of both albums that defy that category. We have never been the sort of band that feels comfortable with labels like death metal, Grindcore or whatever. Obviously there is a progression between the two albums, but that's only natural. If we didn't improve or expand at all then we'd be stagnating, and as far as I'm concerned it would be better to finish altogether, than re-hash old ideas."

- Primarily, who is the author of the lyrics ? They totally rule. Could you comment generally on them ?

"On "Reek..." the lyric writing was divided fairly equally between Jeff, Ken and myself. On "Symphonies..." Jeff wrote the majority of the lyrics, and that's the way the situation remains today. The intention has always been to write stuff that's graphic, overblown yet almost poetic, whilst retaining the entertainment value."

- What's the general idea behind your concept, I mwan with those covers, lyrics and of course music ?

"We often get asked about our concept, and one thing we feel the need to strees is that we are not trying to put across a "message". We do what we do in such way as to produce music, lyrics and packaging that complements each other. That's our main aim, but we also that the latter two aspects are able to provoke thought, amuse and intrigue." - But you must have had an awfull lot of trouble with those covers, I mean

with censur and so, haven't you ?
"We have reciewed a certain amount of

trouble due to the sleeves and lyrics, but the situation could be alot worse than it is. So far, we've just had large stores refusing to handle the albums, the occasional moronic article in newspapers, and distribution problems overseas."

- You've done a couple of "Peel sessions", and obviously, John Peel himself is dedicated to the underground, but what about the other people you met during the sessions, are they serious invovled with what they do, or didn't they take you serious?

"We've done 2 sessions for the John Peel show, and both times we found it difficult to work with the producer. All in all the conditions are far from suitable for a band wanting to make a representive recording."

- I'm kind a interested to know what you listen to mostly when you listen to music ?

"Difficult to say. At the moment I listen to Beethovens nine symphonies more than anything else, but as bands go, some of my faves would probably include QUEENSRYCHE, THIN LIZZY, CONFESSOR, SCRITTI POLITTI and KING DIAMOND."

- A last word ? "Thanx for the interview Morten!"



PSYCHOPATH "The Soul Personification" Demo '90

Was formed in January '90 by Bill Lynn (guitar/ vocals), Ben Trost (bass) and Doug McIntosch (drums). All the members have been playing in other bands before, but they decided to form their own band, what a vise decission. Usually I say that a band should stay a couple of years till they're real tight before they enters the studio, but in PSYCHOPATH's cas I'll make an exception. They play techno death metal, and I can't vein them to anybody. This demo is good, I can't find anything to change, maybe the vocals, but that's about it, it's such a small thing. The drumming is performed with technical high skill, and the guitar + bass are great. PSYCHOPATH has managed to do some real heavy stuff here with which changes from fast to slow rythms all the time. Sometimes a successfull band gets born and PSYCHOPATH is one of them. Their lyrics deal with real life gore, not horror/ splatter gore, but real life gore like drugs, alcohol etc etc. The sound on this demo is good but could have been better. PYATHROSIS "Fields Of Unceasing Death" Demo '91

Was formed in January '90 by Wiebe (bass/ vocals), Ernst (guitar) and Rene (drums). With this line-up they recorded their first demo "Siphoned Hell" which was rather bad in production and music aswell. Now Rene has left the band and his place has been taken by a dude called Hans. "Fields Of Unceasing Death" is a 100 times better than "Siphoned....", just listen to the drumming, the guitar and the bass, ups, that was all the instruments, well that must show that they all have improved a lot as musicians since then. They play death grind metal, in the vein of CARCASS and TERRORIZER. They have since the release of their debut EP gotten rid of two members, Zac Taylor (guitar) and Albert Gomes (guitar), and replaced them with John List who's taking care of all the leads in their music. I must say he has been a refreshment in their music, cuz his solos are very good, and they make the music a lot better. Actually they're only a 3 piece band now and that should normally make the music worse, but not the music of RECIPIENTS OF DEATH, no their music is still very thrashy, but they have added a lot more technical stuff into their music and that only makes it all better. Also Wild Rags Rec. have improved. Instead of making all these black n' white covers, Wild Rags have started to make full coloured covers and that's just great.

There's 4 tracks on the EP and they're all good. If John List's solos has improved the music, then I must say that the vocals still is a bit irritating to listen to, but that's also the only bad thing I'm going to say about this EP. SADISTIC INTENT delivers some brutal death metal/ thrash and I like the music a lot. Since the release of the "impending Doom" EP they have gained a member, so their line-up looks like this: Rick Cortez (guitar), Bay Cortez (bass), Enrique Chavez (vocals), Joes Marques (drums) and Vince Cervera (quitar) with those names they could come from Mexico or Spain but they don't, they come from L.A.. This Release is quite impressive, no wonder why Wild Rags signed them. Maybe the sound is a bit bad, but I am not the man to say that, cuz my tape has been X-Rayied. I like their death parts, but their grind parts doesn't fit in anywhere, so if they dropped the grind parts and concentrated on the death metal, their music would be a lot better. The guitar is okay, and the vocals is very brutal, the vocals is just tuned up to high. Of course this release isn't only shitty, I like their tempo changes, first slow then fast, it sounds good though I don't like the grind parts. I would say they're good at mixing the tempo changes, and even that makes this release worth listening to.
