HOW IS DOING YOUR 7" EP?

I really don't know because Nosferatu is a rip-off label, many people hasn't got what they have paid for so please, don't order anything from there. Fuck Nosferatu!

WEAT'S NEW AFTER YOUR 7" RELEASE?

Well, we shall hit the studio on October to record our LP/CD for Osmose Prod. It is called "Tol Cormpt Norz Norz Norz" and features new cuts like "I al Purg Vondo", "My blessing" ("The beginning of the End"), "Mortification", "Blood Red Razor Blade" etc. and some songs from the demo and Ep.

DESCRIBE YOUR UNHOLY SOUND TO OUR READERS IN PR.

Boring.... ( No way! - ED)

EOW DID YOU GET THE DEAL WITH MOSPERATU AND HOW IS TREATING YOU SUCH LABEL?

Like I said earlier, fuck Mosferatu, Roberto Cannavo can suck my shitty dick! HOW IS THE BLACK METAL SCENE IN FINLAND?

Well, us, BEHERIT, BLACK CRUCIFIXION and BARATHRUM are at least true bands, much poser shit little children playing and don't know what the fuck they are dealing with.

Well, read answer #2 plus "Succubus Mars", "Orgy", "The unholy whore" (Where's your God now? and one untitled.


FUTURE PLANS

Being in L.A. ia a great moment to check the L.A. scene so that was Reynaldo did, the next inter view was done by one of the most known bands in L.A. Theard <u>Demolition's</u> last demo and I can say that they got the balls to be in a big record label so read this words from Carlos. 12050 Sheldon St. #17c L.A. California, 91352. USA

Tell us a short story of the band.

Demolition rose up in 1986. It star ted like a grind/noise, you know punk oriented band, then different members came, and they transmited the music. They transmited into a more macabre, heavier and heavier and more darker sound better lyrics and arrangements. I guess Demolition since 1986 it changed a bit. It was until 1988 that the band found the music the band wanted to play. Now is 1992 and the band knows the direction we want. Yes, we still opening for everyone hope fully they like us and keep the underground living.

Was it easy to keep the band living due your lifetime of the band?

As you know all was different mem bers and ever since when I came we lost our drummer, it was for the better I guess, The guys is doing his own now, his band is <u>Dominium</u> And we got another drummer and you know it's hard when you come to play shows, you know some times like "shit I don't have no cash for this or for that". But eventually we come through, ever gig we play here in L.A. it's really good for us because the people, they back for us very good we got a good following, we get along with the rest of the bands here in L.A. It's been hard but it's nothing we can't handle well keep doing it!

What do you think of the other bands here in L. $\lambda$ .?

Actually, L.A. is one of the most.. we like to call it Subterranean 'cuz there's a lot of bands here that are very different. All the

bands here sound a lot different from each other and from the world. As the world knows nobody's really from L.A. has come out, you know been signed. Fear Factory just got signed, but there's a lot of great bands, that should be but you can't set it the way you want it all the time. Yes, there's a lot of great bands like ENTITY from east L.A. they play "Brutal Cadaveric Necro grind" also CATALEPSY from south central CA. Brainstorm a really great band, very different and ori ginal, little by little L.A. is known not as much we like to be, but hopefully that will change soon enough!

Influences of the band.

Well, there's a lot of bands but overall the main influence for the band it has to be BLACK SABBATH

Tell us about your demo;

It's called "When the tomb Beckows" it was done in 16 trax studio, it cost \$250 so we think the money worthing Also the demo is distributing cool in L.A. Mexico (Thanks to Despenadero and all the guys in Mexico) Also now in Puerto Rico (thanks!) we're hoping to infest everyone with it 'cuz it's really cool! Let's see what happens.

Do you have other merchandise?

Well, we got stickers for free who ever sends something. We got t-shir ts for sale.

What kind of music do you play?

Well, we like to call it "Muerte" (in spanish) death is cool but we want to keep our roots, so we play Brutalic muerte grind from subterrancan L.A. that's what Demolition is all about.

If would have to tour which bands would you like:

Ahh! I'd like to do a tour with: Bolt Thrower, Carcass, Morbid Angel, but there's too many great bands in the underground. I don't care who tour with. It could be from Mexico like: CENOTAPH, (Godz! ED) HARDWARE or' HEXX from San Francisco FEAR FACTORY, anyway if we would have to do a tour id doesn't matter with who fuck it!

I think you're a cool guy, if you get signed. Would you be the same person?

Definelity, I'll be the same guy! I think it's rather stupid when somebody changes because they're signed. You got to remember those who helped you, no matter what you'll always be who you are!

With which label would you like to sign?

I like something like R/C Recs. They're really cool with their ba nds, I've talk with some guys and they (R/C) put a good amount of help for you, like recording, tour, promotion buy any kind of label would be cool, but you always want the best for your band. It's hard to get signed. A lot of not so gre at bands are signed, but there's a lot of others who are really good.

TELL US WHY DID YOU CHOOSE THE MONIKER SEPTIC FLESH AND DID YOU HAVE ANY OTHERS?

Personally, I think that our name sucks but the other guys like it so it remained. We had some other ideas like: FORGOTTEN PATH but we didn't agreed to change it so FORGOTTEN PATH became the title of our demo.

DO YOU THINK THE GREEK SCENE IS STRONG? ARE THEY VERY SUPPORTIVE?

The greek scene is very strong. We have many great bands like: HORRIFIED, NECROMANTIA, VARATHRON, NIGHFALL, ACID DEATH, SEPTICEMIA, STIGMA, MEDIEVAL DEATH etc...There is a lot of support but from outside.

DO YOU HAVE SOME PROBLEMS WITH YOUR GOVERNMENT BECAUSE YOUR MUSIC?

We don't have problems because of our music but because of our appearance (cops love longhair!)

YOU SAID THAT YOUR MUSIC HAS PERSONALITY, COULD YOU EXPLAIN THAT?

Our music is a combination of brutal and technical parts with a weird atmosphere. Also we are not afraid to put melody in our solos! I think the result is personal.

HAVE YOU RECEIVED GOOD RESPONSE OUTSIDE EUROPE?

Yes, the response is good.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR MINI-LP AND HOW IT IS DOING?

It's called "Temple of the Lost Race" and it has 4 new tracks. "EREBUS", "ANOTHER REALITY", "TEMPLE OF THE LOST RACE", "SETTING OF TWO SUNS", we released it at the end of summer and until now it's doing very well.

WHAT KIND OF INFLUENCES HAS <u>SEPTIC</u> FLESH AND WHAT YOUR LYRICS DEAL WITH?

We listen from <u>Death</u>, <u>Celtic Frost</u>, <u>Possessed to Horror Soundtrack</u>, <u>Dead</u> <u>can Dance</u>, <u>Merciful Fate</u> etc... Our lyrics are dealing with ancient legends, Paradox, Supernatural, Fear etc.

## DO YOU HAVE SOME LABEL INTEREST?

We have contact with some labels to trade our stuff, nothing more at this time.

IN WHICH OTHER 'ZINES DID YOU HAVE APPEARED?

We have appeared in 'zines as Lobotomy, Final Holocaust, Burial Volt, Slayer, Hammerheart, Poulets, Nuclear Mosh etc...



DO YOU HAVE ANY PLAN TO TOUR OUT OF GREECE?

At this time it's not possible. need a great amount of money to tour out of Greece. This is a great problem for all the greek bands because traveling from Greece is very expensive and also here in Greece it's not existing such things as management.

WHAT'S NEXT AFTER THE MINI Lp?

Who knows? Maybe a full length Lp.



Phantasm has been acclaimed as one of the most original bands of their genre and I can't agree more with that statement. Actually they're negotiating with a major label and I have no dourt about a good record deal for them. The following in terview was done with Doug.

Why did you take so long for the recording of your new tape?

We wanted everything to be perfect so we took each instrument at a time each song and it's turn each riff at one time so it just ended up taking longer than a normal demo. We just wanted everything to be like our album the best we could do it.

The production was very expensive. How did you Handle that? Do every body work to contribute to cost the recording?

Well it took a lot of saving and time and a lot of contributing took place from everyone. No one was left out, everyone spent a lot of time and money on this one.

How many copies sold your Lycanth ropy demo and how is doing your new one?

The lycanthropy tape sold well but with this one we more than double it in the time it's been out and it's only be out for I think 2 mon ths or so.

You said that you've been scouted by big record labels, which labels have been interested, and being specific, what things they want you to do?

Well... I can't really say what label has interest or what they want us to do because for the mo ment it's just interest nothing actual specific yet. It's getting there sorry I can't say what label (s) but if if doesn't work out then I don't look too horrible.

Your sound is different than others even than your past effort, so do you have new influences.

Well... We kind s try to have a different sound and to tell you the truth we listen to a lot of differents bands but we try to have our own influences so we can make

our own style instead of copy others.

What are you looking for in a Record

A Record label, well 1 guess 1 just want one that's got good Dist. A good budget for a record good to their bands get us on tour to pro mote the album. Also to be kind a well known and the one I really want is very well known.

What things could happen to <u>Phanta</u> <u>sm</u> if you don't get signed? Would you try again with another demo?

guess we will keep trying and doing anything to get there. I guess that if we had to we would have to make another demo, but I hope it doesn't come down to that.

Why did you decide to do a cover in this demo?

We wanted to show people we could do things other than write music originaly we wanted to show we co uld re-do somethings originally plus it's a cool tone when we do it and the crowd skanes it up when we play it.

1 haven't seen a 7" ep by the band Why did you decide to not put an ep out being this so urgently po pular?

I guess we just have to get a good offer and we probably would do it if someone would write to us.

Are you planning to play at the Milwaukee metal fest this year?

Hopefully, if there is a fest in 1993 we should be playing it, yes.

EAVE YOU EAD SOME KIND OF SUCCESS WITH YOUR "WORKSHIP HIM" LP TEAT YOU

We have sold 10,000 copies of "workship him". We don't think it's a success but it was ok, for osmose, we are very glad, but no more. One thing is more important than to sold more is to sold our Lp's to people really interested by <u>Samael</u> not only for buy another Lp, I think you know what I mean. (Definitely, yes!-ED).

DID YOU FOUND ANY OBSTACLE IN YOUR LIPETIME BECAUSE OF YOUR SATANIC IMAGE? IF SO, BOW WAS YOUR REACTION?

No, not so much, yes some people askus for know if we believe in our Satanic Image and tell us if we are stupid, but this kind of people wasn't a obstacle for us, we don't care about this white Monkeys.

BOW MANY COUNTRIES HAVE YOU TOURED RECENTLY? BOW WAS THE RESPONSE?

This year we had played in Bland, URSS (Now Russia) Holland a lot, Germany and Belgium, all the answer was fucking great especially in Poland, but we have liked all countries and we hope play again in Europe and Scandinavia too, for us later is better.

I THINK YOU REMIND ME OF OLD BATHORY, DO YOU THINK THIS IS AN ACCOMPLISHED OR AM IMSULT?

No it wasn't an insult and of course it wasn't an accomplished. I like alot <u>Bathory</u> old and new one too, in the last <u>Lp Bathory</u> has lost his powerful black image, now I listen to <u>Bathory</u> only for the music sometime ago during the "Under the sign of the Black Mark" Age (that was killer!-ED) also for the image too.

COULD YOU TELL US SOMETHING MORE ABOUT YOUR MEXT LP? IT WILL BE WITH

No, the next <u>Samael's</u> Lp (Blood Ritual) It must come out on century media, normally for October'92 but nothing is really sure. But we hope. We have been some troubles with osmose about the first one, but I don't want to Blame Osmose, in fact it's a good label with some bad bands, but is my opinion.

WHAT DO YOU THINK ABOUT BANDS SAYING THEY WORSHIP THE DEVIL JUST TO SELL LP'S?

I think this people don't play Black metal for say that, you can't win more money with this image if you play boring music. I don't think you have just to tell Satan 1000 times for sell 100,000 copies of dure shit! and now we have 5 1/2 of existence and we wait ever the Fortune.

I BELIEVE HELL IS A STATE OF MIND, WEAT ARE YOUR OPINION?

In fact I don't think is a country (Maybe the Russian Border main station). It's really difficult to explain and especially with a pen, I think every body can make with his life a hell and you speak about mind, but mind and body walk together, and when your mind was in pain sometime ago your body cries too and that is a Real Hell. I think you can come really high with pain. I DON'T BELIEVE IN A CLASSICAL HELL AND I

DON'T BELIEVE IN A DEVIL WITH A LONG TAIL AND 2 HOURS, BUT WHO BELIEVE IN THAT NOW? (A lot of ignorants:-ED)

DO YOU REALLY THINK THE RELIGIOUS EAVE THE RIGHT CONCEPT OF SATANISM?

WHICH KIND OF RELIGIOUS? Chistians, no read my last answer, only this kind of frogs believe in a hell like a country with a big fire and Dammed Souls in pain, my hell was here and my Biggest Punishment was the reincarnation.

TELL US A BRIEF STORY OF THE BAND

Well, we were pretty much the only people in our area interested in death metal, so it was very natural that we got together. We formed when Brett Pugate and I (Brett now plays drums in VITAL REMAINS) collaborated with Curt Peithman and Norm Sales in November '91. We started writing songs and in April we released our first four song demo "Mourning glory", shortly there after, Brett left us to pursue other proyects. We quickly replaced him with Chris Brought a lot of brutality to TERATA. So between April and June we wrote 3 great new songs, recorded and So between April and June we wrote 3 great new songs, recorded and released them as our demo, "TRIUMVIRATE", "TRI" has really put us on the Mad. Everyone seems to dig it. Since then, we've just been playing shows and trying to write the best song we possibly can. How is your new demo doing? And how many copies did you sell from your "Mourning Glory" first demo?

"TRIUMVIRATE" is doing fucking great! "TRIUMVIRATE" is doing fucking great!
We're getting nothing but possitive
responses from it worldwide. It's
scoring us interviews with a lot
great'zines (like yours) and we've
got rid of about 500 or 600 copies so
far. "Mourning Glory" really didn't
go over that well thought, we were a
pretty young sounding band then. We
were still experimenting, trying to
find what direction we wanted to take
TERATA. It sold about 250 copies,
but it's not available anymore.

FOR THOSE WHO HAVEN'T HEARD YOUR SOUND, DESCRIBE IT.

Dude, this one's kind though for me, 'cause I'd like to think we have a very original sound. It's brutal, dark, and melodic. Each song has a completely different backrop, a different personality. The Tempos are constantly flucuating, from slow down, to pulverizingly fast. Our



music never boring, scomething catchy and interesting.

That's something we strive for. So
I definitely can't compare us to
another band.

HOW IS THE SCENE IN YOUR TOWN? DO SOME OTHER BANDS EXIST THERE?

The scene in our town sucks horse cock, but we're always doing our best to improve it. We just convinved the comer of "Airwaves skatepark" to have shows there every saturday. So that is now the best and only place to play in Peoria. We played there on Hallowen night with 3 alternative bands, and the turnout was great, over 300 people showed up. It was madness, people diving off half-pipes an shit. There's a shit-load of alternative bands here, which is cool. The only other death metal band in Peoria area is the legendary Impetigo. We were scheduled to play with them, but Dan Broke his hand on the day of the show. That dude is always having freak accidents. Hopefully, we'll have the opportunity to play with them soon.

DO YOU EAVE SOME PLANS TO DO VINYL, 7" EP COMP. TAPE FOR A RECORD LABEL?

Yes, as a matter of fact, we have a 4 song cassette ep coming out on Wild Rags Records, so look for that soon. We'll definitely be releasing a full We'll definitely be releasing a rull length LP in the very near future. We're talking to all kins of labels right now, as to which one we'll go with permanetely, I don't know.

ANY NEW SONGS AFTER YOUR DEMO?

Yeah! We've got a truckload of great new songs. Sometitles are: "Soul Siege", "Murella", "Detoxification", "Horrific Disfigurement", "Revelations Throughblood" and "Revelations Throughblood" \*Prelude to Purgatory\*. These are completely finished. We're recording 3 of these this week. The production will even better than the last time. and will even better than the last time. We just kicked our bass player norm out last week, because he simply could not keep up with us. So Curt and I will be playing the bass tracks in the studio. We're not releasing these new 3 songs as a demo though, it's just a promotional thing to send to labels that are showing interest in TERATA. But if anyone would like to hear'em, go ahead and send me \$3, an I'll get one for you.

WEAT RE YOUR PAVORITE BANDS, 'SIMES?

Oh man, I have so many fayes, not just death metal either. Some stuff I've been listening to lately would be, ENTOMED, DISHARMONIC ORCHESTRA, ATROCITY, ALICE IN CHAINS, NED'S ATOMIC DUSTBIN, SOLITUDE AETURNS, GRAVE, IMPETIGO, DARKTHRONE, KING DIAMOND, WHITE ZOOMIE and of course on one kind of music, so I liten to fuckin' everything. I try to ignore trends too. I could care less what's cool. And if someone doesn't like the fact that I play brutal death metal, yet listen to other stuff, well that's too bad. In all honesty enthroned is my favorite 'zine (a true fan! ha, hal-thank-ed), and I've seen a lot of fanzines. Some other faves be mine are eternal darkness, coroner's report and holocaust 'zine (really killerone!-ed).

DO YOU PLAY OFTEN IN YOUR TOWN? WITE WEO?

Well, we play here in Peoria as often as possible, which isn't much. Right now, we're focusing mainly on out of State Shows. We recently played Indianapolis In, that was a blast.

How about, <u>SADUS</u>, <u>IMMOLATION</u>, <u>ENTOMBED</u>, <u>KING DIAMOND</u>, <u>or OBITURY</u> OR <u>METALLICA?</u> Ha, ha! But seriously, those are all great bands and sem like great guys who would be a lot of fun to tour with (Except Metallica) (What about <u>Firehouse</u>?-ED).

WHAT'S NEXT FOR TERATA?



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# TIGH FAIL At the most original death bands

One of the most original death bands I ever heard is <u>Nightfall</u>. These guys come from Greece and recently tehn released their debut Lp on Holy recs from France. Definitely you must check out this Lp after this interview with EFTHIMIS.

COULD YOU INTRODUCE YOURSELVES TO OUR READERS WHO DON'T KNOW ABOUT NIGHTFALL?

I'm Efthimis, the bassist/singer and also keyboardist of an 100% original atmospheric, death metal band, called Mightfall. The other guys of the band are: Christian and Mike as guitar player and costas the drummer. All of us we're about 19-24 years old, and our aim is to play the music we feel, from the dark depths of our hearts and souls, really sad, dark, pesimist music.

I TEIME YOU EAVE A VERY INTENSE AND ORIGINAL SOUND, BOW DO YOU GET ALL TROSE IDEAS?

As I mentiones before, we just play what we feel in our life. We don't try to play what we play, it's just coming up via our feelings and nothing size. Our technics on our instruments and what we know about music so far, are just help us to perform better our songs and nothing more.

TOU SAID TEAT DEMONS AND GODS ARE PRODUCT OF WEAK MINDS, SO I SUPPOSED TOUR ATERIST. IF SO, WEAT'S YOUR

LYRICS DEAL WITE?

Yes, we are atheist or so...we just believe in human's mind power; we're humanistic! Our lyrics are influenced by poetry, and that's because I like to write and read sad poems, full of vanity. They deal with simple humans thoughts about death and life's meaning, our existance, our nature etc...I have to tell here that our lyrics are sad and pesimistic, I think the word "vanity" tells everything. Our second Lp "Hacabre Sunsets" will include only sad poetry instead of simple lyrics.

BEING THESE YOUR LYRICAL CONCEPTS, WHICE BANDS INFLUENCE YOU? OR JUST LISTEN TO?

You better write here which bands do you believe they have influenced us. I just tell you some of my fave bands: CANDLEMASS, PARADISE LOST.
SISTER OF MERCY, MY DYING BRIDE, DEATH etc... By the way, none lyrics writer have influence our lytical concept in sure.

DID YOU GET TIRED OF THOSE ALL BLACK METAL BANDS EMERGING FROM GREECE AND DECIDED TO DO YOUR OWN SOUND?

No! We jut play what we feel and nothing else, as the great leaders Black Sabbath said... "We sold our souls for Rock and Roll" you see if a band plays good or bad is it's problem, I may decide to hear it or not, depending on how I may feel. But in my band things are runing different, either someone likes us or not, I don't give nothing, I would continue to play like that because I wanna be honest with myself!

WEICE OTHER BAND(S) DO YOU KNOW IN GREECE DOING THE SAME THING LIKE YOU?

There are some good bands here in Greece, like <u>Septicemia</u>, for instance, which play very deadly and also killing music, there are melodic bands too, powerful etc... But there's no any other band, I think, that has mixed melody and hate together!

EOW WAS THE RESPONSE TO YOUR GODLY "VANITY" DEMO?

Hey, thank for your good words. We had released it for about only 3-4 months and it was gone very well, although we were a small new band! In fact, I still receive some orders for "Vanity" demo tape but it's finally over. You see, our debut Lp/CD "Parade into centuries" is the most representative release so far...Until the 2nd "Macabre sunsets" Lp/CD or any 7", 12" will come out.



COULD YOU EXPLAIN THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN YOUR DEMO AND YOUR NEW STUFF AND HOW DID YOU ELABORATED THE MATERIAL OF YOUR UPCOMING DEBUT CD?

The main differences are first of all in the production and the whole sound of our Lp/CD. Now we've had more money and time to do everything better, than a year before, with our demo, we realized every "mistake" from "Vanity" demo and avoided them in our "Parade"...Finally, Nightfall sounds more originally now than ever, we've almost found our own sound!

HOW IS NIGHTFALL ON STAGE? HOW IS THE CROWD'S REACTION?

Fans in Greece are really crazy, especially for death metal stuff. But not any serious death glg has taken place so far here with us and not only. In winter time we'll visit the west of Europe for a tour, then I'll know exactly how it is to play to a strange crowd.

WHICH COUNTRIES DO YOU WILL TOUR IN YOUR UPCOMING TOUR WITH MISANTHROPE and PROTON BURST?

I'm not sure exactly, the French guys are the responsable one for booking the places, some countries may be: Belgium, Spain, France, Holland...

#### AMYTHING RISE TO ADD?

Thank a lot for the support and the interview too. The best wishes to you and your readers, stay original and do what ever your souls like! Every band, fan, mag, etc...Who may like to write us, is more than welcome. No rip off at all!

It's been a lot of time since Inm molation released the now classic record "Down of Possession" with fucking death tunes as the apocaly ptic "Those left behind". Some of their fans may be wondering what happened that we haven't seen a new Immolation record in a while. Recently we had the opportunity to share some thoughts with Ross Dolan from Immolation about the writting of new material for the second up coming yet untitled record. And her's what Dolan has to say:

1. What's happening with Immolation and your new material?

Well at the moment, we are writing for the second album. We just fini shed up a 25 date U.S. tour which began in early July and ended the end of August. The tour went really well considering we booked all the shows ourselves, organized every thing ourselves, and basically pro moted it ourselves. It was basica lly a self booked, self financed and self promoted tour with no help or support from our label aside from a few things and interviews they set up. But as I mentioned earlier, we are writing new mate rial, we have enough titles and lyrical ideas for the whole next album, its the music that is ta king longer because we are putting a lot more time and energy into making this next album a true mas terpiece, we want to re-define Dea th Metal with this album, it's go nna be the darkest album ever to be released, with tons of feeling and its own mood to it, we want it to be very haunting, so this stuff takes time.

Could you give us some ideas of your new stuff and any title songs? What's the album title?

We have a very good idea of what the title of the next album is going to be as well as the titles for a good majority of the songs, but we are keep this all under wraps

so that it will all be fresh when the album comes out, not like with our first, album all the songs on that album were basically old except for 4 of them, but with this album it will all be ne and fresh. Like I said in the previous question, we're concentrating on making this album even more dark that the first one, its still going to be Imm olation, only this time around we are improving on everything that needed improving in the past.

Will you record your new Lp on Mu siclab with Harris Johns as produ cer again? If not where and with who?

I think we have already decided on recording the album locally, so we have more money to spend on the actual recording, and there is a good chance that we might bring Harris Johns over here to produce the second album, but only time will tell at this point in the game.



What things you'll improve in this new recording and what others do you thing it will be different than your 1st Lp?

Well, we'd like to improve many things in the production. I think we are definitely going to aim on a better more defined drum sound that cuts through the mix without being dominating. We also want to improve on the guitar sound and bring it up front more so it doesn't sound so distant. We just want to make it better than the last album while still keeping it raw and heavy as hell with its own at mosphere.

Well, what about the sales of your lst album? How many copies you have sold at this time and are you satisfied with R/C's job with your album promotion?

We are told by R/C that the album was selling good adn still selling to this date which is a good sign.

I'm sure both the European and U.S. tours helped our tremendously in boosting sales. We're not totally satisfied with R/C's job in pushing the album, we feel it should have gotten pushed more than it did, but there's always next time. It seems we're never satisfied with anything when it comes to our music everything could always be a little bit better.

I've heard about your USA/Europe tour, How was the response on each continent? Which is your favorite crowd?

We toured Europe last year, and we also did a U.S. tour this past summer. Also, we had the opportunity to play up in Canada and down in Mexico City. Although we love touring and loved everyplace we played, I'd have to say that playing in Mexico, Ireland, France, and Germany were probably the most intense as far as crowd reaction and response. These places had the largest and most energetic crowds, but on a whole we enjoyed every place we've played on both tours. Every new place is a new and very different experience to us.

Sometime ago you said that N.Y.'s scene was growing, but now it see ms to be one of the brutalest, do you agree with that?

I am happy to say that the new york scene is growing, more people at the shows supporting the bands, more people writing to the bands and more bands.When I say this

scene, I am also including the Jer sey area as well, because there are tons of great bands from Jersey such as Incantation and Goreaphobia from Philadelphia. Death Metal has finally cought on here in N.Y., and it is a good sign.

Have you heard any band/'zine from P.R.? (Beside me)
Actually, I did get another inter view and a few more letters from P.R. which I plan to answer after I do this interview, but as far as bands go, I can't think of any right now off the top of my head.

Do you think Death Metal is becoming trendy in this days?

Yes, I definitely think it is becoming trendy, but its like with every thing else, when something starts getting popular, more and more people start paying attention to it not because they like it, but be cause of its popularity. But I do know there are also a lot of true people into this scene, old fans and new, so these are the people that count, and these are the ones who will last the duration.

What plans has teh band inmediately after your new Lp? Any band to do a tour with?

Well we would like to first get the next album recorded and relea sed, then following that, we want to do extensive touring, preferably with a larger act, but we aren't that picky as long as we feel it is a good strong bill. We would like to tour with Morbid Angel or Autopsy, adn Incantation and Gorea phobia again.

What kind of people are Immolation when you're not on stage?

We are the most normal people you'd ever want to know, pretty average we keep to ourselves and live ave rage everyday lives not any diffe rent from anyone else.

Here's another interview done by my pal Pierre to Spitltead. This band is from Belgium and plays very cool stuff so it's time to check the Belgian scene, I said that cuz the band's latest demo is excellent. Hope you enjoy this interview!

Interview by: Pierre (Morbid Noise Comp.)

You started in 1987? Could you tell me why there's so much time passed until (1991) you released your first studiodemo?

There are various reasons for that. We started the band in 87, did some gigs, had a lot of fun, etc.. But none of us was thinking about recording a demos. We weren't out to be famous or gigging seriously, or anything else. In the autumn of 88 the band broke up because I departed. The other guys went further under another name changed the style of music. In 1990 they asked Patrick (bass) and me (Steve, vocals) if we were interested to reform the old SPITHEAD. We said yes, and everything started again. We rehearsed about a year, with some breaks because of the lack of rehearsalroms. At the end of 90 Patrick warted to record some of our songs and we went into the studio. This was our first official demotape; MECROMANTIAL RITES. Actually, you can say we existed only a year before we recorded our first demo. I don't think that's a long time.

...And even this long moment of patience? The first demo "mecromantial rites" haven't got the expected result...Why?

I have to say, that in our eyes, this tape did what we expected from it. It was not meant to sell hundreds of time. It is recorded to spread our name, so people would know what they could expect when they see other products, or gigs of us. It hasn't sold that much, that's true, but it certainly spread our name. There's lots of people who traded our tape with friends. That's the most important thing. We already sold 300 copies of our second tape, which is now available for 5 months. We're up to the next hundred copies. I expect it to sell about 500 times. That's our main goal, to reach the point of 500 copies. If we don't make it, no problem, if we can sell so many of them than it's damn good. We're not into this scene for money. In fact, we've put more money in this band, than respect and appreciation for the things we do, and have a good time, by meeting other bands and people. There's still a lot people who are asking me for our first demotape. That's great but we haven't got any copies left of it. They can always send a blank tape and some postage money or 2 IRC-coupons to cover the postage costs. It's fucking expensive!!!!! So, to return back to your question, in our opinion it has got the expected result.

ANYWAY, YOU RECEIVED SUCE GOOD ACCEPTATION AMONG THE NUMBROUS UNDERGROUND MAGAZINES...WHICH ONES?

That's true, we've got endless request from magazines. They all want to have a copy of it. That's OK, as long as they're not a rip-off. I've received request from magazines as TRASHING HOLOCAUST (Hallo HENKE!), HAMMERHEARTH, GRIND 'N' NOISE, CHICKEN IS DEAD, MOONSTRUCK, F.Y.A.F.T., and countless others, they're too much to mention but they aren't forgotten. Sometimes it's a bore when you send a copy to magazines and you never receive anything back. Not a single letter. That's bullshit I think.

Even if you don't like the tape, it's not that much work to send a letter back with your personal opinion in it. If you don't like, tell us, we can live with bad reviews. We can

always learn from other people's opinions. I mean, we take care of their letter, by sending them our tape and booklet, a logo and a picture. So, the least thing I expect is a reaction form their side. Sometimes it's hard when don't hear any longer from these people.

BY THE WAY, FROM WHICE COUNTRY DO YOU RECEIVE MOST OF YOUR MAIL?

It depends. Sometimes we receive mail from Poland, then from Russia, then Greece. In general I receive mail from all over the globe. You name it, I've got it. I want to thank everyone who has spread our name all over the world. They know who they are, and friends, you won't be forgotten by us. Eternal glory to thou !!!!!

AND TIME PASSED ONCE AGAIN, YOU RECORD THE SECOND DEMO, MUCH BETTER THEN THE FIRST ONE.

Yeah, thank you, it IS better then the first one. Well, if you can't improve yourself as band then you'll better stop recording songs I think. This second tape shows how much we were improve. The songs are almost a year old now, but they're still OK I think. As I've told you, John Pollentier has left the band, we're now playing with another guitarplayer. His name is De Visch Yves, 21 years old and cool, very



cool dude.!!! The sound on the second tape is much better than on the first ons. We thought we could handle the production ourselves on the first tape but it wasn't exactly like expected. Our mistake, we agree. The second one is produced by a guy who owns a record store ad has done some shows with us to arrange our live-sound. So, he knew the songs and knows what we expected. There are some things which could be done better, but that's always the case I guess. Nothing or nobody's perfect. We've got two new songs, which isn't that much (I hear you saying that), but that's due to the fact of the trouble we had with John. He didn't show up at rehearsals and lost his interest in the band. The new guy is now about two months in the band and everything's goin' fine. We had to rehearse all the old songs with him before we could take care of writing new songs. As I told you before there are already two songs ready, but they could be re-arrange, you'll never know. Titles are: "SANTIGUARSA EN LA CRUZ" AND "L'INCONSTANCE DE MAUVAIS ANCES". They're more in the way the old bands used to play. Not that kind of machinegun and screaming songs.

MUSICALLY IT'S SOMETHING YOU CAN PLACE BETWEEN GOOD OLD CLASSIC BEAVY/DOOM METAL. I FIND IT DIFFERENT THAN ALL "GENERIC" RELEASES. WHAT'S YOUR OPINION ABOUT THAT?

I consider it as a compliment. All the guys in the band are already listening to metal since the old days (81-81), I'm a metalfan since 78. so it's obvious we're a bit old-fashioned. No, to be seriously, we all love the old bands because we grew up with their music. Bands such

ASBEATH, VENOM, ANGEL WITCH, RUSH, MOTORHEAD, MERCHYPUL PATE, HELLIAMBER, etc..WE all love them. We also like the new bands and we are also influenced by them, but it's mostly older stuff and other kinds of music we are influenced by them, but it's mostly older stuff and other kinds of music reasons. We listen to THE KLF, KATE BUSH, JIMMI HENDRIX, MELISSA ETHERIDGE, URBAN DANCE SQUAD, MINOR THREAT, CLASSIC MUSIC...and the list continues endlessly. These are things we listen to, I can't tell you if we're influenced by them, it's possible. Sometimes you're influenced without knowing it. It's hard to tell. Anyway our songs turn out the way we play them. We never gather and saying to each other; "Now we are writing a song which sounds like this band, or something else" Sometimes it's fun when I read the reviews of our demo's. The latest demo has already been described as DEATH at the time of their first album (SCREAM BLOODY GORE), others say we're a mix between old SODOM and MERCYFUL FATE. As you can see, everybody compares our sound to different bands. Seems like everybody has trouble to categorize us. No problem with that!!! As long as people like us it's good. Maybe we should call our genre SPITTING DEATH. (Hahaha).

ANYWAY, MANY BELGIAN BANDS, EXCEPT ANCIENT RITES, AGATECCLES...ARE STAYING VERY UNKNOWN, EVEN IN THE UNDERGROUND IS BELGIUM A DOOMED COUNTRY OR WEAT?

No pal, Belgium isn't doomed. In fact Belgium is quit known in the underground. Bands as INSANITY REIGNS SUPREME, SUHRIM, CADUCITY, DREFT, RISING NATION, ... are already wellknown. Also our name is already spread worldwide. It just takes some time. Wait until next year. Belgium will become the METAL country. Compared to other countries we haven't got that much bands, but most of our bands are kind of original. Holland have got great bands, but there are many who aren't that original. Now, I've got some enemies in Holland. Don't worry up there, I still lowe most of the Dutch bands, but if I had to choose I'd rather buy a Belgium album or tape. Because our scene needs all the support it can get. I mean, Dutch bands are already heavily supported by Anthony Van Den. Berg and Aardschok, magazines such as Meltdown, but most Belgium bands are buried or get bad reviews. I've got demotapes from Dutch band which are pure shit, but they get a good review by AVDB. And bands such as IRS get a ridiculous review of their tape, which is in my opinion great. It could be better, of course, but I love this tape. So what's the point? Chauvinistic? Don't make me laugh, I guess that we also gonna have a bad review of our tape. I don't mind about that, everybody knows his style of reviewing Belgian Bands. GIVE US BAELUS BACK!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

Coops, I'm off the trail. Let's get back to your question. ANCIENT RITES is a GREAT band (Hello Gunther, will I be paid for this promotional campaign, we'll arrange the details later hahah) Seriously, they deserve all the luck they can get. They deserve it to be big and wellknown. I don't know about AGATHOCLES. I've heard some rumors about them, which I'm not gonna tell now, because it's not my habit to spread bad talk. I like their music, I've got some livetapes, demo's and their CD. So, all the luck to them. In fact I wish the best of luck to all bands which put time, sweat and dedication into their music. The underground bands need support. I mean, it's twice as heavy when you come back from work, eat something, go to the rehearsalroom and sweat like a horse to play your song. Nothing against

big bands, they also sweat and work hard, but it's their job. Bands like us work twice as hard, we are doing OUT OWN promotion, management, correspondence, we are controlling everything we do. And we don't earn any money, because everything is put directly back into the band. What we need here in Belgium are concertpromotors who dares to give Belgian bands a chance to play. Part of the troubles in the Belgian scene are due to the fans theirselves. I mean, they buy lots of albums/CD's and foreign bands and wellknown bands. There's lots of people who can tell you everything about the latest Morbid Angel or Napalm Death album, for example. But they do not know any Belgiam bands, they are not interested in it. They think it's cool to love the big bands, it seems like they're afraid being a fan of a Belgian band. This does not count for the whole Belgian scene, but these guys excist. The same trouble with radiostations. If they have Metalehow, which is seldom, usually they don't broadcast much Belgian bands. Just the big bands which has got a record. And they're the ones who doesn't need all that publicity. As usual there are some exceptions, luckily. Just give demo bands chance and plsy those tapes regular.

chance and plsy those tapes regular. People don't react when they hear only one song, you have to play it several times if you really want to push the stuff. I better stop before I get boring I suppose.

AMOTHER FACT IS THAT DUTCE BANDS COME TO PLAY IN BELGIUM SO OFTEN AND BELGIAN BANDS HAVEN'T THIS CHANCE?

That's up to the chauvinism of the Dutch promotors and the attitude of the Belgian promotors. You can't expect that Belgian bands play in another country when even here, in their own country, no-one wants to come to see them play. Maybe I'm exaggerating the situation, but it happens. The fans in Belgium prefer to watch foreign bands, instead of their own native bands.

BUT YOU ENOW, IN GREECE, THE BANDS ORGANIZE SELF-FINANCIED CONCERTS IN SQUATS...ISN'T SUCE TEING POSSIBLE IN-BELGIUM.

That's what slowly begins to happen in Belgium. Thanks to that, if bands help each other, instead of being jealous of each other, things would go a lot better. We're playing at 4 october together with ANCIENT RITES, 31 october together with DREFT and CADUCITY, and we're playing there for free. In exchange they will come playing, without being paid, at a gig which we will organize. I think this is a great way of helping each other. You can organize things without worrying about the cost, or if you'll earn your money back which you have invested. If it's possible, we're always in for a trade. Help we're always in for a trade. Help we're always in the Belgian scene. It should be the motto in the Belgian scene.

ANTWAY, YOU DID OME OR TWO GIGS IN THE REGION OF BRUGGE/OSTKAMP BUT WHAT ABOUT SEOMS WITE BIGGER BANDS? YOU EAVE ONE PROGRAMMEDED WITE AMCIENT RITES...WEAT ABOUT TEAT?

Since we've started again we've played about 12 or 13 gigs (not than much, due to line-up problems) in our area. We've played in Ostend, St-Kruis, Aartrijke,...
We've did our last gig a few days ago

Kruis, Aartrijke,...
We've did our last gig a few days ago
(18/9/92) as a try-out with our new
guitarplayer, and everything went
very well. Nothing but praise, and

everyone was talkin' about how good were, etc...
Sometimes I'm feeling uncomfortable with all this praise, because it's nothing special we are doing. We're just five guys who are enjoying theirselves on stage, and we're expect the same from the audience.

THE PARTY OF THE P

These gigs are not big, or with big bands as you call them, but they are also important. And we always think: better have a small gig that's sold our then a big concert in an half-filled hall. I prefer the small gigs because you have the contact with the audience. I love it. I would also love to do a gig with a wellknown band, I'm no hypocrite, I think every band would do such kind of gig. But it isn't necessary for me. Actually we've got such gig in the near future. We're asked to do the support for HOLY MOSES/WARPATH and INCUBATOR here in our area. But the gig I'm really looking forward to is that with ANCIENT RITES. I think it will be fun. Hopefully we're in optima forma. because we kill!!!!! I don't consider this as a big gig. But it will be fun. We had some doubts about it because our guitarplayer and bassplayer are working in shifts, and they had to wake up at two 0' clock in the morning to go to work. But we decided to do it, because it's an unique chance to play with Gunther and ANCIENT RITES. Hopefully it will happen again. I'm as happy as a little child who has just got some candy. Woocaaahhhh!!!!!!!!!!!!

OF COURSE IT'S SCANDALOUS THAT THE BELGIAN CROWD ONLY FOLLOWS GREAT FOREIGN BANDS AND COMPLETELY IGNORE BELGIAN BANDS OR BANDS FORM STRANGE COUNTRIES.

Yes, it's scandalous. But what can we do to it? Brainwash everyone? It's just a few people who are really interested in the underground. Although there's lot of magazines, compalitiontapes, etc.. there's just a small minority really interested in unknown bands. If you compare the number of people in the underground to the number of average metalfans...Maybe a half percent, not that much I think. O also love bands which are wellknown but I love these unknown underground bands. The obscurity factor fascinates me. And it always surprises you. Bands who

their sound or tire known to be their sound or tile. But these obscure bands which you we never heard of, just hardly read a flyer, or heard rumors, and then you order their tape or and always a surprise. That's what I love about underground, also the fact that you'll learn to know other that you'll learn to know other people from foreign countries, cultures, race, etc... That's great. As Gunther signs: OBSCURITY REIGNS.

BY THE WAY, WEAT DO YOU THINK ABOUT SPANISH BANDS LIKE UNBOUNDED TERROR, AND OTHER SPANISH BANDS?


I think they're a good band, I don't dare to say they're a superband or something like that because I don't tell false stories. They are also good promoted by DROWNED PRODUCTIONS. I haven't heard their album completely yet, I've got only five tracks of their album which I've received from Patrick, since he's in contact with them.

I don't know if he writes regular with Vicente because I'm already to busy with my own correspondence. There's so many bands today, it takes a fulltime job to keep up with what's going on in the underground. There's so many bands around which deserve to be wellknown, but they're not known tr us. I know lots of bands, but everyday I hear new stuff from bands which I've never heard of. That's great, because it keeps your mind fresh and alert. I love to hear from every band, if they're interested, they can always write to my address. Help each other to spread the name and music.!!!

IN YOUR REGION THERE'S ANOTHER BAND CALLED FRAST OF EATE TELL ME SOMETHING ABOUT THEM...

I guess this is a question which is written by Christoph. I really can't tell you much about them. I know Konrad very well, we see each other regular but he doesn't tell anything about the band. It's more a kind of project, because the members are all studying at this moment. He told me they would record something and he would let me hear a rehearsal but I haven't heard anything yet. Sorry, it's all I can tell.



EOW DO YOU SEE THE FUTURE FOR THE BELGIAN SCENE, TELL ME YOUR CONCLUSION?

It will be better within a few years, but we can't moan. If read about others countries where the bands got lots of trouble with the police during concerts, or where you have only two or three concerts each year...That's a horrible situation. These people deserve a lot of respect because they keep the spirit alive despite all the trouble they have. We've got all the facilities we need here in Belgium. We just have to use them. Just try to organize something like that, but small gigs which can expand within a few years. That's what we're planning to do next year, organize something by ourselves. Maybe four or five bands, and if everything goes well, we'll try again. If we can keep it on a regular base then it's ok. We don't have to make lots of money from it, if we can continue with it then it's alright. The fun you have with it can't be paid with all the money in the world.

First of all, megathanks to you PIERRE and CHRISTOPHE for this interview. You deserve lots of respect for the things you're doing to promote bands. Thanks to the people who took the time to read this interview, I hope it wasn't too boring. 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**DEPRESSIVE** 

DOOM!!!

Two or three months ago, I didn't know anything about the Death scene from Australia! A few weeks ago! I received tons of flyers! DISEMBOWENT is the first one to have replied! No, they've sent me at first their demo! At first they played a kind of Noise/Grind, but their new demo has totally changed! Yeah, it's more into the Death/Doom vein!! Great! You've to read this interview and after this, why not, ordering their demo! So, let's go, it's Renato who replies...

Interview by: Pierre (Morbid Noise Comp).

WHEN YOU'VE DECIDED TO START THE BAND, YOU WANTED TO PLAY NOISE-GRIND! WHY THIS EXTREME CHOICE?

Well, to put it bluntly, Noise-Grind is easy to play because just about anything goes these days. You know that and so do a lot of others. We couldn't even play our instruments properly yet we managed to create songs which came close to a complete wall of noise. that basically says it all. To play Death Metal, it's obvious you have to be able to play guitar/bass and of course drumes. There's more thought that goes into it; more planning, structure rather thatn just "1,2,3,4 full steam ahead for about 30 seconds, sometimes even longer, haba". When we were playing noise Grind, it was such a complete rush for us; the intensity of it was so brutal, just to play as fast we could. I'd say when the 'Scum' (Napalm Death) LP was released, well that's what parked it off definitely!

BUT NOW YOU'VE STOPPED PLAYING NOISE! WAS IT SO BORING?

You can only go so far with Noise Gring I think (at least with what we were doing) and basically we were going around in circles. There was no progression so we decided to move on to a style where er could have a chance to progress. I mean just look at all the serious garbage being churned out time after time today in the Noise/Grind area there's a lot I'd say. Where is it all going to I'd say. Where is it all going to lead? Who's going to take it seriously? How many people are going to give you shit for it or laugh? You know what I mean? We changed due to an urge for complete heaviness structure and thought in our songs. That's what Death Metal brings forth. There's no substitute. As they say only Death is real'. But once again I'd definetely have to say that being as heavy as we could be was the reason for music in this area we're in now.

NOW, YOU'VE TOTALLY CHANGED YOU STYLE! YOU PLAY DOOM!!!!DON'T YOU THINK IT'S AN EXTREME CHOICE???

Yeah, Doom is the complete expression for <a href="heaviness.">heaviness.</a> <a href="heaviness.">Paradise Lost</a> say it all! Actually we try to combine really fast Grind (Not noise) with Death and Doom Metal. I just really

get off on those very crunchy muted riffs! We try and create an ambience with our music. The vocals play a big part in making the music as brutal and evil as possible.

DO YOU THINK YOU'VE NOW FOUND THE RIGHT WAY?? OR DO YOU THINK YOU COULD ONCE CHANGE YOUR MUSICAL STYLE???

Yes, what we're doing right now I think is where we are heading. Trying to create the heaviest we can. it'll most likely always be Death/Doom Metal, but there will be different influences being combined within this style. Like for example: special guitar effects and structures. This is what we're experimenting with now. Carbonized (RIP!) really separated from the pack with thier Recarbonized demo. I mean this was incredible, the songs structures and melody work (in no way wimpy at all!) really killed. Everyone familiar with this demo should have a fair idea of what I'm trying to say. Just listen to the track 'for the security! Also Abhorrence is another band which is doing something along what we're trying to do. It's just so trippy to play. I love delayed guitar melody's. I don't know, it's just me. Actually it is isn't me because Jason, our guitarist feels the same about this so it makes it even more interesting.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE DISEMBOWELMENT AS NAME? WHY DIDN'T YOU KEEP BACTERIA, YOUR OLD NAME? DO YOU KNOW THE DUTCH DISEMBOWEL?

Bacteria is such a cliché. I wanted to forget about past. So, when we started the new band, we decided to start form scratch. New name, new attitude, new style of music, etc. It sounds so unoriginal too. Disembowelment us slighty more interesting too. It's a good way to stick nasty thought into someones mind. It goes along with our music. But we are not a gore band. No gore lyrics or anything, just brutal Death! I'd say we're probably the Disembowelment everybody in the underground everybody in the underground knows too. Like there's no other Disembowelment I know of, as long as we're sort of established ourselves. I know of Disembowel from Holland. I'd say they've probably heard to us too. To be honest, I was pretty dissapointed to find out about their name. You know, it's like the controversy between out great friends Acheron and the US Acheron. There's a lot to this, but I'm not going dabble into it now!

WHY DEAN DECIDED TO PLAY IN DISEMBOWELMENT, HE ALSO PLAYS IN 2 OTHER RANDS! IS NOT TOO MUCH WORK FOR HIM??

Dean didn't decide to play with us, we asked him to play and help us out for the demo. It wasn't like we asked him to become a permanent member, just a session player. So

Dean is no longer with us because of the fact that he is too busy with Necrotomy and his own band Mortification. He helped us out a lot and he knows how much we appreciate it, too. We still don't have a bass player and it's not too much of a problem because we're not playing to play live for a while anyway. In a way, we're like in Derketa's situation, we can still bring oyt material without a permanent bass player. I can always play bass for the next recording! Dean is still as close as ever with us, it's not like we don't talk anymore. Everythings fine between all of us.

COULD YOU TELL ME MORE ABOUT YOUR DEMO "MOURNING SEPTEMBER"?

"Mouring September" was recorded in September 1990 (ha, funny that!) on a 4 track. It sounds damn good for a 4 track studio effort. We're just dissapointed on the drums, where they should be been way higher in the mix. We recorded it on my brothers 4 track actually and he was still experimenting with it, so we were like his guinea pigs. We learn a lot by doing this and our next recording will be much better for sure. I'm pretty happy with it for our first effort though. It look 3 days in total to record and mix. We basically did all at home. We've sold far more than we expected to, it's been pretty amazing. Besides, people are still finding out about the demo so there are always more letters coming in. The reaction has been great. Totally positive and brutal. We've had people compare us to everything from Unleashed.

Paradise Lost, Asphyx, Rettrevore to Derketa and Grave. We've tried to make the demo as professional as we can with the money and time we had. Everything from the lyrics and cover. Our next one will be 90% more professional, so it will be something to look forward to. We try and make it worth people's money.

I'VE READ IT'S YOU WHO MAKES ALL IN THE BAND! WHY THIS CHOICE???

Basically because it's my choice and I enjoy it. I suppose I'm like the master of the bands input and output. I'll always write the lyrics that's for sure, but now, the music will be intergrated between Jason and I, which is much more interesting and easier. It's hard working the music by yourselves - "a man isn't an island" I find it hard anyway. Our demo I worked just about everything out even some of the drum beats I wanted specifically here and there. I like to plan everything oyt and then show Paul and Jason and we work on it from there.

BY THE WAY, WHAT IS THE "VAUDEVILLE

Why are people so curious about this? Vauderville Clowns sounds really mysterious and bizarre, doesn't it??? Well, the Vandeville Clowns is simply my brother's band and they're the guys who own the 4 track mini studio recorder. They helped us out a lot by letting us do our demo. You know, we had really no pressure at all when we were recording it, like when you go into a professional studio, whether it be an 8, 16 or 24 track, there's always a heap of pressure because obviusly time=moneu and you want to try and get the best product as possible. We took our time, well not really but we could've, it's just we wanted to get the damn thing out as soon as possible. So there you go. Vaudeville Clowns is no longer an obscurity!!

WHY DO YOU USE A LOT OF "GORY" LYRICS? WHY NO MORE PERSONAL STUFFS?

Gory lyrics? What gory lyrics?! You've got to be joking. The closest song that would come close to gore is "Extracted Nails" and it's really nothing at all! It's just about extreme pain inflicted by some person


into total sadism. I'd classify gore lyrics as <u>Carcass/Nuclear Death</u> (more total perverted, warped sickness) etc, etc. Obviously everyone has they're own interpretation of what are gore lyrics and what aren't. I like to write about dark subjects, surreal (at times), not satanic lyrics or gore lyrics. Obscurity is what I base my lyrics on. Real mystery and darkness. For example our new songs are titled "Burial at Ornans" and "The tree of life and death". Tom'G' Warrior was the ultimate song writer and Leif out of <u>Candlemass</u> is darn brillant too. I admire their lyrics so much. (ed-well, I apologise for my impertinent question, hey Renato hahal)

I'VE SEEN PICTURE OF EVILS ON THE SYRICS SHEET OF PAPER! ARE YOU SO INTERESTED INTO OCCULTISM...?

Yes, I'm interested in the occult slightly. Our lyrics sheet contained wood cuts which were done centuries ago when the Salem Witch trials were happening. I'm really fascinated by that old stuff. I really like old woodcuts. Everything on our "Mourning September" demo has a certain evil, morbid, dark feeling to it, from the images and lyrics used right to the music I suppose. A lot of people have told me that it was interesting what I did with the theme and layoyt of the demo cover and lyrics, that everythings combined to create ambience which is what I was initially concerned with before doing the demo. My intereset in occultism played a pretty vital role in the whole input or the demo.

IT SEEMS THERE ARE A LOT OF BANDS IN VICTORIA! WHAT ABOUT THE WEST SIDE OF AUSTRALIA?

Holy! Yes, there are thousands of bands in Victoria. Victoria is the centre of the Australian music industry. But I suppose your're talking about Death Metal bands huh!? Well, there aren't that many Death/Grind bands in Victoria are Acheron. Necrotomy. Persecution. Corpse Molestation, Crepitus, Damnatory, Abyss and Mortification. What about the west side of Australia? Gee, I don't know, I only know of Morbid Terror. Australia is a very big county. hell, I (we never been interstate either. Melbourne is the best place in Australia.

ANYWAY, FOR SUCH A BIG COUNTRY, IT IS NOT A GREAT SCENE. DO YOU TEINK IT IS GOING BETTER?

Well, I hate answering questions on the scene in australia because I always seem to say the same things, often negative. One of these days, people won't have to ask what the Australian scene is like, but as for now it is unavoidable because Australia is so far away from the rest of world where the scene's are really happening. Dawn here, people are catching on to the Death Metal wave like crazy (I supposed this isn't new because it's happening everywhere) and you would think this is good but it's just bringing forth all these bandwagon jumpers who all of a sudden think they're all brutal Deathmetallers (what's new folks!hmmm). These people have no sense of firection, all they are doing is following. They can't think for themselves! This action just makes the true people in the scene stay even more underground and how underground can you stay these days. Everything is being uncovered into thelp one another out and it's about time people in Europe and the States took notice to bands such as us, Acheron, Necrotomy and embrance us into their own world because down here nothing will bring satisfaction like that of being recognized in Europe, USA, etc. It is hard to explain but I hope someone can undergrand what I'm trying to get across.

WELL, DO YOU KNOW ANYTHING FROM BELGIUM, THERE IN AUSTRALIA??

I know that there are a lot of crazy people there. Just look at the bands coming out of there; Agathocles and Morbid Death etc. I also know that the capital is Brussels and the official languages are dutch and french, that the national anthem is 'La Brabanconne' (brutal song) and that it's one of the most densely popilated countries in the world. I also know for a complete fact that Thierry Prince is the guy they salure and how down to when confronted in the street! (ed-azarrghhhm here is

finally someone who has extremely well replied to my fave question, hehe! Thank Renato....)

HEY, COULD YOU TELL US MORE ABOUT THE POWERFULL OUTRO OF THE DEMO?

The outro of our demo? You like it huh? I adore it also. Doesn't it sound so scary and ambient? It really adds to the mood of the demo and I'm really glad we used it. You see I get into a lot of ambience such as Eno, tangenne, Bogd Rive, Peter Miller etc. Actually, we composed it ourselves under the intense guidance of the monestry of Amorgos. Do you believe me? Yeah, I thought not.

ARE THE DEATE METAL AND ALL OTHER EXTREMS MUSIC WELL ACCEPTED IN AUSTRALIA???

As I said previously, everyone all of sudden who was into Kreator/Slaver/Destruction (I even hate writing these names!) is now into Morbid Ancel, Entombed, Deicide, Terrorizer, Carcass, Napalm Death etc. It's good though because hardly any of these feeble minded fools can withstand Muclear Death (the most INTENSE GODLY BRUTAL) band ever! But for the other bands I mentioned, oh well (huge sigh...) what can you do now (another sigh...)

EAVE YOU ANY KIND OF PROBLEMS WITE THE ABORIGINIES?

Yes, there are a heap of problems concerning the aboriginies. Things such as landrights, racism, government interest and funding. They have been neglected for so long and it's sad to see because if they would've been treated like all others from the beginning, none of this would be happening. But it's just the same in South Africe, only worse there!

WHAT ABOUT THE GIGS IN AUSTRALIA???

Yes, there are always gigs on. There's something on every night. Not Death/Grind or anything, but you can go and see different bands all the time whether it be independent/alternative (big scene in Melbourne) or grunge Punk rock (also big). It's not so hard to get gigs, it's just that you might have to wait a few weeks or something. We haven't

played live yet because of our line-up, plus we want to make sure we're one hundred percent ready because our first gig will be a killer for us. We want to make it the heaviest and brutal gig anyone in Melbourne has ever seen and that means tons of preparations. You've got to make a good impression I think. that's the way we see it.

## SO, WEAT ABOUT YOUR FUTURE PLANS?

Future plans? Hopefully do a 7° abd get some more new songs dawn. Get as much exposure as we can and basically keep enjoying what we're doing, creating extremely heavy and brutal Death/Doom Metal.

# INTRODUCE YOUR BAND TO THE READERS?

Bart: guitars, Quiet guy, easy to be with. Doesn't care about anything. Pascal: guitars. Keeps to himself, antisocial case, hardly ever speaks. Walter: drums. Very fanatic musician. A guy of extreme emotions. Lotsa alcohol, never drunk... Gunther: bass/vocals. To find out how I really am you should ask the other guys. I'm totally consumed by history and Occultism... other guys. I'm totally history and Occultism...


AT WHAT AGE DID YOU GET INVOLVED INTO

History and occultism have always attracted me even when I was a little kid. My father got me into it at very young age. I read a lot about these topics and I travel to visit ancient temples, castles, ruins, crypts. History and occultism means a lot to me, it creates a melancholic feeling of vastness and darkness. Also it gives you a lot of strength and power. When I refer to Satanism I don't mean supernatural forces but the power that is within yourself, the Satanic Life Code of self respect, power and loyalty to the ones who're loyal to you. Very down to earth infact. the satanic symbols are just a way to express the evil that is surrounding us, the ancient instinct, not weakness and "Love everyone" crap! Religion is created for the insecure who need something to turn their preyers to, Satanism is an anti-religion. The Rejoice of men, indulgence, revenge, strength...I'm in contact with many satanist througout the world, there are different views and thoyghts which I respect but my view upon satanism is a realistic one, like I said it's a life code...

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE A DIFFERENT WAY TO PLAY BLACK METAL, NOT THE SAME DAST AND MORBID STUFF LIKE OTHERS?

ry to create our own sound which We try to create our own sound which I think is very dark and morbid but different. Some of new songs we've written have very fast parts but always combined with slow, melancholic parts with choirs and organs to create a dark, evil atmosphere. I like very fast stuff a

lot but when you want to create a dark feel you have to slow down a bit from time to time. the feel is most important to is not the speed, however we do have ultra fast parts. It's very morbid to combine brutal and melancholic parts in one song. We often use classical musicians when we're in studio to create the right We often use classical musicians when we're in studio to create the right atmosphere, guys who don't know anything about Black Metal but who play Bach or Beethoven or soundtracks of Horror movies...It's the same evil feel but with a different musical approach...That rules I think.



WEAT ARE YOUR INFLUENCES? (MUSIC, BOOKS. ETC.)

Anything obscure and dark influences us... I like soundtracks of Horror music and Medieval or Gothic classical music. Old Black Metal such as VENON, BATHORY, HELLHAMMER/CELTIC FROST...Fave HELLHAMMER/CELTIC FROST...Fave
movies: "Picnic at Hanging rock" "The
name of the Rose", "Angel Heart",
weird mystical movies but also very
cruel splatter movies... Books:
anything dealing with Ancient Greece
(Spartal), my forefathers the Celtic
tribes, the Assyrian empire, Mycenian
(war) civilization, Babylon, Gilles
De Rais, Medieval, Europe, Satanism
and Black arts (not the wimpy white
magic shit)...I like writers sucha
as strengh not useless violence and Black arts (not the wimpy white magic shit)...I like writers sucha as strengh not useless violence inspires me, old Ancient empires rule but also "De Bokkerijders" who were a satanic horde that lived in the Flemish part of Belgium a few centuries ago, they burned down the churches, robbed the rich and took part in very blasphemous rites. They all got executed but kept on spitting upon the cross til the very end. The name still represents fear in Belgium and some parts of Holland, reality was stranger than fiction, they had their own rules and a very black life code...One of our songs on our ep is dedicated to them: "Obscurity Reigns" (Fields of Flanders)...I spit upon all peace/love/social lyrics! Hippie stuff! I don't care that many people hate us for our dark lyrics they don't have the right view when it comes to death/doom or Black Metal. A dark music style needs dark lyrics. dark music style needs dark lyrics.

DO YOU ENJOY OTHER KIND OF DEATH METAL LIKE: ENTOMED, AUTOPSY... CANNIBAL CORPSE ETC THAT THEY'RE NOT

I like some Death acts but when a band has Satanic lyrics I can relate to them in a much better way...Satanic lyrics don't have to be dumb or childish but they can have a more intelligent approach you aumo or childish but they can have a more intelligent approach you know...More mysterious and very deep. I think Evil things have a certain beauty which is difficult to describe but I know I'm totally consumed by it, it attracts us...The "good" side of things are so boring and have no background or deeper thought behind them...EVIL REIGNS! For instance: GILLES DE RAIS was a very famous

French knight who proved his bravery while fighting the English invaders at the side of JOAN OF ARC. he was a at the side of JOAN OF ARC. he was a well respect rich man...In his crypts though he had an alchemist atelier and a chamber where he practices Satanic Rites, on top of it all he adored the beauty of death and slaughtered and raped little children in a very cruel bestial slaughtered and raped little children in a very cruel bestial way...Evenmade love to the cadavers! When he got caught he financed his own execution so that everyone could witness it so he payed people to build stages etc! So fucking weird, insane & intense! He held a speech and said he deserved "A thousand deaths! "He butchered hundreds (!) of children and yet he was a very loyal true friend to have. total Schizo! These things I like!

TELL US ABOUT YOUR LATEST STUFF AND BOW COULD YOU COMPARE THEM WITH THE

We've always been a black band but we're becomming more and more extreme, no sell out whatsoever! No noise though we try to play as tight as possible and there will always be room from fot slow, "evil" parts... The demo "Dark Ritual" was alright but it was recorded with the old line up and therefore not representative for A.R. anymore. I'm the only "demo" member left, new people means another sound, they don't have to copy the style of former A.R. members...The new material we've written for our forthcoming CD is even more intense and morbid. Many bands progress into a more commercial direction, we move in opposite ways...

NOW'S THE SCENE IN BELGIUM 'CUE IT SEEMS TO BE ONE FULL OF NOISE BANDS, HOW MANY BLACK METAL EXIST THERE?

Many Grind/Noise bands indeed because Many Grind/Noise bands indeed because of AGATHOCLES but they don't have anything to do with Metal underground, infact they boycot our kind of bands and criticize Metal in general but we don't need those shitheads you know...There are some Death and Deathrash bands like DYING CORDER BLASPHEREION, SPITHEAD and Death and Deathrash bands like DYING CORPSE, BLASPHEREION, SPITHEAD and many others. We're the only Black Metalband though...There's a lot of competition between the nands which is quite stupid I think. In the past I ignored it but now I fight them

when they try to walk all over us, we want to get the respect we deserve. This own release is meaned to sell at our gigs and to people who prefer to order it directely from me, also for promotional reasons. But soon it'll be available at WRR as well... 
FUTURE PLANS AFTER YOUR CD, ANY TOUR?



WEAT'S THE BAND DOING AT THE MOMENT?

At the moment we're trying to find ourself a new REH place because that one we have now sucks. And we are also waiting to get our debut album released.

CURRENT LINE-UP WITE THEIR AGES.

Actually our line up has changed some days ago. We fired our bassplayer because he was not longer into what we are doing. So we decided to get a new bassplayer. The line-up now is:

Morgan- Guitar - 19
Magms- Guitar - 22
Joakim - Drums - 18
Andreas - Vox - 20
Roger - Bass - 27

TELL US ABOUT YOUR "FUCK ME JESUS"

Well, the demo was recorded back in the summer of '90 and it was released during late 91 because we didn't have no money at the moment. The demo includes 3 songs: "Departure from the

mortals", "The black...", and finally "Within the abyss", and at the moment the demo is sold out, but hopefully new copies will be printed.

YOUR SOUND IS PRETTY INTENSE AND DIFFERENT THAN OTHER SWEDISH BANDS. WHAT COULD YOU TELL US ABOUT IT?

Yesi We don't want to sound like all the other motherfucking wimp bands from Sweden. Actually Sweden only has 6 great bands and that's: ABRUPTUM, MARDUK, DISSECTION, UNANIMATED, BATHORY (I don't think so listening to their new poser stuffled) and OPHTALAMIA.

HOW IS THE SCENE IN SWEDEN FOR A BLACK METAL BAND? DO YOU HAVE SAME RESPONSE LIKE OTHERS?

Of course we don't get the same response as these bands. Because we are not doing the same thing. We are not interested to get attention from Swedish idiot people.

I THINK WHEN YOU PLAY DEATH METAL YOU SHOULD BE INFLUENCED BY DEATH METAL BAMDS AND NOT BY ANY OTHER STYLE, IN THIS CASE WHAT IS YOUR OPINION?

Yes of course! If you play death metal you must be influenced by death bands but mostly by death itself (you got the ideal-ed) Death Metal Lyrics should only deal with topics considering death, otherways it is not Death Metal.

DO YOU KNOW DYSENTERY? WHICE OTHER BLACK METAL BANDS DO YOU KNOW IN YOU AREA?

No! I don't know <u>Dysentery</u>, and I'm not interested to know them either. Hmmm...Dysentery is not Black Metal. (They say so - ed) other black metal bands in Sweden is ABRUFTUM and BATHORY (???-ed)

HOW IS MARDOK ON STAGE? DO YOU USE SOME KIND OF EFFECTS IN YOUR SHOWS LIKE: FOG, INTROS, ETC...?

Marduk on stage is pain and damnation, some of the effects we used so far is intros, smoke, candles, torches, cutting ourselves and let the blood flows...We do have some more evil ideas for the future gigs...Let's wait and see.

## AMY 7" EP/LP PLANS

We recorded 2 songs that were planned to be released as an 'ep but now we decided to not release that one because every stupid band releases 7" inches and by the way 7" inches are for shitty hardcore stupids. Now in June '92 we recorded our debut album which will be released on LP/CD on no fashion Recs., during late september '92. The album will be called "Dark, Endless".

I don't really have fave 'zines, most all of them are boring but slayer mag and a few more are OK.



# MAKE US A SHORT STORY OF THE BAND.

I met the bassplayer and he wanted to play in a band called Miasma, then we were searching go a drummer, we found it and we had our first receiving a good response by the fans. Some months later the bassplayer said that we vocalist because our vocalist was a very stupid guy that only standed on stage and there was not intense show for the band. So I said "OK" I'll do the vocals" and we did our first demo "Amusement of the Gods" called containing four songs, also in the album but better performed.

WHAT KIND OF MUSIC DO YOU PLAY AND WHAT THE LYRICS DEAL WITH? ARE THEY SATANIC?

Yes! We're death metal, but not every lyrics are satanic, a few of them are like Deicide , the bassplayer used to write the lyrics before I came to the band. On this album we have lyrics from our bassplayer and the drummer. drummer likes lyrics CANNIBAL CORPSE, more gory lyrics.

I like very strange lyrics like The Doors, in our new album you'll find inspiration by THE DOORS, especially in the music.

DO YOU ARE IN THE US FOR PLAYING GIGS?

No, we are only for the foundation I want to play but we are not too popular here and Europe, only in Austria we try to reach more popularity. Last gig we play was with: THERION, AT THE GATES and a polish called <u>BETRAYER</u> the scene was very cool!

BESIDE YOUR BAND DO YOU KNOW OTHER BANDS FROM AUSTRIA LIKE: PUNGENT, STENCH, DISHARMONIC ORCHESTRA, DISASTROUS MURMUR.

Yes, I know them especially P. Stench. They're very cool live! DN Record tehy sound like Cannibal Corpse, very easy riffs, easy music, only to listening. But live they're really good! I like D. Orchestra too, but is not easy playing like P. Stench, D. Murmur is cool! The guys are really nice, but I think the vocalist is bisexual! When we did our first gig with them, the guy played with his dick off on stage.

# WHAT DO YOU THINK OF THE FOUNDATION FORUM?

I like it very much! The people are so friendly, when I get back to Austria I'll say "you'll never find guys like this "you know, in Austria is more difficult for a death metal band to come out, we have bands like Morbid Angel or Deicide and that's it.

# FAVORITE BANDS

My favorite band from Austria should be D. Orchestra. About worldwide bands my favorite is THE DOORS.

# DO YOU HAVE SOME MERCHANDISE TO SELL?

We have shirts! We have demos but won't sell them anymore because the album is out. Also we sold only 100 or 200 demos 'Cuz in Austria is very difficult to sell demos most than other lands.

# FINAL WORDS

I hope that everyone like our LP, thousands of hanshakes to those who buy our album, hail yourself and thanx!

Tell the most Recent happenings with the band. Still the same Line-up ?

Since a few months we are without a bassplayer, Arjan Left some time after the recording of "Sphere of the Rotting" our latest demo. As long as we don't find a suitable replacement, we'll simply so on without.

Without happened with your 7" ep ? Still in your plans ?

We have many people that want to do ep on Obstrucation, we haven't decided anything yet. Probably with Mauricio of Putrid Phlegm and maybe another one.

Could you explain your evolution since your "Sanctum's Disruption" to the new material ?

I think "Sphere of the Rotting" will sound a lot better than "Sanctum's ...", mainly because the new songs are better arranged and the new stuff was recorded in a 24 tx studio by an experienced person, who did a number of metal bands before us, so he understood the sound that we wanted.

Did you play with <u>Immolation</u> when they played in Rotterdam?

No, shit! Why ? there already played 3 bands, Morgoth, Immolation and Massacre, we didn't fit into the schedule.

Could you tell how was the crowd in that show ?

Well, the crowd in this place called "Nightown" usually sucks, this time also, 'though when <u>Massacre'</u>, was playing, there was some movement. Rotterdam crowds are spoiled ... they've seen all godly bands five times yet ... they've become to critical.

Any label interested in your stuff ?

Yes, some are... we've had a guy over from an interesting german label, Know from bands as Destruction etc ... But nothing sure yet. For us it's such a big deal, cuz we all have our jobs and shit. It's not that we're desperate to put out an LP. We'll just see!

Which are better places to play in Holland ? are there promoters very supportive ?

All places are OK to play, but the

ones in the upper north and far east of Holland have the best crowds. Crowds in big cities as Rotterdam, for example, are mostly spoiled bastards. Promotes are usually very supportive, there are many opportunities to play, so that's cool



Now did you get the chance to be on the Dutch compilation ?

Yes, we are on the DSFA CD compilation with 2 songs. Thank to Anthony V.D. Berg, who have been very supportive. DSFA features a variety of death, thrash, and doometal from eight dutch bands, and is really professional done!

Do you think you can record with a mayor record label ? what do you think has the best bands ?

Maybe someday, But as I already said, we're just hobbyists and people would expect to much from us if we would go as far as recording for a major label. there aren't any labels that put out godly stuff only, They all have a number of releases that don't appeal to me.

What is the worst thing that could happen to a band in Holland ?

The most horrid disaster a dutch deathmetal band could experience, would be to be left without a big pile of pot and Hasj!.

What is best gig you had ever played and with who ?

With Winged (Now Sinoath) and Catacomb in a very inside bar in Catania, Sicily. We played without a PA, had shiftly sound, but we played tight and the crowd was really megasupergoed !.

Do you think every band tries to copy <a href="mailto:Entombed"><u>Entombed</u></a> or <a href="Morbid Angel">Morbid Angel</a>?

Most bands do, 'though in most cases it's not on purpose, I think it's just because it's very hard not to sound like the bands you're influenced by.

If you would have the chance to reincarnate, who or what would you like to be ?

We'd like to incarnate as goats, for they are the living symbols of satanic sex

What are the thoughts of <u>Destilence's</u> new album ? Do you think Martin did the best leaving to join the Mighty <u>Asphyx ?</u>

I, probably not speaking for the rest of the band, like this new album a lot. I thought Martin Fitted very well in <u>Pestilence</u> and I don't know the details about his departure. But as a band, <u>Pestilence</u> has much more class than <u>Asphyx</u>. (What? - ED)

Tell us about any plan to tour out or inside Europe ?

We don't have any plans to tour and shit like that 'cuz we all have our job's that take too much time.

Any insult to someone who deserve it ?

How fuckin' sick! Usually when I vomit the croud moves away... These guys took it all! I love it!! Allican say is... you guys all ruled! total fuckin' maniacs thank from the bottom of my black heart for coming out and supporting us, and I mean that sincerely!!!

How would you compare them with other crowds? in this case USA.

Like I said... U.S. crowds stink! In Rhode Island, the crowd was very active and involved, but very tired... still, they were cool, but they're definitely an exception! Usually, when we play it's like a funeral, only not as fun! Real Zombies (Horror!-ED) and they don't come out to see the bands, only to show off their Napalm Death shirts and get laid! posers!!

The P.R. crowd waas there to go completely insane, without a doubt!!! it was great!!

What do you like most from P.R.?

It really is a different palce, and I think a lot of it's appeal to us has to do with that... The buildings, the forests, wheather, food etc.. are all new to us, and we love it!! How do you think your new album will cruch your first one?

The music, lyrics and production are 100 times better, for one thing!!Also, I'd like to point out that our first Lp was made of song s from the first 3 years of our existence, new and old... This Lp is more cohesive, the songs are definitely not similar in anyway but they share a slight thematic and musical bond because all this material was for the most part, written in the course of 9-11 mon ths overall, it's just a better album.

What thing you think are improved on this album?

Well, we haven't gotten mere tech nical or anything, but we've been playing together longer and we've come up with a few new things to do when writing a song... Every body pitches in on the writing more and I think the songs are much more powerful, because we're not graspin g for a style anymore... We've come up with our own sound, and we're sticking with it, yet still growing ... make any sense? plus, the lyri cs are a lot Darker adn sicker... adn the production!! not only the new studio we're working at made a difference, it was us too!! The more time we spend recording the more we learn about our sound and how to get it right in the studio. We're still learning!! also inste ad of dumping new techniques and Ideas onto the listeners, and cha nging our style, we've improved on what we've been doing! So, it's not a new band or sound on the Lp. All the way! Hope I'm making sen se, sorry if I'm not pal!! (No Way you got it-Ed).

What about the Puertorican cuisine and girls?

Hmm!! Well, to be honest, I came down here expecting mexican-style food, but I was pleasantly surprised! Don't get me wrong, I love mexican food! But the P.R. cuisi ne was different, I loved it! Re y's family fixed some killer food, especially "morcilla" that stuff was delicious! the other wimps in IMPETIGO AND NUCLEAR DEATH don't know what they missed when phil hampson and I indulged in it. We've got a 3 song demo out that only neil and I played on, it's called "Sorrows of the Moon" and it costs \$5 (US and PR) and (\$6 world) we're working on new material now and it's a lot better than the demo, but we're still happy with it!! We've got recording planned before the year is out! Write me for more info, and thank for the free plug.

Would you return to play again in P.R.?

Hell yes! I only hope you will have us back. We won't let Dan Drink as much, ok??

I know you'll play on the Milwau kee's metal fest, what other plans do you have?



I'D LIKE TO KNOW YOUR OPINION ABOUT TIPPER GORE (ALGORE'S WIFE AND PMRC' PRESIDENT) DO YOU TRINK IP AL IS ELECTED, TIPPER WILL EAVE MORE POWER OVER THE UNDERGROUND?

We played songs from the 1st, 2nd LP's and I think we played a new song, I forgot, it was a fucking amazing show, with a great response.



Excluding MONSTROSITY, KILLING ADDITION doesn't play trendy commercial death metal (if I could call it Death Metal!). This band has released a debut album called "OMEGA FACTOR" on J/L AMERICA RECS. I've listened some adv. tracks that bass/vocal Pat Bailey sent me, and it's somethings to check out. Mean while you can write to: K.A., 4201 SE 46 st, OCALA, FL. 34480 USA

# 1) Introduce yourselves to our readers.

K.A. was formed in Sept. of 1988, we did our "Legacies of Terror demo in Sept. 1990 and then our 7" ep "Necrosphere" in June of 1991. After the ep was released our drummer quit, giving us our current lineup (Chad Bailey-guitar, Chris York-percusion, Chris Wicklein-guitar, Pat Bailey-bass/vocals). Last March, we recorded our debut Lp which should be out in early '93.

2) Tell us about your up coming debut on J/L AMERICA/OSMOSE, and how did get that deal?

The Lp is titled, "Omega Factor" and should be out in Jan. of '93. There are 8 tracks: 5 new, 3old. Some song titles are "Omega Factor", "Nothing Remains", "Dehumanized", "Global Freezing". We had already recorded the Lp when we got in touch with JL. They were looking for bands to sign that had album completed and thy liked our material. They signed us almost immediately. immediately.

3) Did you chose Morrisound to record your Lp?

No, we don't like and will probably never use Morrisound. There production is too comercial sounding for our style. We recorded at Mirror Image studios in Gainesville, FL about 30 miles from where we live. It was much more convenient for us and it's a great studio.

4) I think that you sound different than the rest of the bands from FL. could you elaborate on this one.

Thanks, we take that as a complement. Not because we think we're better, it's just that most of the FL bands seem to play the same style of material. I think we sound different because we live far enough away from Tampa that we don't get sucked into the mold that has been made by the bigger bands there. Most of our influences are European anyway.





5) Tell us about the cover of the Lp, please could you describe

Well, this is going to be difficult. The cover is set on a moonscape type background. There is a human in some sort of space outfit, kneeling over a dark pool. He is reaching out to touch his reflection in the water, although his reflection looks like a descomposing being. There is also strange barbed vines in the background that have red eyes looking out of them. This all might sound kind of strange, but when you see the picture it makes more sense. The artwork is incredible. It was painted by Nick Curri from Italy, who does artwork for a mag. Over there.

6) Did you receive any other offer from other labels? Which ones?

Yes, a fake label called Putrid Corpse records that we originally recorded the album for before we found out originally recorded the album for before we found out otherwise. Grindcore International also said they were interested in signing us after they heard the Lp, but they changed their mind at the last minute. We talked to Relapse and a few others who weren't signing at that time though. After about a month JL America picked us up.

7) Theres a lot of killer shows in FL. in which ones do you have played and with who?  $\label{eq:condition}$ 

Well, we've played about 50 shows so far. Some bands that we've played with are Atheist, Obituary, Incantation, Assuck, Paineater, Ebullition, Phlegm, Skeletal Earth, Incision, Acheron, Rupture(R.I.P.), Brutal Enemy, Brutality and tons

8) How many copies from your 7"ep were sold?

We aren't sure exactly since Seraphic Decay never told us, but we've heard from people who know where he does his pressing that it's been about 3,000 copies or more.

9) Have you heard ORGANIC INFEST from P.R. who also signed

No, in fact the only band that I've heard from JL America is Acheron. Most of the bands that they've signed I've never heard of before in the underground, other than the ones on

If you bought my second issue if Enthroned 'zine then you know this band and how killer is! Well, that was nothing compared to their new production. The sound is great, the music is intense and powerful! It was released by Drowned Prod, who also released the Necrophiliac Lp. It's time to give Spain a chance to prove their potential and with this band, you have nothing to loose except your brain! It contains 8 tunes and 2 intros including some new versions from their demo. Try to find this at any cost.

FLESCRAWL "Descent into the Absurb"

Another great release by Black Metal Recs. This German band is one of the most brutal acts from their country, they released some stuff under their old name (Suffocation). But this is their best material. This band has everything grind, doom and overall heaviness, and is when this band let is feel all the intensity they make.



TIAMAT - "Clouds" Lp

Here's the third release from century media's most original band, I have to say that this is the second Lp on CM) I was waiting for this Lp and it didn't dissapointed me! This time the band included a keyboard to give more versatility to their music, so now they're a five-piece unit. The vocals are little bit deeper than the "Astral Sleep" Lp. Also there's some fast parts, but not the usual speed found in any death metal band. So if you haven't had the chance to listen to any of Tiamat's releases don't you think that this band plays the typical death metal or even plays like other Swedish band's, 'cuz this is not the band's direction! This Lo is recommended with some classic touch!

SEANCE - "Fornever laid to rest" Lp

Extreme brutal death metal from the land of the Godz! This new band land of the Godz! This new band sounds extremely intense and this Lo is the living proof!

I have to include this great band into my lovely Swedish collections, 'cuz it's so fuckin' godly. They play death/grind in their own way, and one curious fact is that this record was not recorded in Sunlight record was not recorded in Sunlight studios and was not produced by the almighry Romas Skosgberg, but the sound is brilliant! So for those who think that bands like Grave, God Massacre are the ultimate bands in Brutality, wait to listen this and you'll be impressed! (Like me!)

Grave - "You'll never see...." Lp

Bere comes the heaviest band from Century Media Recs. This is the second Lp from my favorite band (I don't give a damn if you don't like it!) But, this is no reason to blind my eyes to see the real quality of this recording. First, I still love their debut album and I don't see how this new effort could blow it in any way! This album includes 8 songs, featuring 3 old ones, also the speed is not the order of the day 'cuz heaviness describes this record. You

must listen to the title track 'cuz is one of brutaliest songs from this band (and "Deformed" of course!) Also new tunes like "Christianity" are cool! They recorded it in the Mighty Sunlight Studio, which other studio could give them a place to amplify their heavy sound?

Acheron - "Rite of the Black Mass"

This is the most evil outfit in Florida. After sometime finally these guys put their dark and obscure stuff on vinyl! As you can noticed, those songs are a little bit old, it seems to be that it took much time to seems to be that it took much time to find some label interested in the release. Every song has it's own intro done by Peter Gilmore. Actually the band is looking for a new record label for their second Lp featuring the addition of the Ex-Nocturnus frontman Mike Browning! New material should be written already for the new Lp! But talking about this Lp, I think it's a masterpiece for those who love the true black metal. As I mentioned true black metal. As I mentioned before, it includes 10 songs with 10 As I mentioned intros recorded at Morrisound studios with Scott Burns, so it's up to you!

Necrosant - "Incarnate" Lp

This is the second recording from this band and let me tell you that is too much better than their first. They're now in the real death/grind vein, the vocals sound similar to Martin V. Drunen, 'though the production doesn't help the brutal sound of the band, still a good purchase. Also the lyrics are more obscure and darker compared to "Equal in Death". This Lp was recorded on Montezuma studios in Sweden and containd 11 tracks! Those who liked their first recording must get this their first recording must get this cuz as I said before is better!

AGRESSOR - "Towards Beyond" Lp

This is the second album by this legendary french band! Although I haven't had the chance to listen their first Lp, I have their "Satan's sodomy" demo and I can say that the progression of this band is great! There's only one original member left (Alex) so I suppose that's why this band is talentous now! It's death/thrash with very high technicism and 'though I'm not into technical stuff, these guys really know what they're playing. Definitely different from the rest!

MIASMA - "Changes" Lp
This band is from Austria as you can
see in their interview, but is not in
the vein of P. Stench, D. Orchestra the vein of P. Stench, D. Orchestra or D. Murmur. This guys play death/black music without falling into the trendy. I can find some original ideas and a lot of speed. The vocals sometimes remind me of Chris from Cannibal Corpse. Definitely, the production didn't help the band, but this band it's worth to checking but 'cuz it satisfies every death metal fan.




